4★ ALABAMA over Mississippi - This is the ultimate conf revenge gm for Bama, who had won 10 in a row SU in this series but LY suffered their only reg ssn loss. Bama was -4' and lost 23-17 with Wallace getting 2 td passes in the final 5:29. Bama had led 14-3 at the half and 17-10 in the 4Q. Bama had a 396-327 yd edge. The last 2 times Ole Miss upset Alabama, the Tide was 2-0 SU/ATS winning 42-7 at home (-11) in '02 in a battle of ranked teams and in '04 at home was -11' and won 28-7. In the 2 games they held Ole Miss to 207 ypg and 12 FD per/gm. The Tide are off a 37-10 (-34') win over Middle Tenn as RB Henry became the 1st SEC RB to rush for 3 td's in the 1st 2 gms s/08 (UGA's Moreno). It's safe to say Ole Miss' level of competition will rise just a tad as they enter after becoming just the 3rd tm in over 95Y to score 73+ pts in B2B gms! Bama has won 23 str SEC openers (9-4 ATS run), while The Rebels are just 1-26 all time in Tuscaloosa, with their only win being 22-12 in 1988. Roll Tide.

FORECAST: ALABAMA BY 17

3★ MIAMI, FL over Nebraska - The L/time that NU traveled to Miami to face the Hurricanes was in the '94 ssn Orange Bowl, NU won 24-17 finishing 13-0 (National Champs). Miami had a hard time early on at FAU on Friday as they held just a 20-17 lead at HT and were tied at 20 early 3Q, but then talent took over and the 'Canes responded by scoring the games final 24 pts to cover 44-20 (-18') and cash us another Friday night Marquee winner (just \$12 on VIP debit card system). RB Yearby had his first 100 yd rush gm of the ssn and also finished w/a car high 97 rec yds. QB Kaaya hit 21-32-287-1-0 and hasn't thrown an int in 3 str reg ssn gms. Miami had a 526-389 yd edge and also forced 5 TO's. NU won easily LW vs South Alabama 48-9. LY NU was -8 at home. Brad Kaaya passed for 359 yds which set a UM single gm record for passing yards by a true frosh. UM, down 3 late 3Q, fumbled and NU ret'd it 57 yds for a td in the play of the game and the main reason NU covered 41-31 (-8). This is a make it or break it year for Miami HC Golden and the Hurricanes with extra rest will get a comfortable win.

FORECAST: MIAMI, FL BY 17

3★ SYRACUSE over Central Michigan - The last/only trip to the Carrier Dome was in '99, CM was hammered 47-7 (+30) being outgained 495-241. We cashed a 3★ LPS along with a 2★ on these pages LW on Syracuse as they handled WF 30-17 (-3'). True frosh QB Dungey in his 1st start threw an 89 yd td pass in the 3Q as the Orange took the lead after being down 17-13 HT. SU was a bit fortunate as they were outg'd 419-370 & outFD'd 23-15, but were +3 in TO's. CM meanwhile, is off a 31-10 win over FCS Monmouth. LY CM was at home +4' but top RB Thomas Rawls was susp'd on Friday night and CM rushed for just 34 yds on 23 carries. WR Titus Davis also missed the game. SU got a 36 yd FR td to lead 10-3 and controlled matters from there with a 40-3 blowout road win and a 464-217 yd edge. Chippewas are 4-14 SU in road openers but 2 of the wins happened in the L3Y at B10 foes Iowa in '12 & Purdue LY! No sked edge for either team as CM has a big game vs Mich St on deck, while SU has LSU on deck and is off of their ACC opener. New QB Dungey looked good with a solid amount of starters around him and we cashed on the Orange LW and now with a start under Dungey's belt we feel even better.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Air Force (+) over MICHIGAN ST - First meeting. MSU is off a huge home win vs Oregon 31-28 (-4) and now has to take on the option. AF is 2-0 coming off a 37-16 win vs SJSU. AF led just 17-16 but scored 3 TDs in the 4Q. AF was 0-2 ATS LY as an AD while MSU is 5-3 as a HF. AF is 1-5 in L/6 road openers (only win at Navy in OT in '11). AF in '12 traveled to Michigan +21' and only lost 31-25. In '10 they were +16' vs #7 Okla and only lost 27-24. In fact, while they've dropped 7 in a row vs P5 teams, 4 have been by 7 pts or less. MSU is only giving up 70.5 Rush ypg. Michigan ST has a massive size edge at the line of scrimmage as well as talent but Air Force is catching Sparty in a letdown spot.

FORECAST: MICHIGAN ST BY 17

2★ BOWLING GREEN (+) over Memphis - BG was our underdog POW LW on these pages (+9) and came through with a 48-27 outright upset! BG trailed 20-13 in the 3Q and outscored MD 35-7 from then. BG also had 2 missed FGs and 2X was SODs in MD territory in the 1H. QB Johnson was 36-55-491-6-1 and BG held a 692-341 yd edge. MU was in unfamiliar territory LW as an AF vs a P5 tm (1st time s/89) in Kansas (-13). MU beat Kansas 55-23 despite losing TO's 3-0. MU hasn't started a ssn 3-0 since '04 which ironically is the last year these two last met in the GMAC Bowl (BG 52-13, -3). BG is 8-1 SU hosting non-conf foes incl 6 str wins by an avg of 27 ppg. LW was MU's 1st NC road gm since '04. Memphis has a short turnaround after this game vs Cincy (Thursday) and could be looking ahead.

FORECAST: BOWLING GREEN BY 6

2★ Illinois (+) over NORTH CAROLINA - These teams haven't met s/87, with NC winning 34-14. The Bill Cubit era is off to a fast start as Illinois is 2-0 and coming off a 44-0 shutout over FCS W Illinois. UNC is also off a FCS win LW, getting by NC A&T rather easily 53-14. The Tar Heels are 5-1 SU under Fedora in home non-conf gms vs FBS foes w/a avg score 46-21. While the HC at SMiss ('08-'11), Fedora was 7-1 SU hosting non-conf foes. Illinois has lost 12 of 13 road openers with the avg loss by 18 ppg. Illinois last won a non-conf AG in '07 (Syracuse). NC is in a sandwich between FCS NC A&T and Delaware. Illinois is also off a FCS w/a home date against Middle Tenn on deck so there's no sked edge either way. HC Cubit has the Illini believing in themselves and playing great and could pull off the road upset.

WK 3 SEPT 17 (THUR)

Clemson at LOUISVILLE - LY these two met for the first time. UL was +9' on the road. It was a def battle with the two teams combining for 493 yds and 22 FD's. Deshaun Watson was inj'd early and Stoudt hit 20-33-162. Down by 6, UL went 79/5 in the last 1:20 but on 4&gl from the 2, threw incom in the EZ. UL is coming off a surprising 34-31 (-13') loss vs Houston and is 0-2 SU for the 1st time s/98. Jackson St'd at QB, but Bolin was in during the 4Q as the gm had 5 lead changes. UL had their 53 yd fg at blk'd at the end, while UH had a 462-395 yd edge. Clemson is off a 41-10 (-17) win over App St as QB Watson threw for 248 yds & 3 td's. CU is 9-2 SU in conf road games winning by an avg of 23 ppg with their losses being to FSU & BC LY. WK 3 SEPT 18 (FRI)

Florida St at BOSTON COLLEGE - FSU has won 6 of L/10 meetings incl 5 str SU. The visitor in this series is on a 7-3 ATS run. L2Y BC has given FSU their closest game of the reg ssn. LY the Eagles (+17') controlled the LOS w/a 240-110 rush yd edge but their bid for the upset came up

just short as FSU kicked a 26-yd FG w/:03 left for the 3 pt win. LTH ('13) was the closest reg ssn MOV for the Noles in their Nat'l Champ ssn as they trailed 17-3 early 2Q but scored 35 of the next 38 pts incl a Hal Mary td pass on the final play of the 1H and won 48-34 (-23). FSU does have a bye next week and only opened with Texas St and USF (Cook was 1st FSU RB w/200+ rush yds s/88, Sammie Morris) so this is their most important game of the month of Sept and BC has only played a couple of FCS foes.

New Mexico at ARIZONA ST - Prior to LY the L/mtg was in 1977. ASU outscored NM 26-2 in the 2H limiting the Lobos to 84 ttl yds after a sluggish 1H that actually was a one score gm until :03 before HT in a 58-23 (-23') win. The Lobos haven't won in Tempe s/34 (1-12-1 in all-time visits). ASU is off a tougher than expected 35-21 win over FCS Cal Poly in a gm that was tied at 21 mid 4Q. The Sun Devils did have 531-330 yd & 28-20 FD edges but also were -2 TO's. NM is off a 40-21 (-4) home loss to Tulsa. They had a chance to take the lead late 3Q, but missed a 42 yd fg and it was all TU from that point on as the Lobos were outg'd 600-390 & out FD'd 31-18. Graham is 11-7 ATS as a HF, but ASU does have USC on deck. WK 3 SEPT 19 (SAT)

Wake Forest by 4 over ARMY - WF has won 8 str in this series by 15 ppg (3-0 ATS run). LY Army (-2) led 21-14 entering the 4Q but WF won 24-21 with Army fmb'ing at their own 41 into 2:47 left. Army had a 359-338 yd edge and rushed for 341 (5.8). LTH ('13) WF trailed 2-0 into the 2Q & 11-10 w/3:44 3Q. Two of WF's L/3 poss ended in td's while Army had to punt, was SOD at A36 & time ran out at the WF2 after 78/13pl as the Deacons won 25-11 (-2'). We cashed a 3★ LPS & a 2★ on these pages LW going against WF in their 30-17 (+3') loss at Syracuse. QB Wolford threw for 373 yds but had 3 costly int's. WF did have 419-370 yd & 23-15 FD edges. Army did cover in their 22-17 (+7) loss at UConn. The Black Knights were outg'd 415-265 & outFD'd 23-9. They surprisingly also lost the TOP battle 39:01-20:59. WF is just 5-21 SU in road openers (6 str losses w/2 in OT) & just 6-27 SU on the road s/09 while home teams are on 9-3 SU run in Army games. Upset?

Temple by 13 over MASSACHUSETTS - First meeting. Minutemen are 0-3 SU/ATS in home openers since moving up to the FBS. From 2007-'11 the Owls ply'd as a MAC member going 25-15 in conf gms. This marks the 1st time facing a MAC foe since. UMass had a bye to open the ssn & lost at Colorado 48-14 (+13). True frosh RB Young had 62 yds (8.9) as the lone bright spot as they were outg'd 558-397, outFD'd 32-20 & were -2 in TO's. Temple is off B2B outright upset wins, the latest a 34-26 (+6') victory at Cincy despite being outg'd 557-296 & outFD'd 34-13 as they benefitted from +4 in TO's. RB Thomas followed up his 135 yd (4.7) performance against PSU with 193 yds (7.4) LW. Temple won both their games LY as an AF winning at CT 36-10 (-6') and Tulane 10-3 (-2').

MICHIGAN by 35 over Unlv - First meeting. Ironically all of the Wolverines non-conf opp's TY reside in the MT/Pacific time zone. We easily cashed our top weekly LPS play along with a 4★ on these pages LW on UM as they dominated Oreg ST 35-7 (-14'). The Wolves had 405-138 yd, 21-12 FD & 38:01-21:59 TOP edges in new HC Harbaugh's home cch'g debut. UNLV is off a 37-3 (+29) home loss to UCLA. St'g QB Decker was inj' 1Q (hamstring) and is a ? for TW (CS). The Rebels are all'g 535.5 ypg this young season. UNLV is just 19-43-2 ATS away from Sam Boyd Stadium and are on a 2-8 ATS run as a DD dog. HC Tony Sanchez played at NMex St and was a HS cch for 16Y so this will be the first time one of his teams goes in front of 100,000+ fans. Harbaugh was 3-5 at home his first year at Stanford but then went 13-5 ATS his last 5. Back then he took over a 1-11 team so is on much more solid footing here and trying to develop a new attitude so we expect him to put the hammer down when available.

Ball St by 4 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - Important game for both sides here as this is not only the MAC opener, but also the Division opener as well. LY EM had 30-19 FD & 503-440 yd edges but were -3 TO's. that led to 21 pts for BSU. EM trailed 35-3 early 3Q but scored on 5 of their L/6 drives to get within 15 and cover (+16'). Cardinals have won 5 str trips here but 3 were by 2 pts or less. LTH ('13) EM (+10) took the opening drive for a td (XP ng) & BSU answered with td's on their f/4 drives to lead 27-6 after 1Q & 51-20 into the 4Q. Eagles have lost 9 of 10 (last win '10) SU in this series. EM is off an outright 48-29 (+13') win at Wyoming. The Eagles hadn't won a non-conf FBS AG in 27Y & did it with a backup QB! Roback hit 17-24-330 and had a 38-7 lead late 2Q. BSU is off a 56-23 (+30) loss at Texas A&M as they were down 49-3 at HT! EM is just 9-14 ATS at home, but did cover at home vs ODU in the opener.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 18 over Charlotte - 1st meeting between these new CUSA rivals. MT enters this gm 1-1 SU/2-0 ATS and is coming off a 37-10 (+34') loss at Bama getting outg'd 532-275 & outFD'd 28-15. They did score a late td w/6:11 left to play. Charlotte meanwhile, is off a 34-10 win over FCS Presbyterian after leading 24-0 at HT. MT is on a 5-2-1 ATS run as a Conf HF, but both of those losses took place LY. Since joining CUSA, the Blue Raiders are 2-0 SU/ATS in their conf opener, beating FAU 42-35 (-3') in '13 and ODU 41-28 (+3') LY, but both of those were on the road.

MINNESOTA by 21 over Kent St - These schools have met just once ('06) with UM winning 44-0 (-15). UM had a 468-282 yd & 25-13 FD edge. Only 2 of KSU's 10 drives ended in punts as they had 3 fmb, 3 int, missed fg & EOH. KSU HC Haynes was apart of Big 10 staff's MSU/OSU from 2003-'11 going a perfect 8-0 SU vs UM. The Gophers are off an OT 23-20 (-6) win in the attitude at Colorado St. After scoring what appeared to be the GW td w/55 left, UM all'd a 37 yd fg w/:00 left to force OT. The Gophers rec'd a fumble on the 1st play of OT & then kicked an 18 yd fg (413-314 yd & 23-14 FD edges). KSU is off a 45-13 win over FCS Delaware St. Golden Flashes kicker April Goss became the 2nd female to score for an FBS tm as she kicked a PAT in the 2Q. KSU is on a 0-8 SU/ATS run vs the B10 & UM plays a good bully and is 9-3 ATS as a HF.

FAU by 4 over Buffalo - First meeting. FAU had it's juices flowing early on hosting in-state rival Miami last Friday as they were only down 20-17 at HT and then tied it up at 20 early 3Q. It went downhill from there as the Owls all'd 24 unanswered to lose 44-20 (+18') as we cashed our Friday Night Marquee on the 'Canes. The Owls were -5 TO's and making matters worse was the fact that st'g QB Johnson was inj'd early on & RB Warren, who had rushed for 132 on just 11 carries was also hurt before HT. The loss also snapped an incredible streak where the dog in FAU games had won 11 str ATS. Buff is off a 27-14 (+20) loss in heavy rain at PSU (bk door cover). The Bulls were down just 10-7 late 3Q and all'd just 328 ttl yds in the gm, however they were held to just 274 yds and the FD's were even at 15. FAU is just 1-5 ATS in the 2nd gm of B2B home slates.

WISCONSIN by 38 over Troy - First meeting. We easily cashed a 2★ on these pages as well as our Marquee College 900 POD on Wisconsin as they dominated a less physical Miami. Oh team 58-0 (-31) in new HC Chryst's home debut with a 451-157 yd & 26-9 FD edges. Surprisingly, the Badgers rushed for just 188 (4.2) as Miami all'd 240 rush ypg on the road LY. Troy is off a 44-16 win over FCS Charleston Southern, which was also new HC's Brown 1st career win in what was also his home debut. Concerning for the Trojans is the fact that they all'd 263 rush yds LW. Since Troy moved up to FBS status ('02) they have faced 3+ Power-5 conf schools in the same yr 6x's ('02, '03, '06, '07, '08 & '13) going a combined 0-21 SU and being outscored by 25 ppg. UW is on an 18-11 ATS run at home (all as a fav). There's no real sked edge for either side as while UW only has a home date with Hawaii on deck, Troy has a bye.

OHIO ST by 40 Northern Illinois - These schools have met just once ('06) and ironically that was also when OSU opened the ssn AP #1. They were -17 at home and jumped out to a 28-0 lead :05 into the 2Q and led 26-3 at the half in a 35-12 win. The Buckeyes offense looked sluggish in their non covering 38-0 (-41) home opening win over Hawaii. Their 363 ttl yds was their lowest since they had 293 at PSU LY. The emotional win & short week could be the reason. RB Elliott rushed for 3 td's & in his last 6 gms dating back to LY, has 14 rush td's while the shutout was their 5th under HC Meyer. NIU is off a 57-26 win over FCS Murray St. NIU was down 7-6 early 2Q, but then went on a 34-9 run into the 4Q. OSU is 2-1 ATS against the MAC under Urban Meyer, winning by a combined 162-30 score. Despite not covering LW, Meyer is still 39-13-1 ATS against non-conf foes. NIU has won their last 2 road openers in outright upsets of B10 teams beating Iowa 30-27 (+3) and N'wstrn 23-15 (+6'), but after LW, Meyer will have the defending Nat'l Champion Buckeyes more focused.

Nc State by 10 over OLD DOMINION - LY was the only meeting. The Wolfpack (-16') actually trailed in the 3Q 28-25 before outscoring the Monarchs 21-6 in the final 16:01 to prevail 46-34. ODU finished w/a 504-495 yd edge while the FD's were even at 28. ODU is off a 24-10 win over FCS Norfolk St. ODU had their punt blk'd for a td and were down 10-7 2Q, but led 14-10 at HT. RB Lawry had his 2nd str 200+ rush gm & the Monarchs had a 458-261 yd edge. NCST is off a 35-0 shutout over FCS EKU. This marks the first time in ODU history they will host a Power-5 conference foe. NCST is an amazing 1-15 ATS as an AF with 12 outright upset losses!

OKLAHOMA by 31 over Tulsa - Not surprisingly OU has won 8 str in this instate series by 38 ppg (3rd str ssn ply'ing). LY OU led 31-0 at HT w/a 398-95 yd edge & went on to win 52-7 (-24'). OU is on a 5-0 ATS run in the series, covering by an avg of 16.4 ppg! LTH ('13) Tulsa trailed 34-7 early 2H getting no closer than 17 pts the rest of the way. The Sooners are off an emotional come-from-behind 31-24 (E) 2OT win in their 1st ever trip to Knoxville. QB Mayfield struggled in the F/3Q, but got hot in the 4Q/OT. OU was down 17-0 2Q & 17-3 4Q before getting two 4Q td's, the last w/:40 left to send it into OT. While the Sooners had just a 20-19 FD edge, they did have a 348-254 yd advantage. TU is off a 40-21 (-4) win at NM as both RB's Langer & Brewer rushed for 100+ yds and the Golden Hurricane had over 600+ yds for the 2nd str gm. TU is 0-9 SU L6Y vs ranked foes, outscored on avg 47-19 & on a 1-5 ATS run vs them. HC Montgomery spent the L7Y w/BU (LY OC) going 3-4 vs OU but LY BU traveled here and had 544 yds offense and 31 FD's in a 48-14 road win. TU is on a 9-17 overall ATS run and their non-conf ATS win LW was their 1st in 10 gms. Both teams have byes on deck.

TEXAS A&M by 35 over Nevada - These schools have faced each other just once and that was way back in 1950 with A&M winning 48-18. Nevada is coming off 44-20 (+11') home loss to Ariz. Down just 21-13 at HT, the Wolf Pack all'd 20 str pts in the 2H. A&M is off a 56-23 (-30) home opening win over Ball St (1st gm at Kyle Field since the \$485 million worth of renovations were completed.) The Aggies led 49-3 at HT & both QB's comb'd to hit 19-27-191-4-0. Nevada won at Cal 31-24 (+10) in '12 but lost their L/3 P5 road trips to Ari, FSU & UCLA by 32 ppg. A&M has won all 10 games vs current MW teams winning by an avg 40-16. (L/gm '09 38-30 vs Utah St). Tough spot for NV QB Stewart who is making just his 4th car start and 1st on the road and it just so happen to be at College Station in front of the 12th man. A&M does have a big gm vs Ark on deck.

OREGON by 42 over Georgia St - This is a \$ game for GST & LY's gm at Washington also netted the tm a solid payday, but it could also be argued ruined the remainder of their ssn b/c 3 key ply'r's went down w/ssn-ending inj's. Oregon is off a physical 31-28 (+4) loss at MSU despite having 432-389 yd & 26-21 FD edges as they were SOD 4X. GST is coming off perhaps their biggest win in school history, a 34-32 (+6') win at NMSU, their first win over an FBS school. UO is 13-8 as a DD fav vs FBS foes under HC Helfrich, while GST is a perfect 7-0 as a 20+ pt dog. GST has played five P5 tms in their history going 0-6 (Clemson, Washington, Tennessee, WV & Alabama 2x) losing by an avg score of 46-7 (outgained on avg 468-209). UO does have their P12 opener vs Utah on deck while the Panthers have a bye.

Rice by 4 over NORTH TEXAS - LY's meeting was a tail of 2 halves. NT led 21-14 at HT thanks in part to a 100-yd KR td. NT started the 2H fumbling the opening KO & had a int ret'd 60 yds for a td. That set the tone for 80 ttl yds (2.6 ypp) in the 2H as Rice won 41-21 (-14'). LTH ('13) on a Thurs night Rice lost 28-16 (+3') despite leading 16-7 mid-2Q. NT had a bye to open the ssn so their 1st gm was LW when they lost 31-13 (+4') at SMU as QB McNulty struggled hitting just 16-34-128-0-2. The Mean Green were outg'd 444-240 & out FD'd 27-17. Rice meanwhile, is off a back and forth 42-28 (+14) loss at Texas. After spotting the 'Horns 21 pts, the Owls scored 14 pts to trail 21-14 at HT. UT then scored 21 str in the 3Q & then Rice scored the gms final 14 str incl getting a gbg td w/:36 for the backdoor cover. Rice did have 462-277 yd & 30-11 FD edges but also had 5 TO's. The Mean Green are 16-7 SU/15-8 ATS at Apogee Stadium (opened in '11) and have won 3 str home openers by 33 ppg. The HT is 3-0 SU/ATS, but Rice is also 3-1 SU/ATS in this series.

KANSAS ST by 10 over Louisiana Tech - These schools haven't met s/'01. LT had a 300 yd passer (FI Trans Driskel), 100 yd rusher (Dixon; 5th str in reg ssn gms) & 100 yd rec (T. Taylor) but it still wasn't enough as they lost at WKU last Thurs 41-38 (-1') in their CUSA opener. Down 21-3 2Q, LT clawed back to 27-24 early 3Q, and scored the gms final w/:27 left but their outside kick went OOB. The Bulldogs secondary was scorched for 441 (74%). KSU is off a 30-3 (-17) win at UTSA as QB Hubener, in his 1st car start at any level (Incl HSI) threw for 243 & ran for 58 as the Wildcats had 418-229 yd & 22-14 FD edges. Despite the ATS road loss LW, LT is on a 19-8 ATS run on the road, while HC Holtz is still 37-19-1 ATS as a dog incl 20-7-1 ATS when his team is .500 or better. Overall LT is on an 11-4 ATS run vs FBS foes, while HC Snyder is 11-18 ATS vs non conf but they have a bye on deck & should hold nothing back.

GEORGIA by 14 over South Carolina - SC's loss LTH ('13) snapped their longest win streak vs UGA (at 3). SC only trailed 34-30 but UGA hit a 85 yd td pass w/:13:00 left. SC couldn't score after a 1st&g at the UGA8 (UGA ran out L/8:28) and lost 41-30 (+3'). LY UGA's only lead of the gm was 10-7 mid-1Q. After a 75/11pl td drive UGA cut it to 3 w/:7:10 left. SC then was int'd & UGA was set up 1st&GL at SC4 but missed a 28-yd fg. SC ran out the L/4:24 & pulled the 38-35 upset (+6'). SC is off a stunning home loss to KY 26-22 (-7') and making matters worse is they lost st'g QB Mitchell to a seperated shoulder. SC was down 24-7 at HT but cut the deficit to 2 mid 4Q, but their 2 pt conv at went the other way as KY rec'd the fumble and ret'd it for 2 pts of their own. UGA RB Chubb hit the century mark in his 10th str gm as the Bulldogs beat Vandy 31-14 (-20'). The HT is 5-1 SU/4-0-1 ATS in this series. The L2Y SC has caught UGA off of games vs

ranked CU (#8, #6). This time UGA is off ULM and Vandy and playing with revenge with only an FCS foe on deck making this, by far, their most important game in the month of September. Despite the non-covering win LW, HC Richt is 81-43-2 ATS in SU victories

NAVY by 1 over East Carolina - EC won LTH ('11) 38-35 (+12'). EC QB Davis connected on 26 consec passes (all in 1H), breaking T Martin ('98) & A Rodgers ('04) rec. Down 4, EC got a td w/:14 left, Navy's 42-yd'r hit upright on final pl. In the L/meeting ('12) Navy won 56-28 (+3') w/a 563-338 yd & 32-20 FD edge. With 6:55 2Q the gm was tied 14-14. From that pt Navy fired off 28 str until the 4Q (248-3 edge during span!). EC is off a physical 31-24 (+20) loss at UF and had a chance to tie the gm, but QB Kemp fumbled. The Pirates had a 20-17 FD edge and were slightly outg'd 373-333. Navy meanwhile comes in fresh off a bye after beating FCS Colgate 48-10 in wk 1. These games tend to be high scoring with the last 3 combining for an avg 89.3 ppg as EC's spread offense is foreign to Navy and Navy's option foreign to EC. The HT is 0-3 SU/0-4 ATS and there have been 3 str outright upsets in this series. Navy is actually a bit more exp'd than EC TY (surprising for a military acad). Nutiamotolo is 13-17 as a HF, but McNeill is 11-19 ATS on the road.

LSU by 10 over Auburn - Early-ssn road trips have been historically tough for Auburn, which hasn't won in Baton Rouge s/'99. The good news for Auburn backers is it's a day-time kickoff as LSU is 46-5 in night gm's at Tiger Stadium under Les Miles (2 losses LY). LSU's winning % is a full 8% pts lower in day gm's (.665). Auburn survived the ultimate scare as they needed OT to defeat FCS Jax St as QB Johnson became the 1st SEC QB to throw 5+ int's in the 1st two gms s/'09 (UT's Crompton). LSU had their opener cancelled and won their SEC opener at MSU LW 21-19 (-4). The Tigers just couldn't put the Bulldogs away as they scored the gms 1st 14 pts & took a 14-3 lead into HT. Down 21-6 4Q, MSU scored two td's, the last w/:4:00 left. This game has been dominated by the HT going 13-2 SU (10-4-1 ATS), LSU though, is 7-0 SU at home vs Aub winning by an avg of 31-15.

Virginia Tech by 10 over PURDUE - First meeting. Purdue is off a 38-14 win over FCS Indiana St while VT is off a 42-3 hammering of FCS Furman. VT QB Motley was able to get an easy foe to make his 1st college start and he responded by finishing 16-24-233-2-0 & ran for another score. Obviously this will be his 1st road start, but fortunately for Hokie nation, Purdue isn't known for having a significant home field advantage (just 4-11 L/2+ yrs). VT has won 20 of their L/22 road openers (lost at LSU in '07 & at Pitt in '12) incl a 35-21 win LY at #8 Ohio St. PU is 3-9 ATS as a HD but this is VT's first AG and VT is 1-7 ATS as an AF and just 16-34-1 overall vs FBS competition.

OKLAHOMA ST by 31 over Utsa - These 2 meet for a 3rd str ssn. LY when these two met before 54,577 here, it was the largest road crowd UTSA had played in front of in their brief history. That situation favored a veteran UTSA team vs an inexp'd OSU team yet OSU (-13') rolled to a 43-13 win. Now OSU has the exp'd team (16 ret str's) while UTSA has just 5. LW OSU won vs an FCS tm 32-8. UTSA lost to KSt 30-3 who started a QB that had never started a gm at any level! Gundy has been known to put the hammer down and is 28-13-1 ATS as a HF. OSU has Texas on deck whereas UTSA is playing their 3rd str game vs a P5 foe.

NOTRE DAME by 6 over Georgia Tech - Last met in '07 and GT won 33-3, the most lopsided opening season loss in ND history. ND would finish 3-9 that ssn. LW ND was up 26-12 vs UVA when QB Zaire was lost for the ssn. UVA came back to take the lead 27-26. Backup QB Shizer lead an 8/80 drive and threw a 36 yd GW TD. GT is off an easy 65-10 win vs Tulane. GT ran for 439 yds. GT is 5-0 ATS on the road. Paul Johnson was the HC at Navy in '07 when they ended a 43 game losing streak to ND that year with his option and the Irish have struggled vs Navy's option in recent years with Navy covering the last 2.

WASHINGTON by 4 over Utah St - These two haven't met s/'98. The Aggies have lost 32 str when facing a current P5 team on the road. USU is off a 24-14 (+11') loss at rival Utah on Friday. The gm was tied at 14 at HT, but USU as shutout in the 2H. After looking rusty in his 1st gm back from inj, QB Keeton looked more like himself hitting 22-35-256-2-2 & rushing for 46 yds, but did take a big hit on his knee and was able to stay in the gm. The Aggies had a 373-327 yd edge but were done in by -3 TO's. UW is off a win vs an FCS tm 49-0. UW is 6-2 ATS as a HF. Chris Petersen was 6-0 vs Utah St with their avg win 48-14 as a HC at Boise. The Huskies have won 10 in a row hosting non-conf foes.

TEXAS ST by 1 over Southern Miss - These two met in '13 in the season opener. TXSt was +8' on the road and pulled the outright upset 22-15. They led 14-0 but then trailed 15-14 before getting a td in the final minutes. S Miss had a 400-207 yd edge but were -5 in TO's. SM is 1-12 SU in road openers incl 10 str losses by 23 ppg. LW both TXSt and SM won vs FCS tms 63-24 and 52-6. TXSt is just 1-5 ATS as a HF. SM is just 2-17 SU on the road the L3Y but were 4-2 as an AD. SM is 0-5 ATS in rd openers.

Cincinnati by 24 over MIAMI, OH - LW we called for Wisconsin to roll over MU and that is exactly what happened as MU lost 58-0 in a 2★ selection on these pages. MU had just 9 FDs and 157 yds. LW UC lost as a HF to Temple 34-26. Temple actually lead 34-12 in the 4Q. Cincy had a 557-226 yd edge but 5TO's and 100 yd KR were too much to overcome. The Bearcats were 4-0 ATS as an AF LY. MU has lost 10 str vs FBS NC opp. MU has lost 9 str in the Victory Bell series & LY led 14-10 late 2Q. Down 7, MU missed a fg & UC ran out L/5:40. The Bearcats have won 4 str in Oxford incl the LTH. It was 0-0 until UC went 79/16pl (7:41 TOP) scoring a td w/:55 left. That shutout marked UC's 2nd str here as Miami hasn't scored in 9 str Q's.

TOLEDO by 10 over Iowa St - UT pulled off a huge upset over Ark 16-10 (+21) LW. UT was outgained 515-318 (-15 FD). Ark was SOD at the UT 6 in the 4Q and the gm ended with Ark on the UT 13. The win was UT's 1st over an SEC opp. ISU dropped their gm to Iowa LW 31-17 but lead 17-10 at HT. These two have met 3 times and the games have been decided by 2, 1, and 7 pts. The HT is 3-0 ATS. UT hosted this game in '06 and '07. LY's gm had 2 ties & 5 lead changes. Tied 23-23 early 4Q ISU went 75/11pl (5-yd td pass), forced a punt and 85/16pl (14-yd td pass). Toledo did cut the deficit to 7 w/:55 left but their outside failed. UT is 1-3-1 ATS as a HF.

ARKANSAS by 10 over Texas Tech - Arkansas' coach Beilema did not look good LW after complaining about Ohio St's schedule, then losing at home vs Toledo 16-10 (-21.5). The potent AR run gm was held to just 3.3 ypc. UA did hold 515-318 yd and 30-15 FD edges. UA also had a PR called back and was SOD at UT 6 and ended the gm on UT's 13. UA has had just 3 true non-conf AG games L9Y and are 0-3 SU in those. Arkansas is 29-7 vs Texas Tech incl a 49-28 win LY but that was first meeting since both were in the SWC in '91. Gm was tied 3 times as UA outscored TT 14-0 in 4Q. TT was 0-3 LY ATS vs NC opp but covered LW vs UTEP, 69-20 (-20.5). Texas Tech has TCU on deck while Ark opens up SEC play vs TAMU.

NW followed up their upset win over Stanford in wk 1 with a 41-0 shutout over FCS EIU LW, while Duke also had a shutout, 55-0 over FCS NC Central. The Blue Devils are on a 18-7-1 ATS run overall. Sked edge goes to NW who returns home to face Ball St, while Duke has their conf opener with GT on deck. NW is 8-3 SU in non-conf AG's while the Blue Devils are 1-10 SU s/'96 at home vs non-conf P5 schools (win came LY vs KU). NW outplayed a solid Stanford team in wk 1 and still seems to be a bit under the radar. We'll side with the Wildcats in this matchup of quality academic institutions as we go for B2B outright underdog winners!

Colorado by 8 over Colorado St - Denver. CO. This is the 89th Rocky Mountain Showdown played every year s/'95. CU is 5-2 s/'07 in Denver vs rival CSU, avg win by 15 ppg (losses by 10 ppg). CSU is 7-17 SU s/'87 and the last time they won 2 in a row SU was back in '99 and '00. LY CU led 17-7 in the 2H but CSU from the 9:38 3Q mark would score 24 unanswered pts with a 252-95 yd edge and won 31-17 (+2). CU hasn't been 3-0 s/'08. LW CU rolled over Umass 48-14 (-13). CU racked up 390 Rush yds. CSU almost pulled an upset LW at Minnesota losing 23-20 in OT. 4 TO's killed the Rams incl a fmb1 in 1st pl of OT. CSU was 4-1 ATS vs NC Opp LY. There have actually been 5 outright upsets in the last 6Y and 10 outright upsets in the 17Y.

MARYLAND by 6 over Usf - We won on the Underdog POW LW with BG (+9) vs MD as BG won outright 48-27! MD lead 20-13 in the 3Q but BG outscored them 35-7 the rest of the way. MD allw'd 692 yds and 35 FD's! The score could have been even worse as BG missed 2 FGs and 2 SOD in the 1H. MD was 4-1 LY ATS off a SU loss. In the tm's first gm LY UM trailed 17-14 into the 4Q but w/12:25 left got a td off a blk'd punt, added a fg while int'ing & forcing a TOD on USF's L/2 drives. USF is 3-12 ion the road with wins by just 3, 8 & 1 as the tms came in a combined 1-17. USF played tough LW vs FSU losing 34-14 but were tied at 7 at HT. FSU RB Cook did run for 266. MD has a rivalry gm at WVU up next.

MISSOURI by 17 over Connecticut - First meeting, Missouri struggled LW vs Ark St, winning 27-20 (-10.5). Ark St actually lead at HT 17-10 and the gm was tied until 0:44 left in the 3Q. MU's RB's were 20-63 as Hansbrough continues to deal with inj's and played sparingly. QB Mauk did have 75 yds rushing and threw for 3 TDs. MU's D stifled Ark St, holding them to just 217 yds and 3 TO's. The Tigers only allowed 37 yds of O in the 2H. Tigers under Pinkel are 19-4 hosting non-conf FBS foes losing twice to non-Power-5 schools ('01 vs BG 20-13 & '05 vs NM 45-35). MU has started 3-0 8x's in Pinkel's 14Y career (5x's 2-1). CT is 2-0 for the 1st time s/'08 winning both by 5 pts over a FCS (as a Dog) and Army (-7). LW CT outgained Army 415-265 in the 22-17 win. CT's just 3-12 ATS as an AD and this is their first road trip. MU has their SEC opener on deck vs Kentucky but LY at home beat the top team in the AAC, UCF -11 38-10.

KENTUCKY by 1 over Florida - KY is 1-0 in the SEC for 1st tm s/'07 after beating South Car LW 26-22, ending a 22 gm SEC Rd losing streak. KY now tries to end UF's 28 gm active win streak which is now the longest streak in the ncaa. KY got a defensive 2PC for the deciding points. UF had covered 7 in a row in this series but LY were fortunate to escape with a SU win. UF hit a 51 yd fg with 3:52 left in the game to tie it at 20 and won it in 3OT (-18') at home, 36-30. KY has not been 2-0 in SEC play since '77. KY was 3-1 LY as an HF but didn't cover in the opener vs ULL. UF failed to impress LW vs ECU winning 31-24. UF trailed in 3Q 14-10 and ECU had the FD edge 20-17. UF also had an IR. McElwain has not yet chosen a starting QB but Grier did throw 2 TDs. UF follows this up with a rivalry gm at Tennessee.

INDIANA by 6 over Wku - IU is looking to start 3-0 for 1st time s/'10 and will be favored at home. Wku is coming off a 41-38 (+1) Thurs night home win over LT in their CUSA opener but it was costly as RB Allen (2,000+ rush/rec yds comb'd LY) suffered a gruesome leg inj and is OFY. The Hilltoppers had a commanding 21-3 2Q lead and hung on as LT scored a td w/27 left but the outside kick went OOB. After throwing for just 209 yds in the ssn opener, QB Doughty lit up LT for 441 (74%), his 3rd 400+ yd gm in his last 4 dating back to last ssn (incl bowl). RFB RB Derby relieved Allen and avg'd just 2.8 on 14 carries, but Indiana grad trans RB Anthony Davis had a 28 yd run to the 1 yd line and should get some carries against his former teammates. LW IU lead 29-22 late in the 4Q. FIU drove to the IU 2 but threw an INT that was returned 96 yds.

California by 3 over TEXAS - Texas looked awful in their opnr vs ND. They didn't look much better LW vs Rice despite winning 42-28 (-14). Rice had a 462-277 yd edge and 30-11 FD's while Rice's TOP was over 44m! UT held a huge ST edge with a PR TD and two more set up with short fields. UT forced 5 TO's and also had a FR. UT is 5-0 SU in this series and in '11's Holiday Bowl was -3 and won 21-10. Cal won LW vs SDSU 35-7. Cal may feel the loss of C Matt Cochran - who's no longer w/m - for 1st time in this gm, as Texas has the sort of pass rush that can exploit any of the Bears' holes on the OL. Texas, was #12 in nation w/40sks L/ssn. UT is 38-8 hosting non-conf foes s/'96 (B12 started). Cal is 7-4 in road openers but when doing so vs a non-ranked foe are 7-1.

OREGON STATE by 6 over San Jose State - These 2 last met in '97 with OSU winning 26-7. SJSU L/won in Corvallis in '82. LW OSU traveled to face a hungry Michigan team and lost 35-7 (+15.5) which we cashed as our 4★ Key Selection in Power Sweep & Top Weekly Late Phone play as well! OSU had just 138 yds and was 1-11 on 3D. LW SJSU lost 37-16 to AF. SJSU had trouble stopping the option, giving up 428 rush. They trailed 17-16 into the 4Q but gave up the final 20 pts. OSU was 1-5 ATS LY OFF a SU Loss. OSU is 5-1 SU hosting non-conf foes with their avg win by 26 ppg but this is the first with Andersen in charge. SJSU was 0-6 as an AD LY and 0-1 TY but Oregon St does have a Friday night gm vs Stanford on deck. San Jose cannot figure out a starting QB as Gray and Potter continue to split snaps.

TCU by 38 over Smu - TCU is favored big in the battle for the Iron Skillet. This is the 95th mtg. LY TCU was -31 on the road and won 56-0. The win was the most lopsided in the 94 gm history. SMU ended 4 poss on the TCU 1, 30, 47 and 5 yd lines. LTH SMU led 10-7 at the half but then lost 48-17 (+17'). SMU played respectably in Gm 1 vs Baylor, trailing 28-21 at HT but depth caught up with them and lost 56-21. LW SMU beat North Texas 31-13 and had a 444-220 yd edge. TCU is a perfect 8-0 ATS at home. SMU was 0-4 ATS vs non conf Opp LY but has started TY 2-0. TCU does have a trip to TT on deck but will not overlook their nearby rival.

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Utep by 6 over NEW MEXICO STATE - Miners are going for a 7th str 1-10 rivalry win. LTH in Kugler's 1st win as HC, NMST answered each of UTEP's first 3 td's (21-21 mid-3Q). From there UTEP scored 21 unanswered holding NMST to 72 yds. UTEP rushed for 344 yards, its most in a game versus a Division I opponent since 1991. LY NMST was looking for their 1st 3-0 str s/'99. The Aggies led 10-7 w/13:17 2Q but from that pt until :06 into the 4Q all'd 21 unanswered being outgained 271-121. This is UTEP's 3rd Str RG, losing F2 117-33 vs Ark and Texas Tech. UTEP is 6-0 SU and 5-1-1 ATS and the visitor is actually 7-2-1 ATS in the I10 rivalry. LW NM St gave Georgia St their 1st ever FBS victory. UTEP is at its best when it can control the LOS and LY rushed for 344 (5.9) and NMST all'd 309.9 ypg rush and 6.3 ypc. This is 3rd straight road game for UTEP but at 0-2 a must win if they are to get back to a bowl and NMST let one of those games you have marked as W's slip away last week.

PENN ST by 10 over Rutgers - Penn St, 0-2 as a Fav TY is favored again vs RU. They did lead Buffalo 27-7 LW. 26th meeting. PSU is 23-2 but just 1 recent meeting. LY PSU down 10-6 went 80/6pl getting a td w/1:13 left (only lead of the gm) and on the next drive got 1 of their 5 int's on the day w/RU facing a 4th&12 from R29 to seal it. After giving up 10 Sks in Gm 1 vs Temple, PSU kept Hackenberg clean with a reshuffled OL and beat Buffalo 27-14 (-20). Still, PSU lead just 13-7 to start 4Q and FD's were even at 15. The game was played in a steady downpour RU is coming off a tough loss to WSU 37-34. WSU went 10/90 getting a GW TD with :13 left. RU is 6-4 in road openers but the 4 losses have come by a ttl of 8 pts (5 wins by 11 ppg). RU played just 3 games LY in front of crowds of 70,000+ and lost those 3 by 36.3 ppg.

SAN DIEGO ST by 19 over South Alabama - First meeting. Third FBS ssn for USA but they've made 2 longer trips (beat Idaho, 34-10 & lost vs Hawaii, 23-7). Both SDSU and USA are 1-1 incl win vs FCS. LW USA was blowout vs Nebraska 48-9 (+27). USA was 0-3 ATS LY as a AD. They suffered massive graduation losses but had appeared to have brought in enough UAB transfers to compensate but have not looked good losing both ATS by DD's. LY vs non-conf bowl tms (Miss St, SC, Navy, BG) and they went 0-4 BUT were +1 in FD's. SDSU lost LW to Cal 35-7 but led 7-0 after 1Q and trailed 14-7 at HT. SDSU used 2 QBs but neither was effective. SDSU is 7-1 SU at home. USA has 6 TO's in 2 gms so far TY while SDSU has forced 7.

USC by 14 over Stanford - P12 opener for these two tms. L5 gms have been decided by 8 pts or less. LY USC trailed 10-7 at HT, hit a 53-yd fg w/2:30 left. SU was shutout the 2H but their 5 poss ended on missed 26-yd fg, SOD at USC3, fmb1 at USC34, punt from USC32 & sk/fmb1 at USC32 w/19 down 3. USC won 13-10. Stanf is 5-3 in this series both SU and ATS. LW SU won 31-7 vs UCF. SU held a 491-181 yd edge and UCF did not score until 1:22 in 4Q. UCF did lose QB Holman to injury after 2 passes. Stanford was 2-5 ATS off SU win LY. USC has outscored opp 114-15 TY but faced just Ark St and Idaho. USC is 6-2 ATS as HF.

IOWA by 6 over Pittsburgh - Night games are back at Kinnick Stadium this ftbl ssn. This will be the Hawkeyes' first night game at home s/'the 2012 ssn. Pitt hasn't won here s/'31. LTH Pitt lost 31-27 ('11). Pitt led 27-10 w/12:09 left but all'd a td w/2:51 (Pitt's L/poss ended on an int at U143). L/time Pitt opened 2 str ssn's 3-0 was '81 & '82 (Sugar/Cotton Bowl yrs). The home team is 4-1 SU in this series. LW Pitt won vs Akron 24-7 (-12) and only alw'd 110 TY and 8 FD's but needed a late drive with 3 FD's via penalty to get ahead of the spread in the final minutes. RB Conner is lost for the year (ACL). Pitt coh Narduzzi is familiar with B10 as he was MSU's DC but did not face Iowa last year. Iowa is coming off 31-17 rivalry game win vs Iowa St which they scored 2 TD's in the flal 3:00 for a misleading final. Hawkeyes are 5-1 when fav by single digits.

WASHINGTON ST by 24 over Wyoming - Two tms who lost to FCS tms in Gm1 now meet. WSU rebounded well by beating Rutgers 37-34 and had a 559-402 yd edge. WSU also forced 3 TO's. WSU went 10/90 and scored w/:13 left. LW Wyoming lost as a HF (-13) vs EMU 48-29. WY did have a 26-19 FD edge. WY's last trip here was '90 and interestingly they won that won 34-13. WY is 4-0 ATS in road openers. WY is 20-9 ATS as an AD. Leach is 4-5 ATS as a HF. WY has dropped 8 str vs current Power-5 conf opp's (L/win at TN in '08, 13-7). Cougars are 7-1 when hosting non-conference opp's.

UCLA by 21 over Byu - BYU has won B2B come from behind gms in the final minute over Neb and Boise, now try for a 3rd str win as a Dog to start the ssn. LW BYU trailed 24-21 and managed to score 2TDs in last 0:45 of the gm to win 35-24. UCLA is 7-3 SU in this series, they last met here in '07 with UCLA winning 27-17 (-7) despite BYU having a 435-236 yd edge. That year the two met in a bowl and BYU got revenge, 17-16 (-6'). The next year at BYU and the last meeting between these 2, the Cougars won 59-0 (-8') leading 42-0 at the half. It was UCLA's worst loss since 1929. UCLA beat UNLV LW 37-3 (-29). BYU is 10-3 ATS as an AD while Mora is 9-6 as a HF. UCLA follows this up with P12 opnr vs Arizona while BYU travels to Michigan.
