THE MOST UNIQUE POWER RATINGS IN THE COUNTRY

These Power Play Forecasts are the most unique in the country because they are based on Northcoast Sports' Private Power Ratings. Our ratings are unlike any computer rating, as we take into account all of the following: Strength of Opponents Individual Units (Rushing Offense and Defense, Passing Offense, & Defense, Scoring Offense and Defense, Garbage Yards, Weather, Injuries, Home Field Edge, and Successful Unbalanced Attacks). Here is how each is reflected:

Strength of Opponent: Our ratings do not just take the opposing team's overall power rating into account. For example, last year, Florida Atlantic's defense vs the rush was rated at 119. They faced Alabama and allowed "just" 256 yds rushing and dropped 5 spots in the national overall defensive ratings. However, Power Plays took into account the potent Crimson Tide run attack and had forecasted the Owls yielding 289 yds. Due to the fact they did better than the forecast, Power Plays raised their rating to 112 even though they slipped in the national (straight yardage) rankings. Another example last season was Wisconsin vs UTEP. Wisconsin held UTEP to just 77 yards rushing and stayed the same in the overall defense in the national statistics. However, our ratings had them rated at 15 and moved them down, as they should have yielded just 50 yards to a weak UTEP rush attack. Next time an announcer on TV tells you that a certain team is #3 in the country vs the run you better check Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings and see how good a rush defense they really have! The top twenty ratings in Power Ratings for each offensive and defensive category will be listed in each week's issue of Power Plays.

Garbage yards: These are yards that a team gains or allows in the final minutes of a game when it has been decided. For example, Team A is ahead 63-0 and allows 93 yards passing for a TD vs its fourth string defense. These yards are counted into national ratings, but not in Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings!

Weather: If a game is played in miserable weather conditions and is low scoring, the straight statistics credit the defense with outstanding performances. Our Power Ratings reflect the conditions and do not give excess credit to the defenses.

Injuries: When Missouri played Vanderbilt last year, Tigers QB James Franklin was injured early in the game. His backup, who had seen very little action (rFr), was not prepared and hit on 30%, 9-30 passes. The offensive coordinator simplified the offense. In the national statistics Vanderbilt's overall defense MOVED UP 8 NOTCHES. In Phil's Power Ratings they went from #11 dropping out of the Top 15, as the poor performance WAS NOT reflective of an outstanding performance by the defense.

Home Field Edges: The weekly projection of yards and points is weighted with the home field factored in.

Successful Unbalanced Attacks: Last season, Tulsa was held to 155 yards passing vs Houston. This dropped Tulsa in the national passing offense ratings & RAISED the Cougars in the pass defense ratings. In our ratings the two units remained rated around the same. Why? Tulsa rushed for 350 yards & DID NOT HAVE TO RELY ON THE PASS & when they did they hit 18 of 32. While Houston's pass defense looked good in the national ratings, only Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings reflected the TRUTH!

There you have it. More than just numbers, THESE RATINGS REFLECT the true strength of each unit and allow them to have the most accurate forecast of yards gained and points allowed in the country! No other rating system takes into account all the previous factors. Next time you hear that a team is rated third in the country in pass defense, just remember, yards are not everything and Northcoast Sports' Power Plays will show you how strong the team really is.

NORTHCOST SPORTS PLUS OR MINUS POWER RATINGS

The Power Ratings listed below are not based on the Power Plays, they are based on last year's final computer power rating numbers with the pluses and minuses from the off season changes factored in. They are then adjusted during the course of the season based on the final score of the games that are played on a weekly basis. The Power Ratings listed below can be used for you as a base power ratings to forecast up coming lines and strength of opponents, etc. Once again, they are not based on Power Plays and they differ from what we have shown in recent years, which has been our actual computer Power Ratings. These are Northcoast Sports Plus or Minus Power Ratings.

With all that said here are this week's PP Selections.

THANKSGIVING DAY, NOVEMBER 23

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for MISSISSIPPI and MISSISSIPPI ST.

Our Thurs night marquee will be a part of our Thanksgiving exec pkg for just \$125!

NO PLAY: MISSISSIPPI ST 40 MISSISSIPPI 23

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 24

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for BAYLOR and TCU.

PP is calling for a blowout win for TCU, which would put them into the B12 title game. The yards forecast favors TCU by 13 however, and we also lean with the dog making this a no play.

NO PLAY: TCU 33 BAYLOR 4

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for WESTERN MICHIGAN and TOLEDO.

A Toledo win will put them into the MAC title game for the first time s/04. While PP is calling for that to happen, it's also projecting for WM to keep it closer than expected & we agree.

4★ WESTERN MICHIGAN 30 (+) TOLEDO 41

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for VIRGINIA TECH and VIRGINIA.

PP is calling for this game to finish right at the line, but the yds suggest a closer finish.

NO PLAY: VIRGINIA TECH 28 VIRGINIA 21

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for NORTHERN ILLINOIS and CENTRAL MICHIGAN.

PP cannot decide on a winner, but we feel that NIU will be too physical in this matchup.

NO PLAY: NORTHERN ILLINOIS 30 CENTRAL MICHIGAN 30

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for OHIO and BUFFALO.

Despite being outgained by 42 yds, PP calls for OU to win by a td. While UB is proj'd to throw for 332 yds, the weather in Buffalo is always iffy this time of yr & OU'S ST's edge is huge.

3★ OHIO 34 BUFFALO 27

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for MISSOURI and ARKANSAS.

PP is giving Mizzou too much credit for their blowouts over inferior competition on the pts forecast. The yds only project a 4 pt MOV and we also like the Hogs to stay competitive.

NO PLAY: MISSOURI 45 ARKANSAS 29

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for NEW MEXICO and SAN DIEGO ST.

SDSt HC Long not only has a long history of success defending the option, but also on Sr day and there's no reason to believe that will stop this week as NM has faded down the stretch.

4.5★ SAN DIEGO ST 37 NEW MEXICO 10

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for NAVY and HOUSTON.

While Houston just defended the option last week, it wasn't your typical attack as Tulane threw 25 passes. Navy is forecasted to keep this game closer than expected & we agree.

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for MIAMI, FL and PITTSBURGH.

PP is calling for this game to finish right at the line & the yds suggest just a 2 pt MOV.

NO PLAY: MIAMI 32 PITTSBURGH 18

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for IOWA and NEBRASKA.

Both tms have been inconsistent and PP forecasts this game to finish at the opening line.

NO PLAY: IOWA 31 NEBRASKA 28

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for TEXAS STATE and TROY.

There's no doubt that Troy should win this game without much of a hiccup, but the yards forecast suggests a 12 pt MOV and the Trojans have struggled at 11-25 as a HF.

4★ TEXAS ST 13 (+) TROY 34

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for USF and UCF.

The winner of this game will play for the AAC title next week. While PP is calling for UCF to win by DD's, the yards suggest a much closer than expected outcome and we like the dog.

NO PLAY: UCF 41 USF 27

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for WKU and FIU.

These teams are evenly matched as FIU is projected to win by the slimmest of margins with the yards nearly even and the TO's and ST's also being about the same. No play.

NO PLAY: FIU 25 WKU 24

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for TEXAS TECH and TEXAS.

TT needs to pull off the upset to become bowl eligible, but PP is calling for Tx to win by 2 td's and finish with a 132 yard edge. We feel that the Red Raiders will stay competitive.

NO PLAY: TEXAS 32 TEXAS TECH 18

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for CALIFORNIA and UCLA.

UCLA fired HC Mora shortly before we went to press and OC Fisch is the interim HC.

NO PLAY: UCLA 32 CALIFORNIA 29

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for CONNECTICUT and CINCINNATI.

Despite being outgained by 66 yards, PP is projecting UConn to come into Cincy and pull off the outright upset. We disagree & lean with Cincy to send their Sr's off with a win.

NO PLAY: CONNECTICUT 30 CINCINNATI 24

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for BOSTON COLLEGE and SYRACUSE.

Due to the uncertainty surrounding Syracuse QB Dungey there's no line at presstime.

NO PLAY: BOSTON COLLEGE 30 SYRACUSE 26

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for MICHIGAN STATE and RUTGERS.

PP is calling for this gm to finish near the opening line with Rutgers keeping it just a tad closer than expected. The Scarlet Knights have kept games closer despite being largely outplayed.

NO PLAY: MICHIGAN ST 21 RUTGERS 9

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for INDIANA and PURDUE.

The winner will become bowl eligible and PP calls for Purdue to win the Old Oaken Bucket for the first time s/12. We disagree and feel Indy is the better team and will win outright.

NO PLAY: PURDUE 24 INDIANA 21

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for OHIO STATE and MICHIGAN.

PP is forecasting UM to keep 'The Game' closer than expected with OSU finishing with just an 83 yard edge. We disagree as the Bucks aren't taking any chances since their loss at Iowa.

NO PLAY: OHIO STATE 32 MICHIGAN 23

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for NORTH CAROLINA and NC STATE.

PP is calling for this gm to finish close to the opening line with NCSt finishing with a commanding 235 yd edge. The Tar Heels have looked better of late & we lean with the rivalry dog.

NO PLAY: NC STATE 35 NORTH CAROLINA 19

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for DUKE and WAKE FOREST.

The opening line is 12 and PP is calling for WF to win by that exact margin.

NO PLAY: WAKE FOREST 34 DUKE 22

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for APPALACHIAN STATE and GEORGIA STATE.

PP expects GSt to keep this game closer than expected and even gives the Panthers a slight yardage edge. We disagree as GST has struggled in their new home venue. Pass.

NO PLAY: APPALACHIAN ST 25 GEORGIA ST 20

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for VANDERBILT and TENNESSEE.

Tennessee has never lost 8 gms in their storied history and PP doesn't expect that to happen this yr. We also feel the Vols' end their ssn on a positive note & the yds suggest a 5 pt MOV.

While KSU is projected to win by the slimmest of margins, the yards forecast suggests ISU by 1 point. Regardless, this game will likely come down to the wire & is a true toss up.

Table with 7 columns: Team, Ttl Yds, Rush, Pass, Points, TO's, ST's. Rows for LOUISVILLE and KENTUCKY.

PP is calling for Louisville to win the Governors Cup by double digits, which is near the line.

NO PLAY: LOUISVILLE 40 KENTUCKY 29

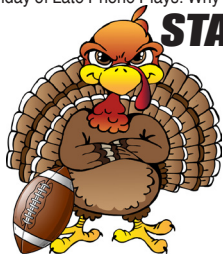
