SD hasn't been the same team since beating BAL & need tons of help to snare a Wild-Card spot. We'll have a marquee selection on this Saturday Night game on 12/20 for you.

PP has this close to the line with no yardage margin so this is a No Play.

Philbin is on thin ice but 9 wins may be enough to save his job for 2015 esp with Tannehill having improved in a new offense. MIN is off a tough loss to DET where 3 bad FG's cost them the game. They now travel for the 2nd straight week vs a MIA defense that will be mad after giving up 40 pts to a Div rival. PP has a slight lean with the road team but we disagree so No Play.

With Rodgers off a loss with a career low QBR (34.3 or 7 pts better than Manziel), the Packers now behind the Lions for the NFC North & Rodgers facing an undermanned scheme (McCoy may be IR as he hyperextended knee 2nd week in a row) this could get ugly quick. We expect the line to rise a bit here so we'll limit the grade here.

Without knowing the Bears mindset with major coaching changes coming & the Lions having playoff need this is a No Play until a real line emerges.

ATL played well vs PIT LW but not having Julio Jones meant the offense simply couldn't pull off the win. ATL is dead last in sacks by & 1 of 3 teams with less than 20 (CIN/OAK) in that dept TY. ATL has been outscored by 99 pts in the 2nd & 4th Qtr combined as they wear down. PP goes against the 0-4 SU/ATS at home Saints but without the MNF results this is a No Play.

The Jets tried to outmuscle the Patriots in the 1st meeting on a Thursday at Gillette & Belichick holds grudges. The Patriots have covered 8 of their L10, the jets only mustered 16 pts LW & were outgained by the #29 offense who were forced to play their backup QB's. The Jets don't have the secondary to slow down Brady or offense to keep pace. PP sides with NE who still haven't locked up the #1 seed in the AFC yet.

4★ PATRIOTS 32 JETS 12

PIT owns the #5 seed in the AFC while the Chiefs are just outside at #7. PIT catches a break as KC's risk averse offense lacks the explosive ability to challenge their avg level defense. PIT does have a good matchup with Bell vs the #30 rush def the L4W & Roethlisberger vs a KC defense with a 21-4 ratio. PIT has the offensive edge but we are wary of their 2-6 ATS record as NDIV HF & have CIN on deck.

The Giants are 4-8 ATS as an AD but STL only cover as a fav this size was vs OAK off their 1st win of the year. PP leans with the home team but we disagree however the pressure that both teams bring here has the Total worth a small play.

BUF is 3-6 ATS away off a win & have NE on deck so this is a No Play.
