Cincy meanwhile is still alive for a BCS bowl as a win here and a UCF loss on Sat puts it in the hands of the BCS poll which gives them a legit shot. The Bearcats have been the exact opposite winning 5 straight and covering 4 of those including pulling impressive upsets vs Rutgers (covered by 36) and Houston (covered by 9.5). With that said we'll fade Cincy and lean with Bridgewater to make a huge final reg ssn impression on national tv.

Meanwhile an NIU D that is allowing 412 ypg is forecasted to give up 447 yds here. Much like LY, the Huskies will be playing with massive BCS pressure and there's nothing we like more than when PP picks a dog outright by over a td.

These two tms did not meet in the regular season this year, but Marshall did win at Rice LY in 2OT 54-51 (-3). The Thundering Herd have won 3 of the last 4 SU, but are 1-2-1 ATS. First CUSA champ gm for both teams. The home team was decided by the BCS polls which favored Rice, despite Marshall getting votes in the Coaches and Harris Polls. Rice has won 3 str (1-2 ATS) while Marshall has won 5 str (4-1 ATS). PP projects the Thundering Herd with an 8 point win with Rice having a 463-432 yd edge. No line as of presstime has us making this a No Play.

These two teams didn't meet during Mizzou's first two years in the SEC and have met only once, back in the '73 Sun Bowl. Into the season, you could have made a case for at least one of the teams in the other conference champ gms to be playing, but there is no one that could've predicted either of these two in the SEC champ gm as they combined for just 2 SEC wins LY. The Cinderella ssn continued for Auburn LW as they had their 2nd miracle win in as many gms. A missed FG was returned 109 yds for a td on the gm's final play allowing them to upset 2-time defending National Champ, Alabama 34-28 (+10'). Mizzou won a 4.5★ on these pages last week as they defeated A&M 28-21 (-4). PP forecasts the Tigers to pull the outright upset with a 470-441 yd edge and we fully agree and back a Mizzou team that is on a 9-1 ATS run.

These two didn't meet in the reg ssn, but the FSU 48-7 win over Duke LY made them a perfect 18-0 in the series. The Noles defeated rival Florida with ease LW 37-7 (-28). There appears to be no slowing them down as they are marching towards the BCS champ gm. Not only have they run the table, but they are on a 7-0-1 ATS run as well. Duke is off an outright upset over rival UNC 27-25 (+4'). The Blue Devils enter this gm having won 8 str (6-1-1 ATS). PP projects a blowout with the Seminoles having a 525-345 yd edge. While FSU has outgained ACC foes by an avg of 231 ypg, the Blue Devils have been OUTGAINED by conf opponents by 41 ypg! We disagree with PP & feel that the Noles will win by more than 4 td's as they head to Pasadena with a chance at their 1st Nat'l Title s/99.

This will be the 2nd meeting between these two TY as Stanford defeated Ariz St at home in Sept 42-28 (-6'). That contest wasn't nearly as close as the final score looked as the Cardinal led 29-0 at HT & 39-7 before putting their backups in. The win was Stan's 4th str SU (3-1 ATS). Both tms come in off wins. Stanford edged Notre Dame 27-20 (-15') to close out the ssn winning 5 of their L/6 (4-2 ATS). Ariz St benefitted from 4 Ariz TO's to win the Territorial Cup 58-21 (-11) in a misleading final as the Sun Devils only had 54 yd & 2 FD edges in the game. PP forecasts Ariz St to win by 4 while having a slight 360-354 yd edge. We disagree as the Cardinal come in with much more big game experience, have a dominant D that should be able to shutdown a Sun Devils' team that will likely be without their top playmaker in RB Grice who has accounted for 20 td's TY.

This series has been dominated by OSU as they've won 8 of the L/9 while covering 6 of the L/8. These two did not meet during the ssn TY, but they did face off LY with the Buckeyes winning on the road 17-16 (+2). OSU has won an incredible 24 str gms, the longest streak since USC from '03-'05. That streak nearly came to an end LW at Michigan as the Bucks intercepted a potential GW 2 pt conv w/:32 left to win 42-41 (-16). MSU capped off its 1st unbeaten B10 ssn s/66 after getting by Minn 14-3 (-16'). Despite a Spartans' D that allowing just 65 rush ypg (2.2) on the ssn, PP is projecting OSU to rush for 234 yds, which is still 87 yds under their ssn avg. PP calls for the Buckeyes to win a nailbiter, with MSU having a slight 392-388 yd edge. We disagree, however, and feel OSU will win more comfortably as HC Meyer has experience coaching in these types of gms, the Buckeyes have to win to play in the Nat'l Champ, and were woken up after the near disaster against their hated rival LW.

This is the 1st MW championship game. Fresno has won 6 of the L/7 SU in the series, but USU is 5-2 ATS during that time frame. These teams avoided each other in conf play this year as they haven't met s/11 when they were both members of the WAC. The Bulldogs were upset LW as they saw their BCS bubble burst against SJSt, losing 62-52 (-8). The Aggies enter full of confidence after crushing Wyoming LW 35-7 (-24). They've won 5 str (4-1 ATS). PP forecasts USt to pull the outright upset, but with Fresno having a 456-361 yd edge. We disagree as the Aggies are starting a true frosh QB on the road in a highly meaningful game while the Bulldogs have a Sr, and potential 1st RD DC, at QB in Carr. The last time USt won in Fresno was 1980 as they have gone 0-10-1 SU.

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NOTE: Power Plays - PP PRO FOOTBALL DECEMBER 5th - December 9th

Power Plays is based upon statistical numbers and rankings that are used to develop the projections you see here. As with all types statistical information the more numbers that one inputs ordinarily the stronger the accuracy of the results. Therefore, one would expect the projections to be more reliable after a number of weeks worth of stats are input. The numbers in parenthesis are a comparison of the teams rankings (Visitor, visitors offense ranking vs home defense ranking, Home home offensive ranking vs visitor defensive ranking) over each teams last 4 games.

Thursday, December 5th

HOUSTON JACKSONVILLE (HOU #24 vs JAX #17, JAX #28 vs HOU #19) - It's very odd to write that the Jaguars are the team coming in with a win streak and confidence having beaten HOU just 2 weeks ago. The Texans put in a spirited effort vs NE LW but faded in the 2nd half again (-79 TY vs +15 LY). Will the Texans finally live up to their talent edge or will the Jaguars keep them in the top spot for the 2014 Draft in June?

NO PLAY: JAGUARS 23 TEXANS 22

Sunday, December 8th

KANSAS CITY WASHINGTON (KC #17 vs WAS #14, WAS #18 vs KC #32) - The Chiefs come into this game a bit dinged up as OLB Houston (elbow) and #1 LT Albert (knee) status' are doubtful here. They get a WAS team that has mathematically been eliminated from the playoffs as their #27 pass def is allowing 71% comp the L4W (9.4 ypa, 6-2 ratio) and the offense simply hasn't gotten in sync all year long. PP gives WAS a 104 yd edge largely due to KC being -131 ypg the L4W and with this around the line it's a No Play.

NO PLAY: CHIEFS 25 REDSKINS 20

MINNESOTA BALTIMORE (MIN #7 vs BAL #11, BAL #29 vs MIN #29) - MIN has feasted off the #32 and #26 rush defenses the L2W and after B2B season highs in rush atts (32 and 35) by Peterson playing in basically 2 full OT's they travel to the #6 rush def (100 ypg, 3.7) who has extra rest. TE Pitta who was a key cog in LY's offense (61 rec, 11.0, 7 td) finally returns here. PP gives BAL a slight yardage edge here but that's factoring Ponder at QB and he's likely to miss (concussion) and there is a reason Cassel/Freeman haven't replaced him and the Ravens have the superior talent.

3.5★ RAVENS 27 VIKINGS 15

CLEVELAND NEW ENGLAND (CLE #12 vs NE #25, NE #1 vs CLE #5) - Basically everything that could go wrong has since CLE returned from the bye as they've given up 51 pts via special teams or TO's making the success of WR Gordon (29 rec, 21.5, 4 td) meaningless. CLE fans can only hope that Campbell (concussion/ribs) returns here. Belichick excels at taking away what a team does best which for CLE is pass to Gordon (54.8% of offense L3W). With PP giving NE just a 21 yd edge (5-13 ATS DD fav) here and having a road game vs MIA on deck we'll limit the grade.

1★ PATRIOTS 36 BROWNS 21

OAKLAND NY JETS (OAK #26 vs NYJ #21, NYJ #31 vs OAK #16) - Its wrong to blame Rex Ryan for the loss to MIA as the QB spot imploded vs the #19 def after they faced the #10, #15, #5 and #7 units 4 wks in a row. It was just their 2nd home loss in a season where they upset NE and NO. OAK has extra rest as they travel to the East Coast (-21 ypg on the road) but we want to see just who lines up for the Jets (David Garrard) as well as the state of their secondary before making a call so No Play.

NO PLAY: JETS 19 RAIDERS 18

INDIANAPOLIS CINCINNATI (IND #22 vs CIN #9, CIN #16 vs IND #20) - Indianapolis owns the #3 seed and with a win formally locks up the AFC South. Cincinnati has the #4 seed and brute forced a win vs San Diego thanks to 164 yds (4.3) on the ground and not letting SD get any closer than the CIN30 on 9 sustained drives. Indy is being held together by sheer force of will by Luck (#21 rush off, #28 rush def, 13-4 def td/int ratio L7) and PP gives CIN a 406-257 yd edge here. Cincy is on a 9-4 ATS run as a fav and is a healthier team just a week removed from the bye.

4★ BENGALS 33 COLTS 16

DETROIT PHILADELPHIA (DET #4 vs PHI #30, PHI #5 vs DET #4) - DET shredded a thin GB team for their 1st Thanksgiving win since 2003 but dogs off a Thursday win are on a 2-6 ATS run. PHI is just 4-18 ATS at home with their only victory over a winning team being vs ARZ. DET has the firepower and QB to match with the Eagles and PP gives the a 135 yd edge (#5 TW) but their TO ratio the last 5 weeks (-13) limits the grade on the side but the Total is worth a look here.

2★ LIONS 30 EAGLES 27 • 3★ LIONS/EAGLES: OVER

MIAMI PITTSBURGH (MIA #20 vs PIT #15, PIT #21 vs MIA #7) - PIT is off a tough loss to BAL and fav's off a Thursday loss are 6-0 SU/ATS TY winning by 10 ppg. The Steelers are also dealing with Tomlin's "placement error" and the NFL has yet to decide on any punishment. MIA takes a big step up in QB class after facing a rookie QB with poor supporting talent (PIT WR Brown has 207 more rec yds than Jets top 3 rec's combined). PP only gives the Steelers a 63 yard edge and we want to see how angry the Steelers are as a team are with the NFL's handling of Tomlin first.

NO PLAY: STEELERS 23 DOLPHINS 17

BUFFALO TAMPA BAY (BUF #14 vs TB #18, TB #30 vs BUF #10) - TB's 4 game ATS streak came to an end vs the red-hot Panthers and their #1 def in yards and points. They now host the #17 def in yards/#24 in points that is backing up a one dimensional run oriented offense. BUF is -63 ypg on the road (#29) and TB has made it clear that despite the earlier issues they are behind Schiano who is getting quality play from Glennon (90.3 QBR). Power Plays gives BUF a small yard edge here but calls for the home team with a manageable line for the win and a small play here.

1★ BUCCANEERS 25 BILLS 18

TENNESSEE DENVER (TEN #11 vs DEN #24, DEN #3 vs TEN #8) - With DEN beating KC and taking NE to the brink in the L3W it's not a surprise they are the biggest fav of the week. Still, Manning is familiar with this scheme of defense from his days with IND and facing the Saints in the Super Bowl. TEN has to travel for the 3rd straight week and DEN can't afford to take chances with the #1 seed still in reach. PP's 95 yd edge doesn't match the margin of victory which tempers the grade here.

3★ BRONCOS 39 TITANS 18

ST LOUIS ARIZONA (STL #11 vs ARZ #1, ARZ #9 vs STL #23) - After 4 solid games Palmer stumbled at Philly (2 int, 1 fmb) but they also didn't have RB Ellington (knee) who gives the offense just enough balance to operate. St Louis only had 7 FD/113 yds prior to their final 3 drives vs San Fran last week and LT Long (concussion) is unknown. Arizona's line is inflated due to last week's misleading final (Philly ran out the final 1:51 inside ARZ15) and this is a No Play.

NO PLAY: CARDINALS 24 RAMS 22

NY GIANTS SAN DIEGO (NYG #25 vs SD #22, SD #6 vs NYG #12) - The Giants travel off a SNF win vs Washington vs a San Diego team fielding a borderline elite QB at home for the 2nd straight week. Power Plays calls for a 408-270 yd edge for the Chargers with 2 home losses vs DEN/CIN. The Giants haven't faced a good healthy QB on the road since Cutler back in mid-October who was coming off the New Orleans game. Power Plays calls for the home team and we'll back the call.

3★ CHARGERS 22 GIANTS 16

SEATTLE SAN FRANCISCO (SEA #19 vs SF #6, SF #32 vs SEA #13) - SEA is off last week's MNF game vs NO which had massive playoff implications. SF dominated STL last week but their OL took a huge hit and LT Staley (sprained MCL) is already expected to miss. With No MNF game factored in here this is a No Play.

NO PLAY: 49ERS 23 SEAHAWKS 16

ATLANTA GREEN BAY (ATL #13 vs GB #31, GB #15 vs ATL #27) - ATL showed some heart LW refusing to give in to BUF but instead of a comfy dome they will now play in temps around 20 here. There is conflicting information with Rodgers' (13-5 SU 32 deg or below) status and this is a No Play as there is no line at this point.

NO PLAY: PACKERS 21 FALCONS 20

CAROLINA NEW ORLEANS (CAR #23 vs NO #3, NO #2 vs CAR #2) - NO is off last week's MNF game vs SEA and they make the long flight home where they are 6-1 ATS hosting a Div foe. CAR has covered 7 of the L/8 as Newton has fully matured into a franchise QB and CAR has one of the best front 7's in the NFL. This game has been flexed for a reason but without knowing the MNF results this is a No Play. **Get the Sunday Night Marquee Winner! DALLAS CHICAGO (DAL #27 vs CHI #26, CHI #8 vs DAL #27) - DAL is one of those teams that just as they start getting things going their way something bad happens (6-13 ATS away off B2B wins). CHI is holding onto the slimmest of playoff hopes and desperate teams on national TV tend to rise above their talent level but can the Bears do so vs #32 defense in the NFL? **Monday Night Magic releases are available on your NC VIP Card for a Money Back PLUS Guarantee!
