THE MOST UNIQUE POWER RATINGS IN THE COUNTRY

These Power Play Forecasts are the most unique in the country because they are based on **Northcoast Sports' Private Power Ratings**. Our ratings are unlike any computer rating, as we take into account all of the following: Strength of Opponents Individual Units (Rushing Offense and Defense, Passing Offense, & Defense, Scoring Offense and Defense, Garbage Yards, Weather, Injuries, Home Field Edge, and Successful Unbalanced Attacks). Here is how each is reflected:

Strength of Opponent: Our ratings do not just take the opposing team's overall power rating into account. For example, last year, Florida Atlantic's defense vs the rush was rated at 119. They faced Alabama and allowed "just" 256 yds rushing and **dropped 5 spots** in the national overall defensive ratings. However, Power Plays took into account the potent Crimson Tide run attack and had forecasted the Owls yielding 289 yds. Due to the fact they did better than the forecast, Power Plays raised their rating to 112 even though they slipped in the national (straight yardage) rankings. Another example last season was Wisconsin vs UTEP. Wisconsin held UTEP to just 77 yards rushing and stayed the same in the overall defense in the national statistics. However, our ratings had them rated at 15 and moved them down, as they should have yielded just 50 yards to a weak UTEP rush attack. Next time an announcer on TV tells you that a certain team is #3 in the country vs the run **you better check Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings and see how good a rush defense they really have!** The top twenty ratings in Power Ratings for each offensive and defensive category will be listed in each week's issue of Power Plays.

Garbage yards: These are yards that a team gains or allows in the final minutes of a game when it has been decided. For example, Team A is ahead 63-0 and allows 93 yards passing for a TD vs its fourth string defense. These yards are **counted into national ratings, but not in Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings!**

Weather: If a game is played in miserable weather conditions and is low scoring, the straight statistics credit the defense with outstanding performances. Our Power Ratings reflect the conditions and do not give excess credit to the defenses.

Injuries: When Missouri played Vanderbilt last year, Tigers QB James Franklin was injured early in the game. His backup, who had seen very little action (rFr), was not prepared and hit on 30%, 9-30 passes. The offensive coordinator simplified the offense. In the national statistics Vanderbilt's overall defense **MOVED UP 8 NOTCHES**. In Phil's Power Ratings they **went from #11 dropping out of the Top 15**, as the poor performance WAS NOT reflective of an outstanding performance by the defense.

Home Field Edges: The weekly projection of yards and points is weighted with the home field factored in.

Successful Unbalanced Attacks: Last season, Tulsa was held to 155 yards passing vs Houston. This dropped Tulsa in the national passing offense ratings & **RAISED** the Cougars in the pass defense ratings. In our ratings the two units **remained** rated around the same. Why? Tulsa rushed for 350 yards & **DID NOT HAVE TO RELY ON THE PASS** & when they did they hit 18 of 32. While Houston's pass defense looked good in the national ratings, only Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings reflected the TRUTH!

There you have it. More than just numbers, **THESE RATINGS REFLECT** the true strength of each unit and allow them to have the **most accurate forecast of yards gained and points allowed in the country!** **No other rating system takes into account all the previous factors.** Next time you hear that a team is rated third in the country in pass defense, just remember, yards are not everything and Northcoast Sports' Power Plays will show you how strong the team really is.

NORTHCOAST SPORTS PLUS OR MINUS POWER RATINGS

The Power Ratings listed below are not based on the Power Plays, they are based on last year's final computer power rating numbers with the pluses and minuses from the off season changes factored in. They are then adjusted during the course of the season based on the final score of the games that are played on a weekly basis. The Power Ratings listed below can be used for you as a base power ratings to forecast up coming lines and strength of opponents, etc. Once again, they are not based on Power Plays and **they differ from what we have shown in recent years**, which has been our actual computer Power Ratings. These are Northcoast Sports Plus or Minus Power Ratings.

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The Power Plays Newsletter consists of forecasts that are made by a special rating system. You will see in the write-ups that we agree with the majority of the PP forecasts. However, there are times when we will disagree. We want to make it clear that this is the PP Newsletter and these forecasts are based purely on the power ratings. If the PP's rating is strong enough to be a 4★ Play, yet we are on the other side of the game, we will clearly state that we like the other side of the game. With all that said here are this week's PP Selections.

Thursday, October 9th

Both tms played mid-wk gms LW but BYU has 1 extra day to prep and travelling. The Cougs lost star QB Hill for the yr LW but UCF is off a misleading win. PP calls for a tight forecast. Pass.

NO PLAY: UCF 27 BYU 25

Friday, October 10th

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: WASHINGTON ST, STANFORD.

Stan has won 6 in a row SU by 28 ppg but the visitor has covered 5 str. Both are off L/Sec losses. PP calls for the Cardinal to get the bounce back win but the forecast is near the opening line.

NO PLAY: STANFORD 33 WASHINGTON ST 17

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: SAN DIEGO ST, NEW MEXICO.

Rocky Long is a perfect 12-0 in this series but has failed to cover all 4 ATS vs his former schl. PP calls for SDSt to hold NM's option to "just" 264 rush yds (59 below avg) but forecast is near line.

NO PLAY: SAN DIEGO ST 24 NEW MEXICO 20

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: FRESNO ST, UNLV.

Bulldogs have won 10 str by an avg score of 38-16. Fresno comes in off 3 str wins/covers while UNLV has 4 str losses. PP calls for Fresno to win easily but will there be look ahead to Boise?

NO PLAY: FRESNO ST 42 UNLV 24

Saturday, October 11th

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: TEXAS, OKLAHOMA.

RRR has been a series of streaks and the Sooners are playing w/revenge. They are coming off an upset loss but UT's loss to Baylor LW was very misleading and PP calls this near the line.

NO PLAY: OKLAHOMA 30 TEXAS 14

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: MICHIGAN ST, PURDUE.

LY MSU only won 14-0 (-27). They pulled their foot off the gas LW vs Neb while PU piled up 349 rush yds vs ILL. PP calls for MSU to hold the Boilers to 60 rush yds but forecast is near line.

NO PLAY: MICHIGAN ST 39 PURDUE 20

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: NORTHWESTERN, MINNESOTA.

Remarkably the visitor in this series is 15-2 ATS. NW comes in confident off B2B upsets while Minny is only +2 ypg TY despite their 4-1 record. PP has UM by 1 (opening line -3) but we like NW.

NO PLAY: MINNESOTA 18 NORTHWESTERN 17

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: RICE, ARMY.

Rice is only -1 ypg TY while playing our #36 sked while Army is -31 ypg playing our #112 sked. PP calls for the Owls to come away with a 6 pt win (opening line is E) and we agree.

4★ RICE 36 ARMY 30

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: TULSA, TEMPLE.

The Owls are outscoring their opp by 27 ppg TY but are only +44 ypg. PP calls for much of the same here as they are proj to have a 24 pt MOV but to only outgain the Hurricane by 55 yds. However, with an opening line of 14', we're not afraid to back the Owls who are on a 10-2 ATS run.

4★ TEMPLE 38 TULSA 14

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: MIDDLE TENNESSEE, MARSHALL.

The Herd are playing with legit revenge (lost on final play LY) and have been outscoring foes by 32 ppg (+276 ypg). PP calls for them to cover the large spread w/an incredible 633-365 yd edge.

3★ MARSHALL 47 MIDDLE TENNESSEE 21

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: MASSACHUSETTS, KENT ST.

Someone's "O" has got to go in this matchup and PP backs the Golden Flashes w/a 6 pt MOV and a 473-375 yd edge. However, their top 2 QB's are banged up and we'll pass on this for now.

NO PLAY: KENT ST 33 MASSACHUSETTS 27

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: FLORIDA ST, SYRACUSE.

After an 0-4 ATS start, the Noles finally got a cover LW. Now they take on a reeling Cuse tm off 3 str losses. PP calls for a 20 pt MOV but only a 75-yd edge (Cuse is +41 ypg TY, FSU +111).

NO PLAY: FLORIDA ST 37 SYRACUSE 17

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: DUKE, GEORGIA TECH.

The Jackets have won 10 straight in this series by 21 ppg (7-3 ATS). Duke has all'd 200+ rush yds in each of their L/3 gms and PP calls for GT to have 352 here but only a 1 pt MOV.

NO PLAY: GEORGIA TECH 29 DUKE 28

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: ILLINOIS, WISCONSIN.

Have to like a UW tm coming off a loss taking on an IL tm that gave up 458 rush to Neb and 349 rush to Pur. PP calls for UW to have a 372-68 rush yd edge but w/no real line at presstime (IL QB Lunt is now OFY) we'll pass for now.

NO PLAY: WISCONSIN 40 ILLINOIS 19

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: BOSTON COLLEGE, NC STATE.

Home tm is an amazing 8-1 SU/ATS in series. NCSst is off a 41-0 loss to Clem which has PP calling for a tight contest here (opening line NCSst -4) but we disagree and back the Pack.

NO PLAY: NC STATE 30 BOSTON COLLEGE 26

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: CINCINNATI, MIAMI, FL.

For the ssn the Canes are +82 ypg while the Bearcats are -130 ypg. PP calls for Miami to have a dominating 530-361 yd edge but only a 12-pt MOV. We agree with the yds but not the pts.

NO PLAY: MIAMI, FL 35 CINCINNATI 33

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: BUFFALO, EASTERN MICHIGAN.

Interesting forecast here as PP calls for EM to have 194 pass yds (only avg 103 TY). PP calls for the Bulls to come away w/a 14 pt MOV on the road, but that is right near the opening line.

NO PLAY: BUFFALO 40 EASTERN MICHIGAN 26

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: MIAMI, OH, AKRON.

The Redhawks finally broke their losing streak LW (rallied from a 41-14 deficit) but this wk will be a diff story vs a Zips tm that continues to impress. PP calls for a 14 pt win which is right at the line.

NO PLAY: AKRON 28 MIAMI, OH 14

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: INDIANA, IOWA.

Hawkeyes come in off a bye and have been impressive their L/2 gms while Indy has been a Jekyll and Hyde tm all yr. PP calls for only a 4 pt Iowa win (opening line 7) but we like their situation.

NO PLAY: IOWA 29 INDIANA 25

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: BOWLING GREEN, OHIO.

Series of streaks here as BG has dominated the L/2. PP calls for a much different story this yr as it has the Bobcats winning outright. Also BG D is all'g 699 ypg on the road TY and we love taking home dogs with the better defenses.

4★ OHIO 30 (if dog) BOWLING GREEN 28

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: WEST VIRGINIA, TEXAS TECH.

Counting good gms vs bad gms TY. WV has 5 good gms TY while TT has played 5 bad gms. The Mountaineers are +194 ypg vs our #11 sked while TT is -3 ypg vs our #38 sked. PP calls for WV to win by 9 and with a reasonable opening line (WV -4), we'll Mount up here!

4★ WEST VIRGINIA 42 TEXAS TECH 33

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: OKLAHOMA ST, KANSAS.

OSU has only avg 365 ypg vs KU the L/2 yrs and PP calls for similar numbers TY. While PP only has them w/a 50-yd edge, it does call for an 18 pt MOV which prevents this from being a stronger play.

2★ KANSAS 14 (+) OKLAHOMA ST 32

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: TCU, BAYLOR.

LTH the Frogs upset the Bears 49-21 (+6 TO's) and they nearly pulled the upset LY. While PP calls for BU to have a dominating 548-365 yd edge, we disagree and think TCU's D matches up well.

NO PLAY: BAYLOR 38 TCU 27

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: HOUSTON, MEMPHIS.

While the Tigers continue to impress wk after wk (4-0-1 ATS) and are fresh off a demolition of AAC favorite UC on the road, the Cougars are off a misleading loss to UCF LW. UH is 4-0 ATS as a conf AD while Mem lost outright both times LY as a conf HF.

NO PLAY: MEMPHIS 28 HOUSTON 16

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: NORTH TEXAS, UAB.

We couldn't disagree more w/PP's here as it is overreacting to UAB's 14-pt loss to FIU 2 wks ago (-6 TO's). Also while PP calls for NT to win, it has UAB outgaining them by a 94 yds. Pass.

NO PLAY: NORTH TEXAS 34 UAB 32

Table with 6 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows: AUBURN, MISSISSIPPI ST.

Both tms come off big wins but Auburn has been there and done that recently. Aub is all'g just 307 ypg on D while Miss St is all'g 426 ypg. PP calls for Miss St to have the ydg edge but for the Tigers to win outright. Opening line has Aub -3. Pass.

NO PLAY: AUBURN 31 MISSISSIPPI ST 29
