HOME TEAM IN CAPS

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ KANSAS CITY over Cleveland** - The Chiefs became the 1st team in NFL history to follow a 5-gm losing skid with an 8-gm winning streak (7-1 ATS run) LW against the Ravens behind yet another solid defensive outing that saw them record a pair of def TD's in the 34-14 victory (KC now just a game back of DEN in the AFC West). They now play host to yet another struggling squad in the Browns who were basically shutdown following their 80-yd TD drive to begin the game (just 150 ttl yds the remainder of the matchup). With CLE having now lost 8 of their past 9 matchups including ATS losses in 6 of their L/7, the momentum is clearly on the side of the Chiefs in this one as QB Manziel makes his 1st career start in Arrowhead. **FORECAST: KANSAS CITY by 21**

**3★ ARIZONA over Green Bay** - GB heads into Glendale just 2 gms back of the Cardinals for the #2 seed in the NFC following their playoff-clinching win LW in rainy OAK, a game in which they were surprisingly outgained by a 372-293 margin but benefitted from a pair of early offensive miscues by the Raiders (resulted in 2 GB TD's). ARZ meanwhile eclipsed the 30 pt mark for the 8th time this ssn a week ago vs PHI behind a 229 ttl yd, 3 TD outing from rookie RB Johnson. While the Cardinals have put together quite an impressive ATS mark against NDIV foes (24-7-1), we are a bit surprised on just how much of a struggle GB has had as an away dog (-1-7 ATS). With the Packers traveling for a 2nd straight week and still trying to fend off MIN for the NFC North crown (host Vikings next week), the pressure is all on them in this one against an ARZ team that is on a very solid 17-9 ATS run. **FORECAST: ARIZONA by 10**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ SEATTLE over St Louis** - After having a dormant passing offense (#32 in NFL) for a good portion of the ssn, QB Keenum's addition to STL's starting lineup has begun to rejuvenate their success in the air over the past few gms incl a 234 yd (82%), 2 TD performance last Thur in their win over the Bucs (TB 30-16 FD and 509-319 yd edges). They now head to SEA to take on a red-hot Seahawks team that delivered their 7th win in their L/8 gms (5-0 ATS run) LW at home against the Browns (3★ LP Winner!) behind the continued success of both Russell Wilson (1st QB in NFL history w/5 consec gms of 3+ TD's and no ints) and WR Doug Baldwin (3rd WR s/1960 with 4 straight gms of multiple TD rec). In their previous meeting this ssn (Wk 1), a much different SEA team (offensive issues) went into STL and lost by 3 in OT after blowing a late 7 pt lead. With revenge on the mind of the Seahawks and a playoff spot now in hand, we fully expect SEA to get the job done in this one as they are a very solid 22-10 as a HF. **FORECAST: SEATTLE by 21**

## OTHER PLAYS

**San Diego at OAKLAND - TNF** - While the Chargers were able to handle the Dolphins with ease (3.5★ Top LP Winner, 442-231 yd edge) in potentially the final home game in SD history, they do head to the "Black Hole" having scored just 3 pts in each of their L/3 DIV gms (DEN and KC twice). After escaping DEN a few wks back with a 3 pt road upset, the Raiders were unable to carry any momentum into their home matchup with GB a week ago as a pair of early int's by Carr resulted in 14 pts by the Packers in their 30-20 victory (OAK eliminated from playoff contention for 13th straight yr). In their previous meeting TY back in Oct, OAK jumped out to a commanding 30-6 HT lead before a few late SD scores made it close in the end. With SD on just a 8-17 ATS run and the Raiders clearly having issues as a HF (6-20 ATS), this is one of those weeknight gms that we'll have to put further research into to decide which way to lean towards (TNF NFL Marquee selection available after 11am EST on weekends on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee Packs).

**Washington at PHILADELPHIA - SATURDAY** - This marks the 2nd consec yr that the Redskins and Eagles face off on Sat Night of the Wk 16 NFL ssn. Unfortunately for PHI, LY's matchup didn't go as planned as a 2-win WAS team pulled the outright upset as an 8 pt HD despite a 495-305 yardage deficit. The Redskins were able to make it 2 in a row earlier this ssn against the Eagles thanks in part to a late TD pass w/26 left for the 23-20 win. WAS has an opportunity to clinch the DIV with a win in this one following their win over BUF (scored on 1st 3 poss for first time s/99). The Eagles meanwhile were outgained for a 5th consec game in their 40-17 home defeat by the Cardinals (PHI 4 TO's). With major NFC East implications on the line, grab one of our very special NFL Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee Packs.

**TAMPA BAY by 4 over Chicago** - Despite significant FD (30-16) and yardage (509-319) edges for the game, a 28-6 deficit in the 3Q ended up being too much to overcome for the Bucs last Thur in STL as they were unable to recover the onside with a minute left trailing by 8. They now return home having been mathematically eliminated from the playoffs to take on a Bears squad that also finds themselves in a bit of a tailspin following their 3rd straight loss LW in MIN, a game in which they were held to just 293 yds. With TB HC Lovie Smith still searching for his 1st win vs his former team (HC w/CHI from '05-'12) following a 21-13 loss LY in CHI, this might be his spot for redemption as the Bucs have now covered 5 of their L/7 following a SU loss.

**Carolina by 10 over ATLANTA** - While the Panthers were able to continue their undefeated run a week ago in NY, it didn't come easy as they squandered a 35-7 lead late in the game only to connect on a GW 40 yd FG as time expired (QB Newton 440 ttl yds, 5 TD's). They now head on the road for the last time this ssn to take on a Falcons team that they blanked 38-0 just 2 weeks ago behind a suffocating defense that allowed just 230 ttl yds, recorded 5 sks and forced 4 TO's. ATL was finally able to get back into the win column LW against JAX following a 6-game losing skid (9 consec ATS losses) although their chances of earning a WC berth still seem remote at the moment. With a perfect ssn on the line for the Panthers (11-4 ATS run) and the Falcons' performance in their previous meeting, the biggest question for CAR following this matchup will be just how much their starters will play in the finale against TB with everything now clinched in the NFC.

**BUFFALO by 10 over Dallas** - The Bills and Cowboys matched up in a pair of Super Bowls in the early 1990's with DAL coming out victorious in both while outscoring BUF by an 82-30 margin. Despite being outgained by a 372-309 margin and throwing for a combined 4 int's, the Cowboys found themselves deadlocked late in their home matchup LW, a game that the Jets were able to connect on the GW FG w/40 remaining. They now head to BUF with QB Moore potentially making the 1st start of his career (15-25-158, 1-3 ratio in relief of an ineffective Cassel) to take on a Bills squad that will be missing the playoffs for a 16th consec yr (longest drought in the NFL) following their beatdown in WAS (trailed 21-0 at HT). With the Cowboys' slim chances of capturing the NFC East Title now officially gone, we expect the Bills to end their 2-gm skid in this one in front of a home crowd that they are seeing for just the 2nd time in the past 7 weeks!

**NEW ORLEANS by 7 over Jacksonville** - With a potential shot of staying within a game of the AFC South Title heading into LW, the Jags stumbled out of the gate at home against the Falcons (trailed 17-3 at HT) in their 23-17 defeat (3★ LP Winner on the Under!). They now head into the Superdome to take on a Saints team off of short rest following their MNF clash with the Lions. While the Jaguars still find themselves mathematically alive for their DIV, we look for the Saints to play spoiler here as JAX has gone just 1-11 ATS in their most recent matches against the NFC including an 0-3 ATS mark thus far in 2015.

**DETROIT by 10 over San Francisco** - Despite rattling off 3 consec wins following their bye week and changes to the offensive coaching staff, the Lions' good fortune has now worn off as they enter their MNF matchup with the Saints carrying a 2-gm losing skid. They now return home on a short week and with a porous 4-12 ATS run to take on a 49ers squad that's also seen the negative side of the scoreboard quite often in '15. SF is now on a 6-14 ATS run following their home defeat against the Bengals, a game in which they trailed 21-0 at the half thanks in part to 3 int's by Gabbert (SF 318-242 yd edge). While we do find it somewhat difficult to align ourselves with a DET team that has disappointed us throughout a good portion of the ssn, siding with the 49ers is not a wise decision as not only have they lost 6 of their 7 road gms, but they've also been dominated in the process (-16 ppg, -173 ypg).

**Indianapolis by 7 over MIAMI** - While the Colts were able to take the early lead for the 3rd consec week, their struggles as the game wore on showed up once again in their AFC South showdown against the Texans as they were outFD'd (20-14) and outgained (305-190) by substantial margins in the 6-pt defeat.

They now head down South to take on a Dolphins squad that's off of their 2nd consec loss LW in SD (1-7 ATS run), a game that saw them dominated throughout (27-13 FD and 442-231 yardage deficits). While the Colts are clearly struggling after 3 consec losses by a combined 76 pts, keep in mind that the Dolphins have won at home on just 2 occasions all year while being outscored (27-21) and outgained (394-319) by fairly substantial margins.

**New England by 3 over NY JETS** - The Jets moved their winning streak to 4 in a row following their narrow win over the Cowboys a week ago, a game that they needed a GW FG w/40 remaining despite a 372-309 yardage edge and forcing 4 DAL ints. NE meanwhile had an easy go in their matchup with the Titans LW as they held TEN to just 282 yds (forced 3 TO's) while earning their 6th straight 12-win ssn in the process. In their previous meeting back in Oct, the Jets actually had a 4 pt lead early in the 4Q before NE rattled off a pair of TD's in the final 7 minutes to get the 7-pt win. While the Pats appear to be in line for the #1 seed in the AFC with 2 gms remaining (already clinched 1st round bye), expect them to be tested thoroughly in this one as the Jets have gone 5-1-1 ATS the past 3.5 yrs against NE and enter play in a 3-way tie with KC and PIT for a potential WC spot in the AFC.

**Houston by 7 over TENNESSEE** - After a pair of crushing road defeats against the Jets (30-8) and LW vs the Patriots (33-16 defeat, just 282 ttl yds of offense), TEN returns home with more questions at QB following yet another inj to Mariota (CS). They now look to play spoiler against a Texans team that moved into 1st place atop the AFC South standings following their first ever franchise win at Indy (14 tries). HOU also has some questions at the signal caller position however as Brandon Weeden (11-18-105, 1 TD) became the 4th different QB to see significant action following a knee inj to TJ Yates. In their previous meeting TY in HOU, the Texans held TEN to just 6 pts and 211 ttl yds in their 14 pt victory which also ironically started their 4-gm winning streak to get them back in the DIV race. While TEN was able to end their 11-gm home losing skid a few wks ago against the Jags, their overall home ATS mark (4-13-2) and record as a dog (7-20-2 ATS) have us leaning with the visitor in this one.

**Pittsburgh by 12 over BALTIMORE** - PIT has been on quite the impressive run over their L/6 contests with the only loss during that span coming on the road vs a red-hot SEA tm. Despite a 14-pt HT deficit and just 23 rush yds for the entire gm, PIT was able to storm back LW at home against DEN for their 10th straight Dec win (6th str gm of 30+ pts). They now head to BAL sporting a 14-7-1 ATS mark vs DIV foes and seeking revenge for an OT loss earlier in the ssn (QB Roethlisberger DNP). Despite finishing with a 366-277 yd edge LW vs KC, the Ravens were done in by 3 TO's behind QB Clausen who was making his 2nd straight start (1st 5-loss home ssn for BAL in franchise history). With the Ravens clearly packing it in over the past 2 wks (outscored 69-20) and posting just a 7-13-1 ATS mark against fellow AFC North opponents, PIT should have no problem getting the job done here as they head into the playoffs.

**NY Giants at MINNESOTA - SNF** - Huge playoff indications in this matchup as the Giants head on the road to meet the Vikings. While their comeback bid a week ago against the undefeated Panthers came up just short (erased 28 pt deficit, lost on FG as time expired), the Giants still find themselves just a game out of the NFC East standings although they may be without star WR Beckham in this one (susp??). The Vikings meanwhile got back into the win column a week ago in easy fashion (4★ Newsletter Winner!) at home against the Bears to stay within 1-game of the DIV leading Packers (MIN at GB next wk for potential NFC North Title) as QB Bridgewater put up a huge performance with a career-best 4 TD passes (also 1 rush TD). While the Giants have dominated MIN in each of their past 2 meetings ('10 & '13) by a combined 44-10 margin, also keep in mind that the Vikings have put together quite the impressive 11-2 ATS run. For our final decision in this contest, call your VIP Debit Card on game day to get the winner!

**Cincinnati at DENVER - MNF** - A first round AFC playoff bye is on the line in this one between a pair of tms that have seen better days. The Broncos have now lost 2 straight following their blown 14 pt HT lead against the Steelers (3rd straight game DEN held scoreless in 2H).
