### NEWS AND NOTES

NC State was -30' and led 31-0 over South Alabama. NCSt had missed a 39 yd FG with 10:12 left and had led 28-0 at half but put their offense away as they had 255 yards in the 1H and just 149 in the 2H. SA got an 8 yd td pass with 5:20 left for the backdoor cover...Georgia was -41' vs Florida Atlantic. They led 56-14 in the 4Q but FAU got a 42 yd IR td with 10:11 left to get under ATS, 56-20 and UGA despite piling up a school record 713 yds, did not get the cover...LA Tech led 56-30 when Rice took over with 3:40 left. On 4&8 Rice got a 14 yd td pass with 1:32 left to get under the spread as LT only won by 19 laying 21...W Virginia was -35 vs James Madison. They scored td's on their first 4 pass to go up 28-0 and appeared on their way to a rout. They led 42-5 when JMU took over with 5:40 left and JMU converted on 4&6 and then capped their 62/12pl drive with a td with :49 left for the backdoor cover... Wyoming was without

starting QB Brett Smith and Colby Kirkegaard hit 15-23-123. Cal Poly, which went to the option scored on their first couple of poss. Deonte Williams rushed for 187 and he had a 65 yard TD run on CP's first poss and a 74 yd run down to the 5 on the 2nd and CP led 14-0 with 9:53 left in the 1Q. WY battled back to lead 15-14 at the half but CP got a 40 yd drive for a td in the 3Q then a 51 yd FG with 9:49 left. WY got a td with 7:34 left but punted with 3:58 left and took over with 1:46 left at their own 25 and Kirkegaard was int'd at their own 37... Virginia Tech had won 13 str road games, longest standing streak in the country but Pitt ended that. Tino Sunseri hit 19-28-283 vs what was thought to be one of Bud Foster's best D's yet. Pitt had 27-14 FD and 537-324 yd edges and they have a 2-headed monster at TB as Ray Graham rushed for 94 yds on 24 carries and true frosh Rushel Shell added 157 on 23 carries with the 2 chipping in another 32

yards in receiving. Pitt even missed a 35 yard FG at the end of an 8pl drive and missed a 33 yd FG at the end of a 9pl drive in the 1H. It was VT's largest halftime deficit s/'07... East Carolina and Southern Miss both started new QB's last week. EC went to Shane Carden who hit 13-27-171 and guided the Pirates to the upset win. There's not doubting the athleticism that frosh Anthony Alford provides but he hit just 6-14-88 for SM and rushed for 13 yards on 20 carries. After B2B Alford fmbled, Chris Champbell who started the opener, came in with SM trailing 24-7 with 1:19 left in the 3Q and guided the team on a 79/9pl drive for a td. His 2nd poss went 3&out and his 3rd started at the 2. They went 47/13pl but his 4th & 12 pass at the SM49 was incomplete. SM surprisingly had a 324-228 yard edge with EC getting a 19 yd td drive after an Alford fumble late 3Q and then a 16 yd FR td on another fumble by Alford 3pl later for their 24-7 lead

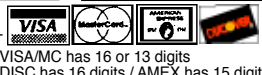
