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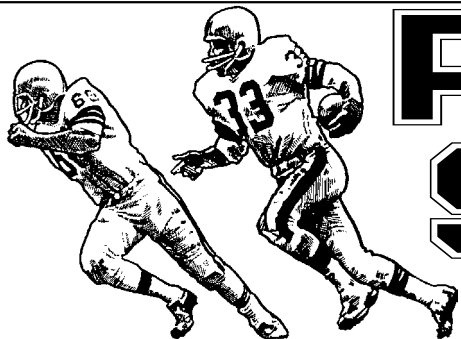

KEY SELECTIONS

4★ WISCONSIN over Georgia St - 1st mtg. GSt greatly improved their rush D LY after all'g 303 (6.3) in '14. They gave up 181 (4.3) in '15, but have taken a huge step back TY, all'g 395 (5.8)! That spells trouble against a UW squad that loves pounding smaller foes early in the ssn, as attested to their 294 (5.3) rush perf LW in their 54-10 (-23) w/ win over Akron. That Akron run D only all'd 93 (2.9) LY & has the best DL in the MAC TY! GAST is off a 48-14 (+21) beatdown from AF, where they were outgd' 531-169, outFD'd 30-6, & held the ball for just 14:46! Life w/o QB Arbuckle is a struggle. Its not just the OFF & D that are causes of concern for GSt, they have our #127 ranked ST unit as well. It appears the Panthers didn't benefit from the extra bowl practices LY. UW has a huge game vs Michigan St on deck, but GAST is travelling in B2B wks & again next wk. LY UW all'd a comb ttl of 3 pts to their non-conf foes at home while scoring 38 ppg. We've used Wisc early & often in prior yrs as our Free Sept 5★ & they've come up big for us time and time again. Will this be our Sept 5★ this yr? Subs can call their 5★ tapes after 11AM ET on Sat to find out.

FORECAST: WISCONSIN by 49

3★ PENN ST over Temple - Revenge will be on the minds of the PSt players after losing this gm for the F/time s/1941, snapping a 31 gm series win streak in LY's opener. PSt led 10-0 with 126 yds in the 1Q, but all'd 10 sks in the 27-10 (-6) road loss. The LTH ('14) PSt won 30-13 (-12) with a 366-248 yd edge. We won a 3★ LPS on PSt in their emotional 42-39 (+5) loss at rival Pitt LW. TO's early hurt PSt, but they settled down & the yds & FD's were nearly even. TU followed up their wk 1 home loss to Army w/a 38-0 (-24) home win over FCS Stony Brook, their 1st shutout s/'14. QB Walker was expected to improve after compl just 57% LY, but is hitting just 47% TY incl compl just 11-23 LW. With the change in OFF to an Oregon style utempo spread, PSt won't allow 10 sks like they did LY. TU is also inexp'd, w/just 12 ret st'rs making their first road trip & we're not concerned that PSt is in a Pitt/Mich sandwich. TU all'd 329 (4.9) rush yds to Army despite extra time to prep & PSt will be able to run the ball after failing to do so LW (74, 2.4). HC Franklin takes care of business vs non conf as his 17-10 ATS mark in that role shows. Could this be our September 5★?

FORECAST: PENN ST by 17

3★ Usf over SYRACUSE - USF has dominated this series. In fact, we've used them as a 5★ Selection incl as our '07 GOY (USF -16', 41-10 winner) and a 5★ in '09 (USF -6', 34-20 winner), both in the dome! USF is 7-2 SU/ATS in this series. The HT was 1-5 SU/ATS prior to LY, but a 1-3 USF tm that had been 9-27 the L3Y scored their most pts s/'11 & won 45-24 (+1) in a gm that was key to turning around their ssn & getting to a bowl. We easily won our Friday Night Marquee on the OVER in Syr 62-28 (+14', 68) home loss to L'Ville. Syr trailed 35-21 at HT & all'd the most yds in schl hist, getting outgd' 845-414! Syr is avg just 110 (3.0) rush ypg. USF enters off a 48-17 (-15) home win over NIU. 2X AAC rush champ Mack was held out (conc, CSTW) so QB Flowers stepped up, hitting 21-33-350 w/4 td's. The Bulls finished w/658-318 yd & 34-19 FD edges. USF is avg 254 (5.6) rush ypg and gets to take on a pourous Orange D. USF hasn't travelled to the unique Carrier Dome s/'11 so none of their players have exp'd the field there, but HC Taggart knows how to win on the road & is an incredible 21-5 ATS away! Could we use our free Sept 5★ on USF again this yr? Subs can call their 5★ tape after 11AM ET on Sat to find out.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Colorado (+) over MICHIGAN - These schls haven't met s/'97, but the 1st thing many think of is the 64 yd Hail Mary pass by QB Stewart to Westbrook as time expired to win 27-26 on Sept 24, '94. CU followed up their wk 1 rivalry win by blasting FCS ID State 56-7 (-41'). QB Liufau looks 100% as he threw for 204 & ran for 54 w/3 tll td's in less than 1H. Mich continues to bury lesser tms at home under Harbaugh after their 51-14 (-36) win over UCF. There may be some concerns however, after all'g 275 (6.0) rush yds. All CU has done is avg 261 (4.6) rush ypg thru the F/2 gms! While CU is just 2-9 SU on the road under MacIntyre, LY they were only outscored by 8.5 ppg on the road losing to Utah by 6 and UCLA by 4. Mich is just 3-8 SU/1-11 ATS vs the P12 & CU won't be intimidated.

FORECAST: MICHIGAN by 14

2★ Boston College (+) over VIRGINIA TECH - VT is 14-6 SU/13-6-1 ATS in this series and LY was playing with double revenge and won 26-10 (-2) on the road. In their last 9 trips here to Blacksburg, it's been all or nothing for BC as they've pulled 3 outright upsets but all 7 of their losses have been by DD losing by 17 ppg. VT enters off an emotional 45-24 (+11) loss to Tenn in a gm that was ply'd in front of the largest crowd in CFB hist (nearly 157,000) at the Bristol Motor Speedway. After 204 yds in the 1Q, VT had just 196 tll after that. BC ret'd from Ireland in wk 1 & travelled to UMass & won 26-7 (-16) LW, finishing w/344-122 yd & 14-8 FD edges. The D continues to be their calling card as they are all'g just 181 ypg incl just 49 (1.3) rush. VT is just a miserable 20-42-1 ATS overall, while BC is 5-1 as an AD. The Eagles are travelling for a 3rd str wk, but their bodies are back to normal after the possible jet lag from their trip to Dublin, Ireland in the opener.

Houston at CINCINNATI - UC is 6-1-1 ATS vs UH, but had their 6 gm series win streak snapped LY. UH (-9) was undefeated & ranked #25. Tied at 14 at HT, UC had a 343-213 yd edge. UH took a 30-14 lead, but UC got the backdoor cover & their final drive was SOD at their 42, 33-30. The LTH ('14) UH (+7) got to the UC 11 yd line down 38-31, but their final pass into the EZ fell incomplete. UC beat a B10 schl for the 1st time s/'57 in their 38-20 (-4) win at Pur LW. UC had 5 int's, 3 of which set up td's. UH followed up their emotional upset over OU with an easy 42-0 shutout over FCS Lamar LW. QB Ward DNP (shoulder, CS) & UH all'd 4 FD's & 86 tll yds. LY BU had a 793-246 yd edge and led 42-10 at the half, 63-7 after 3Q's. LTH ('10) they won 30-13 (-8). BU isn't letting there nightmarish offesn follow them into the reg ssn as they continued their winning ways, pounding in state rival SMU 40-13 (-32) LW. It was tied 6-6 at HT, but BU controlled the 2H & finished w/29-21 FD & 536-405 yd edges. Rice enters winless following their lackluster perf in their 31-14 (+8) loss at unbeaten Army LW. They were outFD'd 25-12 & outgd' 414-289. BU is 4-9-1 as an AF, but Rice is on a 1-6 ATS run. BU has a huge game vs OKSt on deck. Arizona St at UTSA - 1st mtg. AZSt is 1-7 SU in road openers but should be excited to play this game in the Alamo Dome & HC Graham is a TX native. This is the 4th str ssn a P5 conf tm will visit the Alamo Dome & UTSA is 0-3 SU losing by 17 ppg, but they're 2-1 ATS. We won a 3★ Key Selection on these pages LW (as part of a 4-2 week) as well as our Marquee College 900 play Sat (College marquees went 3-0) on AZSt in their 68-55 (-1) win over TT. RB Ballage tied an NCAA rec w/8 td's (Illini Howard Griffith '90) & AZSt's OFF, which struggled early in their wk 1 opener against an FCS foe, finished w/652-612 yd & 34-28 edges. QB Wilkins hit 28-37-351-2-0. UTSA enters off a 23-14 (+9) loss at CSt, getting shutout in the 2H & outgd' 328-235 & outFD'd 19-13 for the gm. AZSt is 6-3 as an AF, while UTSA is 3-2 as a HD. AZSt has their P12 opener on deck vs Cal. Get the Fri night Marquee on your NC Sports VIP debit card for just \$12 after noon ET gameday.

Arkansas St at UTAH ST - These two last met in '14. UTSt lost 21-14 (+1) in OT on the road, with UTSt having a 38 yd fg blk'd on the final play of regulation. The HT is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in this series. We went against UTSt as our Button 3 College selection as the play that just missed out on being a LPS in their 45-7 (+16) loss at USC (College selections went 6-2 on button 3 & 9 comps LW). RB Mays was inj'd & seen on crutches in the 2H (CS) & UTSt was outFD'd 31-14 & outgd' 407-255. AST was whipped 51-14 (+20) at Aub LW. They were outgd' 706-326 & outFD'd 32-14 & have been outscored 82-24 TY. UTSt is 12-7 as a HF, while AST is 1-8 as a non conf AD. This is a rare trip to the altitude for the Red Wolves. Could this be our Fri night Marquee? Find out after noon ET gameday for \$12 on your NC Sports VIP debit card.

SATURDAY SEPT 17

CHARLOTTE by 5 over Eastern Michigan - 1st mtg. EM is an astonishing 1-60 SU on the non-conf road s/'90, but their 1 win came at WY LY. CU is just 8-11 SU at home but the avg win is by 30 ppg & 4 of the 11 losses have come by 8 pts or less. As an FCS team, CU was 0-5 at Jerry Richardson Stadium vs FBS teams with their avg loss by 21. This is the 2nd str road game for EM, off a 61-21 (+24) loss at MO. RB Vann inj'd his shoulder 1Q & didn't return (CS) & EM was outgd' 647-428 & outFD'd 30-21. CU is off a 47-14 (-13) win over FCS Elon but only finished w/a 506-419 yd edge. EM is on a 10-26-1 run incl 10-18-1 as an AD. This is CU's 1st gm as a HF vs an FBS foe.

Western Michigan by 7 over ILLINOIS - IL is 4-0 SU vs WM in Champaign & last ply'd in '12, winning 24-7 (-10). IL has a bye on deck & after finishing 5-7 LY know they need every victory. They've covered their L/3 vs MAC schls, beating Miami 50-14 (-26) in '13 & KSt 52-3 (-13) LY. This will be the first MAC team they've taken on in the L5Y that had a winning record not only the prior yr, but also the current yr. IL is off a 48-23 (+7) drubbing at home to UNC. They may have lost st'g LG Meggison (CS) & punter Frain DNP (CS). IL was outgd' 462-309, outFD'd 21-15 & had 13 pen's totalling 99 yds. WM followed up their win over B10 NW in wk 1 (nearly 100 yd edge) w/ an easy 70-21 (-36) over FCS NC Central LW as WR Davis topped 4,000 car rec yds. Ill is 8-5 as a HD, while WM is 12-4 as an AD, but 6-10 ATS vs the B10.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 7 over East Carolina - The last mtg was in '14 and SC won 33-23 (-15) at home. It was the 3rd str win in the series down by 10+ pts. This is new SC HC Muschamp's home opener & EC's first road game. EC is off an impressive 33-30 (+6) home win over NCSt in the Wolfpacks most important gm in the month of Sept, scoring the GW td after a 14p/84 yd drive w/5:49 left. EC was slightly outgd' & did allow 215 (6.9) rush. We won a 4★ on these pages LW going against SC in their 27-14 (+7) loss at MissSt. SC trailed 24-0 at HT & were outgd' 485-243 incl 290-34 rush! EC is 12-4 ATS vs non conf foes & 6-0 ATS in gm 1 of B2B AG's, while SC is 3-6 as a HF. This is SC's least important gm in terms of opponent in Sept while EC just beat NCSt in their most important gm of the month so they are in their normal underdog role here.

Florida St by 7 over LOUISVILLE - FSU has won 14 of the L/15 SU in this series. While this is just the 5th mtg s/'00, this will be the 3rd str yr. The L2Y UL has all'd ssn high in yds (+265 above avg in '14 and +177 LY). In Tallahassee LY, FSU led just 14-13 mid-3Q but went on to a 41-21 (-6) win. The LTH ('14) was your typical Jamies Winston game as his TO's put FSU down 24-7 at HT, but FSU put up 374 yds in the 2H and won 42-31 (-3'). We easily won our Fri Night Marquee on the OVER in UL's 62-28 (-14', 68) win at Syr. QB Jackson followed up his 8 td perf in wk 1, with 5 more (4 rush incl a highlight reel hurdle). UL led 35-21 at HT & set a schl rec (13 shy of ACC rec) w/845 yds (all'd 414). FSt is off a 52-8 (-59) win over FCS Charleston So that had 14 ply'r's incl 10 str's suspl! UL is 2-7 as a conf HD, while FSU is 8-5 as an AF. While this is the 1st AG for rFr QB Francois, the 'Noles will be on upset alert & will play their best gm. FSU has a massive ST edge (16 vs 122) and are 16-3 SU on the road the L4Y while UL did lose to both Hou & Clem at home LY.

Maryland by 10 over UCF - 1st meeting. MD is making their 2nd str trip to the Sunshine state following their 41-14 (-10) win at FIU last Fr. MD led 31-7 at HT & finished w/a 477-372 yd edge. QB Hills threw for 3 td's & was resting late 3Q. MD has a bye on deck & was in FL so the climate won't affect them. UCF is off a physcial 51-14 (+36) loss at Mich. QB Holman (3-11-19) was inj'd 1H & didn't return (CS). UCF had been 32-6 at home from '09-'14 but were 0-6 LY. MD is just 2-12 ATS off a SU win, but is on a 6-2 ATS run vs FBS, while UCF is 5-14-1 as a 2-12 ATS run. MD is avg 277 (6.2) rush ypg, but UCF just limited Mich to 119 (2.9), so MD may go to the air more often as they do have the edge at QB & UCF did allow 328 thru the air LW.

CONNECTICUT by 6 over Virginia - These two last met in '08 and it was at this site with UConn rolling to a 45-10 win. UVA trailed 42-3 in the 4Q. UVA has an advantage here in the fact that HC Mendenhall has prepped for UConn each of the L2Y with wins of 30-13 (-14') at home (539-230 yds) and 35-10 on the road in '14 (513-355 yds). UConn has the advantages of being the more exp'd team with 16 ret st'rs vs 12 and having the benefit of bowl practices LY, something UVA hasn't had s/'11. UVA followed up their embarrassing ssn opening loss to an FCS foe by having a more respectable performance in their long road trip to Oregon, where they lost, but covered 44-26 (+24) LW. UVA was outgd' 632-388, but were only outFD'd by 3. UConn trailed 21-0 late 1H, but took a 24-21 lead before all'g the GW td w/3:08 left in their 28-24 (+4) loss at Navy LW. After just a 34 yd punt from their own 9, UConn gave up a 26 yd PR that all'd Navy to start the GW drive from the Huskie 17 yd line. UConn did end the gm on the Navy 1 yd line but ran the ball w/no TO's left & the clock ran out. UConn is 2-12 as a HF, while UVA is 6-1 as an AD.

TCU by 28 over Iowa St - TCU is 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS in this series as B12 rivals. LY TCU trailed 21-14 after 1Q and ISU ended 5 of their final 7 poss in TCU terr on 2 fmb's, 2 TO and a punt and TCU came back for the 45-21 (-20) cover on the road. LTH ('14) TCU laid it to ISU 55-3 (-34') in the ssn finale, hoping to impress the playoff committee. TCU fell behind 13-0 at HT at home LW to Ark, but rebounded & led 28-20 but QB Hill needed to put the spotlight on himself with a throat slash gesture after the TD, prompting a personal foul penalty enforced on the KO, resulting in the Hogs st'g their ensuing possession from their own 42 yd line w/under 2:00 to play. TCU then all'd the tying td & 2pt conv & lost outright in OT 41-38 (-7). TCU finished w/a 572-403 yd edge. ISU was crushed in their rivalry gm vs Iowa 42-3 (+15'), getting outgd' 435-291 & outFD'd 25-16. TCU is avg 617 ypg (209 rush, 409 pass), while ISU is all'g 215 (4.6) rush incl all'g over 230 yds to an FCS foe in the opener! TCU is 10-3 as a HF, while ISU is 4-9 ATS on the B12 road.

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RUTGERS by 4 over New Mexico - 1st mtg. Rutgers ssn got off to a disastrous start after losing 48-13 in their opener then falling behind 14-0 to FCS Howard. Their ssn swung on the ensuing KO, which was ret'd 84 yds for a td & the Knights went on to win 52-14 (-42). NM is off an emotional 32-31 (-12) loss at rival NMSt. The Lobos led 31-22 early 4Q, but all'd the GW td w/5:46 left following an int that set up the Aggies at NM 27. NM is avg 32.5 (6.9) rush ypg, but RU has veterans across both sides of the OL/DL & did shut down UW's run gm in wk 1, all'g just 91 (3.0). RU was 1-3 as a HF LY & is on a 3-9 ATS run vs FBS foes, while NM is 10-5 as an AD & is on a 12-7 ATS run.

Middle Tennessee by 3 over BOWLING GREEN - 1st mtg. Huge HC edge to MT as Stockstill enters his 11th year, while Jinks is in his first. A wk after being pased by Ohio St, BG held on to beat FCS N Dakota, 27-26 (-17). ND scored w/13 left, but failed on their 2pt conv att. QB Knapke took over due to inj in '14 & BG avg 30 ppg, but improved to 44.2 ppg with Johnson back under center. Now back to being the str, Knapke is hitting 48% w/a 3-4 ratio. MT led instate rival Vandy 10-5 after 1Q, but were outscored 42-14 after that in their 47-24 (+3) road loss. MT did finish w/495-344 yd & 25-20 FD edges. QB Stockstill set schl rec's in comp (38) & att (65) while WR James set a achl rec w/14 rec's (183 yds). Hard to gauge just where BG's D is at this moment as they had nowhere to go but up following the Buckeyes record setting perf, but this gm should provide answers as MT proved it could move the ball on an SEC D LW. MT is just 3-10 SU on the road L3Y and on their 2nd str road game. The MAC is the stronger conf & BG is 28-12 SU vs current CUSA foes. MT is 4-9-1 as an AD & BG was 3-1 as a HF LY.

MASSACHUSETTS by 6 over Fiu - Fiu is travelling here for a 2nd str ssn after LY's initial mtg. UMass finished w/495-188 yd & 28-14 FD edges & won 24-14 (-3). Fiu is just 3-14 SU in AG's the L3Y & enter off a 41-14 (+10) home loss to MD last Fri. Fiu trailed 31-7 at HT & were outgd' 477-372. QB McGough inj'd his back, DNP the 2H & is ? TW (CS). RfR QB M. Alexander hit 9-18-131-1-0 in relief. Fiu is all'g 243 (5.0) rush ypg. UMass enters off 26-7 (+16) home loss to BC. The Minutemen led 7-0 late 1H, but all'd 2 td's in 84 seconds, the 2nd after from their own 36 that swung momentum. UMass was outgd' 344-122 & outFD'd 14-8. Fiu is 1-5 as a dog & on an 0-5-1 ATS run, but UMass is 2-6 ATS off a SU loss.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 9 over Univ - The HT is 4-0 SU in this series. In the lone mtg in the past 22Y ('13), UNLV won 31-21 (-7). UNLV is off a 42-21 (+26) loss at UCLA. While RB Thomas had 19-112, QB Stanton hit just 11-28-153-1-2. The Rebels were outgd' 499-328 & outFD'd 30-18. CM is off a highly emotional 30-27 (+20) road win over a Top 25 ranked OKSt tm, giving us an easy 3★ LPS winner. Sure the last play shouldn't have counted, but CM basically handed the gm away late 4Q up by 4 when they fmb'd at their own 11 yd line, which resulted in an easy Poke td. CM finished w/418-338 yd & 35:27-24:33 TOP edges while QB Rush hit 30-42-361-4-1. UNLV hasn't won a non conf AG s/07, had a 4.5 hour bus ride home & are travelling across the country TW. They did stay within 21 of Michigan LY (+35). LV had been 1-14 ATS as an AD from '09-'11 but is 14-5 ATS in this role the L5Y. However CM is 22-13 as a HF.

GEORGIA TECH by 3 over Vanderbilt - The last mtg between them '09, with GT winning on the road 56-31 (-11). GT only had FCS Mercer LW while this is VU's first road gm. The 'Dores enter off a misleading 47-24 (-3) win over instate rival MTSU. RB Webb ran for a car high 211 (7.3), but VU was outgd' by over 100 yds & outFD'd by 5. VU is all'g just 109 (4.1) rush ypg, having already ply'd an SEC contest, while GT struggled in their opener against BC running the ball. GT does have a huge game vs Clemson on deck on a Thurs & is just 1-9 ATS vs FBS foes & 0-7 as a fav. VU is 12-6 as an AD. HC Mason generally has good defensive schemes and has speed and LY all'd just 21 ppg and has 7 str back on D.

UTEP by 7 over Army - 1st mtg. Army always plays well in the state of Texas going 11-2-1 ATS s/'95. Fort Bliss, a large Army base, is located in El Paso. UTEP began their ssn w/a big rivalry win, but followed that with a 41-7 (+29) expected loss at a much improved TX squad as st'g QB Greenlee was held out so he could be healthy for CUSA play (CS). RB Jones continues to impress as he followed up his car high perf in wk 1 by adding 18-123 LW. UTEP was outgd' 416-208 & outFD'd 23-10. Army enters 2-0 for the 1st time s/'96 & has B2B wins for the 1st time in 70 gms following their 31-14 home win over Rice (-8). Army had their 414-289 yd & 23-12 FD edges. UTEP has been solid at home going 9-3 SU the L2Y with 2 of their losses by 4 and 2 pts. UTEP struggled vs the option from '13-'14 giving up 395 (6.9) rush in '13 & 410 (7.9) in '14 vs NM (1-1 ATS). They all'd a respectable 171 (3.6) LW to TX. Army has yet to allow a 100 yds rush as a unit, but that will likely change against a RB of Jones caliber. This is the 1st of 3 str AG's for Army, just 5-12-2 as an AD, while UTEP is 10-1-1 ATS vs FBS foes at home.

KANSAS ST by 21 over Florida Atlantic - The last mtg was in '06 with KSt winning 45-0 (-20). KSt is off a bye & a highly respectable 26-13 (+14) loss at Stanford the wk prior where they held 335-272 yd & 18-13 FD edges. This is their home opener & they had won 5 str until they lost in '13 to N Dakota St, but have bounced back the L2Y. We won a 2★ on these pages LW going against FAU in their 38-10 (+25) loss at Miami. The Owls were outgd' 470-214 & outFD'd 21-13. Sked edge highly favors KSt off a bye w/an FCS foe on deck, while FAU is travelling in B2B wks. HC Bill Snyder is a great underdog but still is a respectable 18-14 as a HF, but FAU is 16-5 as an AD.

TOLEDO by 24 over Fresno St - The last mtg between these schls was in '08, with FSt winning in 2OT 55-54 (-7) in Toledo. The Rockets followed up their road win over Ark St to open the ssn with a 45-3 (-31) home win over FCS Maine. Toledo is avg 536 ypg incl 350 thru the air, while all'g just 251 ypg on D & will have a sizeable ST advantage (40 vs 106). FSt got on track following their opening ssn loss at Neb w/a 31-3 (-28) home win over FCS Sac St. This is a rare trip East for Fresno and they lost to Mississippi 73-21 (+30) LY. FSt had been 9-3 ATS as an AD but were 1-5 in that role LY with their avg road loss by 32.4 ppg. Toledo is on a 13-3-1 ATS run vs FBS foes.

San Diego St by 10 over NORTHERN ILLINOIS - The last mtg between these schls was in '71. NIU gets a much needed home gm after starting on the road the F2W & they're 14-2 SU in home openers with 8 str wins by 25 ppg. The last time NIU lost a home non-conf game was in '09 vs Idaho and have won 9 str. Things couldn't have gotten off to a worse start for the Huskies as they lost at WY in OT as a fav & then were blown out at USF 48-17 (+15) LW. They're all'g 268 (5.1) rush ypg & now must face RB Pumphrey, who broke NFL HOF'r Marshall Faulk's car rush total in style, with a car high 281 yds & 3 td's LW. Despite that effort, we won our Underdog POW (2-0 TY) on these pages going against SDSt in their 45-40 (-7) win over Cal. SDSt is travelling for the 1st time w/a 1st yr st'g QB, while NIU needs to get on track & has an FCS foe on deck.

Wku by 21 over MIAMI, OH - This is MU's HC. LY these two met for the first time and WKU won 56-14 (-20) as QB Doughty threw for 457 yds and 6 td's. WKU led 56-7 until a garbage td w/7:28 left. The Hilltoppers are coming off a 38-10 (+28) loss at Bama LW. They trailed just 17-3 at FCS as Bama was just cruising in this one. WKU finished -236 yds & -11 FD's as expected. MU lost to FCS foe E III 21-17 (-9). MU led 17-7 late 4Q before all'd 3 td's. MU did hold a 402-316 yd edge for the gm. MU is 11-8 as a Dog under Martin. WKU is on B2B road gms and is 0-4 ATS in the 2nd of those but are 9-3 as a Fav overall.

FLORIDA by 35 over North Texas - They have only met once and that game was won by NT back in 1947. UF dominated KY LW 45-7 (-16). The Gators led 24-0 at HT and KY didn't get on the board until late 4Q. QB Del Rio had an outstanding game as he picked apart KY's defense, throwing for 320 and 4 tds. The Gators were 14-20 on 3D and held 564-149 yd & 28-9 FD edges. The Mean Green are coming off a 41-20 (-11) win over an FCS foe. NT is just 2-11 ATS as an AD the L3Y. UF is just 7-14 as a HF and 1-5 ATS vs non-conf foes.

TEXAS TECH by 10 over Louisiana Tech - These 2 L/met in 1933! We won a 3★ Key Selection on these pages going against TT LW in their 68-55 (+1) loss at AZSt. They led 41-37 3Q but all'd AZSt to score 21 str. QB Mahomes threw for 540 yds for the gm. TT was outgd' 652-612 and outFD'd 34-28. LT is coming off a 53-24 (-34) win vs an FCS foe. QB Higgins ret'd from a gm1 susp and threw for 409 yds and 4 tds. LT is 7-1 ATS as an AD, taking Kansas St to OT LY and covering at OK and at Aub in '14. LT is on an 18-9 ATS overall run vs FBS foes and 22-11 ATS on the road.

KENTUCKY by 17 over New Mexico St - First mtg between these schls. NMSt was 0-5 ATS as an AD in HC Martin's 1st yr but 4-2 LY although in their game vs Ole Miss, rested some key ply'r's incl RB Rose to keep them healthy for conf play and they were 0-2 ATS vs SEC foes losing by an avg of 56.5-8. UK gave an uninspired performance LW in the swamp, losing 45-7 (+16). QB Barker was constantly harassed and threw more int's (3) than he had comp's (2) and KY had just 10 pass yds at HT. KY was -415 yds & -19 FD's for the gm! NMSt is off an upset win vs rival NM, 32-31 (+12) despite missing RB Rose (CS). The Aggies were outgd' 336-307 but an int set up QB Rogers GW td pass. KY is in an SEC sandwich but is desperate for a win after st'g 0-2. KY is 7-4 as a Fav and was 6-1-1 in HC Stoops 1st 2Y. NMSt is on a 15-31-2 ATS run and is just 12-32-3 ATS vs non-conf foes.

ARKANSAS by 35 over Texas St - 1st meeting. Ark is coming off a wild upset win vs TCU, 41-38 (+7) 2OT. QB Allen was 17-29-223-3 and added the GW rush td in OT. UA led 13-0 at HT and 20-7 3Q but trailed 28-21 and benefitted from a boneheaded Sportsmanlike Penalty on TCU QB Hill, setting up a late td to force OT. The UA OL, which struggled in wk1, raised their rush ypc from 2.7 to 4.2. UA was outgd' 572-403 for the gm. TXSt is coming off a bye wk. The wk prior they upset Ohio 56-54 (+20) in 3OT. TXSt is 0-6 as an AD. Ark is on an 18-8-1 ATS run vs FBS foes and is 8-4 ATS vs Non Conf foes.

TENNESSEE by 24 over Ohio - These two last met in '09 and UT won 34-23 (-23). The Vols are coming off a big win in 'The Battle at Bristol', in front of a record crowd of over 156K, 45-24 (-11). Things looked bleak for the Vols early as VT outgd' UT 204-28 and led 14-0 after 1Q. UT capitalized on 5 VT fmb's to win despite being outgd' 400-330 & outFD'd 21-16. UT QB Dobbs ran for 106 (7.6) and 2 tds. Ohio will be playing B2B road gms in this one after winning at Kansas LW, 37-21 (+1). The Bobcats led 28-7 at HT and finished +262 yds & +18 FD's. OU also held KU to just 26 (1.7) rush yds. OU is just 4-11 as an AD and is 0-8 in their 2nd of B2B road gms!

MARSHALL by 21 over Akron - These 2 used to be in the MAC together and UA's last visit here was back in '03. The last mtg was in '14 and MU (-10) won on the road 48-17. The HT is 5-3 SU/6-1-1 ATS. This is MU's 1st gm vs an FBS foe after a bye in wk1 and they ply'd an FCS foe LW and won 62-0 (-45). Akron was dismantled LW at Wisky, 47-10 (+23). The Zips were -362 yds & -22 FD's and all'd 294 (5.3) rush yds. This will be UA's 2nd str road gm while MU doesn't go on road until Oct. The largest area of concern on the Akron D is their young LB corps & look for Marshall to take advantage of that with exp'd QB Litton, who had more pass td's (6) then incompletions (3) LW. MU is 11-4-1 as a HF & the Zips don't normally respond well off DD loss as they're just 3-7 ATS in that role.

NEBRASKA by 10 over Oregon - NU has won the L/4 vs Oregon by 45 ppg but they last met in 1986. Mike Riley is very familiar with the Ducks going 4-10 SU vs them while as a HC at Oregon St. Neb is coming off a 52-17 (-24) win vs WY. The Huskers led just 24-17 4Q when the wheels fell off for WY as Neb forced 4 consecutive TO's and outscored WY 28-0 in the 4Q. Neb held a 550-320 yd edge and 7 of WY's pts came off a 4D 35 yd td pass just secs before HT. QB Armstrong set the schl rec for pass td's in a car (57) in the gm and finished w/377 pass yds. Ore comes in off a 44-26 (-24) win over Virginia. RB Freeman went off for 207 (9.9) rush yds and QB Prukop was impressive, going 21-31-331-3. While the Ducks Off is in midssn form, their D is vulnerable, especially considering that they all'd a struggling UVA Off to rush for 193 (4.8) despite giving up 6 sks! Neb worked on their rush gm exclusively in gm 1 (51 rushes, 13 passes) & is avg 215 (4.6) rush ypg. Neb is a sleeper pick to win the B10 & a win this week could give the players the confidence needed before they start their conf slate.

Ucla by 4 over BYU - LY these two met for the first time since UCLA's 59-0 loss at BYU in '08. BYU led 23-17 4Q but UCLA got a td to pull out 24-23 (-16) home win. LW UCLA won 42-21 (-26) vs UNLV. The Bruins led just 28-21 4Q but scored 2 tds to pull away. They held 499-328 yd & 30-18 FD edges. BYU is coming off their second loss to rival Utah since L/December. The Cougars forced 6 TO's but committed 3 of their own incl a pick 6 to start the gm. BYU trailed 20-13 4Q but scored a td w/0:18 left. New HC Sitake chose to go for a 2 pt conv to win the gm and it failed, giving UT the 20-19 win (+3). UCLA does have a big game on deck vs Stan while BYU has a neutral site game vs WV. BYU is 14-5 as a Dog. UCLA is 7-3 SU in non conf AG's and 3-0 as an AF.

Miami, FI by 10 over APALACHIAN ST - This is the first meeting for these two and just the 3rd non-conf FBS team to visit Kidd Brewer Stadium. LW UM won easily vs FAU 38-10 although it did take some time to get going as it was scoreless in the 2Q. QB Kaaya wasn't himself, going just 17-31-91-0-2 but UM held a 279-47 rush yd edge. RB Walton went for 155 (9.1) and 4 tds while RB Yearby added 121 (6.1). App St also won easily LW, 31-7 (-21). App St finished +89 yds & +4 FD's. RB Cox went for 133 (7.4) and 3 tds. App St did have some trouble stopping the run as they all'd ODU to go for 157 (5.1). UM has a bye on deck which should help them focus for this gm. The Canes are 8-4-1 ATS overall and when HC Richt wins SU, his teams are 87-45-2 ATS!

OKLAHOMA ST by 3 over Pittsburgh This is the first meeting. We went against both schools LW, winning 3★ LPS on each! Pitt is coming off an emotional win over rival Penn St 42-39 (-5) LW. Pitt all'd just 15 passes in the gm as they dominated the trenches and rushed for 341 (6.3) yds as a tm while holding PSU stud RB Barkley to just 85 (4.3). RB Conner continued his impressive ret from Cancer and rushed for 117 (5.3). OKSt struggled vs C Mich LW but appeared to have the gm won, leading 27-24 and running the clock out. An int grounding pen on 4D was called and the refs gave C Mich one untimed down from midfield, although rules state that the gm should have ended. C Mich turned that chance into a miraculous hail-and-laderal play that cost OKSt the game, 30-27 (-20) but our 'Big Dog' customers are still happy! OKSt was outgd' by 80 yds although 51 of that should have never happened. This is Pitt's road opener and they haven't traveled to a B12 schl s/'05 vs Neb. This is a sandwich gm for Pitt off their win over PSU and their ACC opener on deck. OKSt has their B12 opener on deck as well but are on their 3rd str home gm. OKSt is 27-14 as a HF vs FBS foes. Pitt is 6-1 ATS on the road.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 28 over Ulm - GaSo is 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS in the 2 recent SEC mtgs. LY GaSo won a shootout 51-31 (-6) and ULM all'd a ssn high 455 (6.8) rush yds. ULM is coming off an expected loss at OK 59-17 (+46) and they were outgd' 640-350 & outFD'd 30-15. LW GaSo beat S Alabama 24-9 (-13). The Eagles outgd' SA 441-352 and got an int in the EZ to finalize the cover. ULM has already given up 264 (5.7) rush ypg and now faces the GaSo option that they couldn't stop LY. GaSo is 6-4 as a HF and 6-2 overall ATS. ULM is on their 2nd of B2B road gms but they do have a bye on deck.

NC STATE by 20 over Old Dominion - NCSt won here in '14, 46-34 (-16) but ODU led 28-25 in the 3Q and finished with a 504-495 yd edge. Surprisingly LY ODU got NCSt at home but lost 38-14 (+17). NCSt did score a td with 1:33 left for the cover. The Wolfpack is coming off a tough loss at EC, 33-30 (-6). NCSt led 20-19 at HT and 30-26 4Q but all'd a late td and their final drive ended at the EC24 but time ran out. They also missed 2 fg's and had a failed fake fg. The Wolfpack finished +52 yds but -4 FD's. ODU also lost LW, 31-7 (+21) at App St. ODU fell behind 24-7 at HT. QB Washington struggled, completing less than 50% of his passes for just 152 yds. ODU is 1-3 as a AD. NCSt is now 7-2 as a Fav. The Wolfpack also has the schedule edge as they have a bye on deck while ODU is on their 2nd of B2B road gms.

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Michigan St +7' over Notre Dame

MSU's last win in this series was in '10 on the Little Giants play. ND has won the L/3 incl the last mtg in '13, 17-13 (-4) and it was MSU's lone loss of the ssn. There were 7 upsets in a 9 year stretch from '97-'05 but just one the last 8 years. LY was the first year ND didn't play a single B10 tm s/1914. LW ND bounced back from their opening loss and cruised to an easy win vs NV, 39-10 (-28). ND held 444-330 yd & 21-16 FD edges. ND led 25-0 at HT and NV didn't get a td until late 4Q. MSU is coming off a bye wk and beat an FCS in wk1, 28-13 (-37). Sparty wasn't pleased with their wk 1 results & have had an extra week to prep for this huge matchup. They did not have a medical issue with one of their ch's on D just prior to the wk 1 gm, which surely explains the Spartans lackluster perf. MSU is 9-3 as a Dog and 19-8 ATS away from Lansing & ND is 36-53-3 as a HF as tms tend to get up to ply in South Bend. We will gladly take Sparty getting a td in this one as we go for a 3-0 start on our Underdog POW! FORECAST: NOTRE DAME by 1

SOUTHERN MISS by 4 over Troy - The L/mtg between these 2 was in '08 in a bowl and SM won 30-27 (+4). The L/reg ssn mtg was back in '77. SM kept the momentum going from their ssn opening win at KY and won easily LW vs an FCS foe, 56-0 (-56). LW Troy was a huge underdog vs Clemson but stuck w/the Tigers and trailed just 13-10 at HT and 4Q before losing 30-24 (+35). The Trojans were only outgd 414-386 and outFD'd 21-18 and weren't out of it until a failed onside kick late 4Q. This is the second of B2B road gms for Troy and they were 2-0 ATS in that role LY. SM is 6-14 ATS vs FBS foes and 3-7-1 as a HF. Troy is now 5-1 as an AD under HC Brown.

UL LAFAYETTE by 4 over South Alabama - This series is split 2-2 with the HT going 4-0 SU/ATS. SA was coming off their big win over Miss St LW and plyd GaSo. SA trailed 10-6 at HT and lost 24-9 (+13). The Jags just missed a backdoor cover when they threw an int in the EZ in the final minute. ULL got their 1st win of the ssn by beating an FCS foe 30-22 (-3) winning a 3★ LPS Small College Play. ULL held a 390-364 yd edge but was outFD'd 27-20. This is ULL's 3rd str home gm while SA is on the road for the 2nd time in 3 wks. The Cajuns are 6-10 as a HF but SA is 3-7 as an AD.

MEMPHIS by 17 over Kansas - LY was the 1st mtg and Mem dominated KU 55-23 (-13). This is KU's road opener and they are 3-16 SU in road openers and have lost 35 str gms on the road. A week after Kansas won vs an FCS schl and their fans stormed the field (despite the PA announcer pleading w/ them to get off the field for the respect of the program) fans were reminded that the Jayhawks have a long way to go in a home loss to Ohio 37-21 (-1). The score wasn't indicative of how badly the Jayhawks were dominated as KU finished w/just 9 FD's and were -264 yds. KU trailed 28-7 and had a 359-21 yd deficit at HT! Mem is off a bye week and beat an FCS foe in wk1, 35-17 (-30). This will be Mem QB Ferguson's (Tenn transfer) first start vs an FBS foe. Mem holds a HUGE (#2 vs #123) ST's edge in this one as well. The Jayhawks are on a 3-11 ATS run and are 16-28-1 as an AD. Mem is 10-1-2 ATS vs Non Conf FBS foes and have covered their L/3 off a bye although this is the first for HC Norvell.

AUBURN by 4 over Texas A&M - The HT is surprisingly 0-4 both SU and ATS in SEC games. LY Aub had a 311-166 rush edge and led 14-3 at the half in their controlling 26-10 road win (+7). LTH Aub was #3 in the country (-23) but A&M jumped out 35-17 at HT. Aub got to 41-38 but fmbld on each of their L/2 drives at the A&M 2 and 29 yd line in the upset loss. Aub settled on a QB LW vs Ark St and won 51-14 (-20). QB White had the best gm of his young car, going 17-23-244-3. The Tigers outrushed Ark St 462-66 for the gm and both RB's Pettway (152, 10.1) and Johnson (124, 6.9) went for over 100. The 706 ttl yds was the most in schl hist vs an FBS foe. A&M smoked an overmatched FCS 67-0 (-49). This is A&M's road opener and QB Knight's 1st SEC road gm. HC Sumlin is 2-6 as an AD and A&M is 3-7 ATS. Auburn is 1-6 ATS as an SEC Fav, and 1-8 as a HF. Both tms are 2-0 ATS to start the ssn.

NORTH WESTERN by 6 over Duke - LY we used NW as our Underdog POW on these pages and they won outright, 19-10 (+4). NW is 8-2 SU (5-5 ATS) in the series and there have been 5 outright upsets the L/9 mtgs with the visitor going 8-2 ATS. NW is coming off an embarrassing loss to FCS Illinois St, 9-7 (-12). NW led 7-6 but all'd a GW 33 yd fg as time expired. NW finished -95 yds & -9 FD's. Duke also lost LW, 24-14 (-6) to Wake Forest. Duke was -20 yds for the gm but +8 FD's and missed 2 fgs along with having 3 TO's. This is Duke's road opener and they follow this w/a trip to South Bend while NW is plyng their 3rd str home gm and don't go on the road in Sept. NW is 13-26 as a HF while Duke is 10-3 as a Dog and 23-9 ATS as a visitor.

OKLAHOMA by 4 over Ohio St - This is one of the marquee Non Conf gms of the year but it lost some luster when OU lost to Houston to open the ssn. OSU came into this ssn w/just 6 ret str's while OU has 13 ret str's from LY's playoff tm. LW the Buckeyes gave us another easy winner in our Early Bird POW (2-0 this ssn!) in a 48-3 (-28) blowout of Tulsa. RB Samuels has 401 ttl yds this ssn which is the most by an OSU plyr through 2 gms s/96. OSU held Tulsa's highpowered OFF to just 185 yds and forced 6 TO's! OK also won easily LW, 59-17 (-46) vs ULM. The Sooners led 42-0 at HT and rested QB Mayfield for the entire 2H. OU held 640-350 yd & 30-15 FD edges. There is slight concern for Buckeye nation as their OFF struggled for large portions of LW's gm as QB Barrett was still taking snaps late 4Q to get into a flow. OSU is 6-9 as a reg ssn fav, while OU is 35-24 as a HF vs FBS foes. The Sooners are in a must win situation to reach the playoffs, while the Buckeyes can afford a slip up and still be in the mix for a spot at the end.

Alabama by 17 over MISSISSIPPI - Bama had won 23 str SEC openers until getting beat by Ole Miss LY, 43-37 (-6). Ole Miss also got 2 huge plays, a tipped pass that went for a td and another play where QB Kelly rolled to his right and threw a td pass on a play an OL was more than 5 yds downfield. Ole Miss was held to 95 yds in the 1H but 5 TO's were the key to beating Bama for consecutive ssn's for the 1st time in schl history (DOUBLE REVENGE!). It was also their first win in Tuscaloosa since '88. HC Saban wasn't happy w/Bama's performance LW vs WKU in a 38-10 (-28) win, saying he was "almost embarrassed". QB Hurts became Bama's 1st true frosh stg QB s/84 (Vinnny Sutton). Ole Miss won vs an FCS foe LW 38-13 (-43). HC Saban isn't happy about the L2Y results in this matchup & we can bet he's had this date circled on his calendar. Bama is 6-0 ATS in reg ssn road gms & gets their revenge in a major way this week. Roll Tide.

MISSOURI by 1 over Georgia - LTH in '14 we used a LPS on UGA and they dominated MO, winning 34-0 (-3). It was UGA's first road shutout of a rnkld foe s/82. LY UGA held MO w/o a td again but only won 9-6 (-14) although they held a 298-164 yd edge. LW Frosh QB Eason made his 1st start vs FCS Nicholls. The Dawgs led just 10-7 at HT and held on to win 26-24 (-53). LW HC Odom became just the 2nd HC for MO to win their home opener s/57. The Tigers got their offense going early for once, scoring a td in the 1Q for the 1st time s/Oct 3 of LY and cruised to a 61-21 (-24) win vs EM. MO put up 647 yds of OFF (most s/11) and QB Lock threw for 450 yds and 5 tds. After their solid wk 1 win over UNC, the Bulldogs took a huge step back against an inferior opponent LW. UGA struggled mightily on OFF with a true frosh making his 1st start & now he is making his 1st road start in hostile territory

against a SEC D. Mizzou's OFF is showing improvement & we like the Tigers to keep this one closer than expected. UGA is also on a 5-8 ATS run in reg ssn gms.

LSU by 14 over Mississippi St - LSU is now 15-1 SU vs MSU and the visitor has won 3 in a row SU. LTH in '14, MSU upset LSU 34-29. MSU has not won 2 straight trips to Baton Rouge since '81/'83. LSU is 14-5-1 ATS in this series but Miss St has covered the L/2 after LY's 21-19 (+4) loss. LW we said the public would overreact to Miss St's loss to SA and made them our top selection on these pages. Miss St jumped out to a 24-0 HT lead and won 27-14 (-7), giving us another 4★ winner! Miss St held 485-243 yd & 24-18 FD edges. After being benched in wk1, QB Fitzgerald had 195 (11.5) rush and 178 pass. SC also added a garbage time td that made the gm closer than it appeared. LSU is off a lackluster 34-13 win vs an FCS foe but the big news was that QB Harris was benched for QB Etling. Also, RB Fournette DNP (ankle, CS). This is Miss St's road opener and they are 5-10 ATS in those but they are 6-2 as AD's. LSU is 8-3-1 as a HF vs FBS foes.

Navy by 4 over Tulane - These two met every year from 1998-'05 with Tulane going 5-3 SU but Navy 5-3 ATS. The HT is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS. LY they met for the first time in conf play and Navy led 31-7 when TU got a td pass with -26 left for the backdoor cover. TU did finish with a 386-291 yd edge. Navy lost their stg QB for the ssn in the opener and QB Worth made his first car str in a 28-24 (-4) win vs UConn LW. Navy led 21-7 at HT but trailed 24-21 late 4Q before getting the winning td then stopped the Huskies on the Navy1 to end the gm. LW Tulane blew out an FCS foe 66-21 (-28). Tulane did fair well vs the option LY, going 2-0 ATS and holding both foes well below their ssn avg. These 2 HC's met in '14 with both running the option offense and Navy was -3 at home and beat GA Sthrn 52-19. This is TU's 3rd str home gm and Navy's road opener. Tulane is 8-14 as a Dog while Navy is 9-4 as a Fav and is 6-1 ATS in road openers.

ARIZONA by 14 over Hawaii - These two haven't met since '98 when AZ finished 12-1, (#4 AP). Haw had their home opener LW and squeaked by an FCS foe, 41-36 (-10) but were outgd 418-378 & outFD'd 22-15. AZ also won LW vs FCS Grambling St, but actually trailed 21-3 at HT before coming back to win 31-21 (-45). AZ was outgd 642-445 & outFD'd 28-21 but won because they forced 6 TO's. QB Solomon DNP due to inj (CS). The 'Cats all'd 402 pass yds. This is UH's 3rd long trip in 4 wks as they've been to Australia (vs Cal), all the way to Mich, and now to the mainland again. AZ has their P12 opener on deck vs Wash. Haw is 4-9 as an AD. AZ is 3-9 ATS vs Non Conf foes and on a 5-11 ATS run.

STANFORD by 7 over Usc - Stan had won 4 str SU in this series from '09-'12 but USC pulled upsets in '13 and '14. LY the school's plyd twice and USC lost at home 41-31 (-9) and then lost in the P12 title gm, 41-22 (-4). Stan is coming off a bye and the wk prior beat Kansas St 26-13 (-14). LW USC just missed being a LPS and they rolled over Utah St 45-7 (-16). The Trojans looked much improved from wk1, holding 422-253 yd & 29-13 FD edges. USC led 21-0 at HT and 31-7 after 3Q. USC has lost 4 str AG's. USC is 1-6 as an AD and 8-18 ATS off a SU win. This is the start of a brutal 3 gm stretch for Stan as they follow this up with B2B road gms vs UCLA and Wash. Stan is 7-5 as a HF and is on a 13-5 ATS run.

Texas by 10 over CALIFORNIA - These two met LY. UT was at home and came back from a 45-24 deficit in the 4Q and appeared to tie the gm but missed the PAT and lost 45-44 (+6). We brought home another winner LW with Cal as both our Underdog POW on these pages and a 4★ LPS as they covered in their 45-40 (+7) loss. Cal held 604-463 yd & 30-22 FD edges over SDS and QB Webb threw for 522 yds and 5 tds. TX is coming off a 41-7 (-29) win over UTEP. True frosh QB Buechele had another outstanding gm, going 22-27-244-4 despite missing 2 stg OL. TX held UTEP to just 208 ttl yds and 10 FD's. Cal has already been to Australia (vs Haw) and SDS and now this is their home opener. TX is 3-1 as an AF under Strong while HC Dykes is 3-10 as a HD.

NEVADA by 7 over Buffalo - The WolfPack are 2-0 SU/ATS in this series. LY NV was at Buffalo and James Butler ran for 177 yds and Don Jackson for 113. NV (+1) held on to win 24-21 despite BU having a 487-379 yd edge. NV is coming off a loss at ND 39-10 (+28). The gm was 0-0 after 1Q until ND's offense got going. NV was outgd 444-300 and their only td didn't come until late 4Q. BU is off a bye wk (1-9 ATS off reg ssn bye wks) and lost to FCS Albany the wk prior. BU held 403-238 yd & 23-12 FD edges but 4 TO's kept Albany in the gm. BU is 10-16 ATS as an AD and this is their first trip past the Mississippi since 2013 when they lost to Baylor 70-13 (+27). NV is 6-1 ATS.

Utah by 17 over SAN JOSE ST - Utah and SJST were once in the WAC together from '96-'98. Utah is 4-0 SU all-time here winning their last trip 24-14 in '09. It's not often a team wins after having committed 6 TO's but that's what Utah did LW vs BYU in the 'Holy War', which the Utes won 20-19 (-3). Utah did benefit from LB Tauteoli's int ret for a td to start the gm and finished with 363-328 yd & 20-18 fd edges but Utah needed a stopped 2 pt conv late 4Q to hold on for the win. SJST dismantled an FCS schl 66-35 (-21). SJST is just 2-13 as a Dog. This is a large sandwich game as Utah is off their rival BYU and has USC on deck but they are 6-2 SU in road openers incl wins in Provo and the Big House.

WASHINGTON ST by 21 over Idaho - This will be a short road trip for ID, as these schools are just 8 miles apart. These two last met in '13 and WSU won 42-0 (-31). The Cougars need a win badly after str'g the ssn at 0-2. LW WSU lost at Boise St 31-28 (+11) in a gm that saw QB Falk throw 71 times (480 yds). WSU actually outgd Boise 520-420 and held a 26-21 FD edge but had trouble finishing drives. Their F/6 drives were finished in Boise territory but none resulted in pts. ID will be travelling to the state of Washington for the 2nd str wk after losing to the Huskies LW 59-14 (+37). ID was outgd 482-322 & outFD'd 27-17. They also all'd 356 yds pass (82%) and now face an even more pass happy WSU. ID is 11-6 as a Dog and 9-1 as an AD vs FBS foes. WSU is on an 11-4 ATS run.

4★ NEW ENGLAND over Miami - Despite going into the desert extremely shorthanded without the services of QB Brady, TE Gronkowski and a pair of O-linemen, the Pats surprisingly delivered the outright upset of the 7-pt favorite Cardinals (1st time as a Wk 1 dog in 12 ssn) following a solid opening start from QB Garoppolo (264 yds, 1 TD). They now return home to take on a Dolphins squad that suffered a narrow defeat at the hands of the Seahawks despite being the biggest dog of the weekend (SEA 21-11 & 352-222 yd edges). Needing a win to secure the #1 seed for the AFC playoffs, NE found themselves on the wrong side of the scoreboard in LY's ssn finale in MIA as the Dolphins delivered the 20-10 upset as a 9' pt dog. With the Pats seeking revenge and likely having a few of their starters back (still no Brady), we'll look for MIA to continue their ATS struggles inside of the division where they've covered just 3 of their L/14.

3★ OAKLAND over Atlanta - The Falcons continued their ATS skid (2-11 run) a week ago at home against the Bucs as TB jumped out to a 31-13 lead in the 3Q and delivered yet another win over their division rival (3rd straight). The Raiders meanwhile took advantage of an always suspect Saints defense by storming back from a 24-10 deficit in the 3Q in the 35-34 victory (OAK made 2 pt conv w/:52 left for the win). While the Raiders have been a HF on just 2 occasions over the past 2 years, we'll give them the lean in this one as the Falcons head to the Bay Area with just a 2-7 ATS record in road openers.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Indianapolis (+) over DENVER - The Broncos were able to escape last Thur with a 21-20 victory in their SB rematch with the Panthers (CAR missed the GW 50 yd FG w/:04 remaining, DEN trailed 17-7 at HT) despite a mixed bag of results out of QB Siemian in his 1st car start (18-26-178-1-2). With WR Thomas potentially missing due to inj (CS), they now play host to a Colts squad that has come out victorious in each of their L/2 matchups incl a WC Rnd upset of DEN during the '14 ssn. In a Wk 1 shootout with the Lions, IND failed to hold on to a late lead (:43 left) as DET nailed the GW FG w/:08 remaining (74 comb pts, 898 tll yds). With the Colts posting a solid 12-5 ATS mark as a dog and a 16-6-1 ATS record following a SU loss under Pagano, we'll go ahead and call for IND to stay within the line here.

OTHER PLAYS

NY Jets at BUFFALO - Thursday - Rex Ryan welcomes his former squad following a pair of outright upsets a yr ago incl a 22-17 in LY's ssn finale (knocked Jets out of final playoff spot). The Bills will need to get their offense going however after coming out flat a wk ago against the Ravens when they mustered just 7 pts and 160 tll yds. While the Jets delivered a much stronger performance in Wk 1 w/340 yds of tll offense and sacking QB Dalton for 7 occasions, it was a blkd FG and missed PAT that did them in at the end in a 1 pt home loss to CIN (3★ LP Winner on NYJ +1). Although the Jets are the better team on paper and are clearly seeking revenge from a ssn ago (12-6-1 ATS run vs DIV opp), Ryan and company (Bills 7-2 ATS run at home, incl a 4-0 run in openers) should be amped up for another Thur Night battle. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk.

DETROIT by 7 over Tennessee - The Titans head on the road to take on their 2nd straight NFC North team to begin the year following LW's matchup against the Vikings, a game in which they took a 10-0 lead into HT before allowing MIN to get back into the contest with a pair of def TD's (Titans current ATS streak now at 1-8). In a gm that featured nearly 900 yds of tll offense, the Lions were able to connect on the GW FG w/:08 left to move their ATS run to 7-2. While the Titans running game is a good compliment to QB Mariota and the rest of the offense, TEN's recent success as a dog (7-23 ATS) has us leaning with a Lions squad that is 8-2 ATS as a HF and are playing their only home gm in the first 4 wks of the '16 ssn.

Kansas City by 3 over HOUSTON - The Chiefs head to Houston for the 3rd time in just over a year with some pretty good confidence after a pair of convincing wins that included a shutout of the Texans in LY's WC playoff Rnd. After their come-from-behind OT victory LW at home against the Chargers (trailed 24-3 in 3Q, largest comeback in franchise history), KC has now come out victorious in 11 consec regular ssn contests (8-4 ATS during streak). Following their 23-14 win LW in the debut of QB Osweiler (22-35-231-2-1) for HOU in which we delivered a 3★ LP Winner on the UNDER 43, the Texans have also rattled off quite a solid ATS record by covering 8 of their past 10. While both tms have delivered a consistent cash flow dating back to the midway point of LY, the smart money is definitely in favor of the Chiefs after they outscored HOU by a 57-20 margin a ssn ago.

Baltimore by 8 over CLEVELAND - After continuing their recent ssn-opening skid with a 12th consec SU defeat LW in Philly against the Eagles (just 10 pts & 288 tll yds in RG3's debut), the Browns return home to take on a Ravens squad that has owned the series in this venue with a 7-1 ATS mark. The Ravens used a suffocating def effort a wk ago against the Bills (all'd just 7 pts and 160 yds) to earn their 1st ssn-opening win s/'12. With QB Flacco now having a game in the books following his return from LY's ACL and the Browns' overall ATS futility (2-9 run) and B2B road trips on the horizon, BAL should have no problem going into CLE and delivering a solid win as a road favorite once again.

PITTSBURGH by 3 over Cincinnati - The Bengals and Steelers had one of the more memorable playoff gms in recent history LY as while CIN had the contest virtually locked up, a late fmb! and a pair of boneheaded per fouls all'd PIT to drill the GW FG. Although the Steelers' MNF outcome is unknown as of presstime, they do enter this matchup with recent success inside the AFC North with a 15-8 ATS mark incl covers in 4 of their L/5 reg ssn meetings with the Bengals (avg win by nearly 10 ppg). Following a narrow 1 pt road win by CIN a wk ago against the Jets (Dalton sk'd a career-high 7 times), the line could be within reach as they have proven to be dynamic as an AD with a 14-5 ATS mark.

WASHINGTON by 5 over Dallas - The Redskins are at home for a 2nd straight week following their MNF tilt against the Steelers. While they do face a Cowboys squad that was one of just 2 tms to go into D.C. and come out with a reg ssn win a ssn ago (19-16 win on MNF as a 3' pt dog), DAL could be in some trouble in this one as rookie QB Prescott makes his very first road start following a subpar performance a wk ago in the 1 pt loss against the Giants where they ran out of time at the end despite FD and yd edges for the gm. With just a 3-10-1 ATS run by the Cowboys, the smart money is clearly with the Redskins in this meeting as they delivered covers in 4 of their L/5 NFC East matchups to close out LY.

NY GIANTS by 3 over New Orleans - The Saints and Giants were involved in quite the OT shootout a ssn ago as the matchup featured 101 pts and 1,030 yds of tll offense (finished as the worst 2 defenses in the NFL LY). The previously mentioned high-scoring affair has been quite the norm lately for the Saints who blew a 2 TD lead in the 3Q in LW's 35-34 loss to OAK in the Superdome (OAK 2 pt conv w/:52 left for the win). The Giants and new HC McAdoo earned their 1st win of the ssn in dramatic fashion w/DAL running out of time near FG range trailing by 1. While both tms still have quite a bit of work to do with their defensive units as the '16 ssn begins, the Giants may have some issues pulling too far away from the Saints in this one as they've actually dropped each of their L/4 home openers (SU & ATS) by 10 ppg.

CAROLINA by 20 over San Francisco - Rough situation for the 49ers in this one as they head to the East Coast on a short week (MNF vs Rams) to take on a CAR team off a narrow opening night loss on Thur to DEN (19-11 ATS off loss) thanks to a missed 50 yd FG w/:09 remaining (led 17-7 at HT). While SF is 3-8 ATS as an AD, this will mark just the 2nd time in the L/7 yrs that they come in getting double digit pts (lost 29-13 LY in SEA as a 13' pt dog). With the Panthers likely looking to make a statement in this one with solid ATS marks (8-3 vs NDIV foes and 13-6 as a HF) along with SF having a road trip to rival SEA on deck, there is clearly only one way to lean in this matchup.

ARIZONA by 7 over Tampa Bay - Despite being an AD for their 24th consec gm LW against the Falcons, the Bucs used a 4 TD performance from QB Winston to help deliver the outright upset in ATL while also cashing out Top Weekly LP 3.5★ in the process (Bucs have a winning record for the 1st time s/'12). The Cardinals meanwhile struggled in LW's home opener against a shorthanded Patriots squad (1st time favored vs NE s/'91) as their late FG was no good in the 2 pt defeat (NE 363-344 yd edge). While the Cardinals are a very solid 21-9 ATS vs NDIV foes and the Bucs come in rejuvenated with new HC Koetter (TB was Top 10 LY in both off & def), we'll let the oddsmakers decide which way we lean in this one with ARZ opening up as a TD favorite.

Seattle by 3 over LOS ANGELES - The Rams delivered one of the more surprising ssn sweeps a ssn ago against the Seahawks that included a 23-17 win in SEA as a 12 pt dog. Following their MNF tilt against the 49ers in SF, the Rams are back in LA for their 1st reg ssn home gm in 21 yrs although the once high-flying pass offense has now been grounded in favor of 2nd yr RB Gurley who rushed for 85 yds and a TD in his only matchup as a rookie vs SEA. The Seahawks surprisingly had their hands full LW with MIA despite being a DD fav as they needed the GW TD w/:35 remaining (SEA substantial FD and yd edges). Despite a 7-2 ATS run and an extra day of rest for SEA and plenty of talent all over their roster (CS on QB Wilson's ankle), they may find it difficult to cover in their trip to the Coliseum (1-10 ATS run in road openers) as more than 90,000 are expected to be in attendance.

Jacksonville by 1 over SAN DIEGO - The Jaguars head to SD with just a 1-5 ATS mark in road openers which includes a 25 pt loss (+7) to this very same Chargers team back in '10. While they stormed back late a wk ago in their opener against GB (JAX 348-294 yd edge), JAX fell just short in the 4 pt defeat. The Chargers also nearly came out with the outright upset victory (+6) a wk ago in Arrowhead (led 24-3 in 3Q) before a late offensive outburst by KC allowed them to escape in OT. While JAX has clearly had their issues in Sept with just a 4-15 ATS mark, they could be seeking some revenge following a 6 pt home loss a ssn ago (-5) to this very same SD squad (JAX 420-369 yd edge). With the Chargers' negative record as a HF (2-8 ATS), we find ourselves leaning with a young Jaguars roster that looks to be on the verge of moving up the AFC standings.

Green Bay at MINNESOTA - SNF - Following a solid 2H by the Vikings that saw their def score on a pair of occasions in their 9 pt victory over the Titans with bkp QB Hill under center, MIN (14-2 ATS NR) returns home to play their very 1st reg ssn home matchup in their new stadium with newly added QB Bradford expected to get the start.
