The Panthers return home after B2B AG's & have a home gm vs MT on deck, while the Bulldogs are on their 2nd of B2B AG's & have a HG vs Rice on deck.

**AIR FORCE by 17 over Hawaii** - AF is 2-0 SU & the visitor is 2-0 ATS in their MW mtgs. UH is 1-6 SU in Colorado Springs w/their last win in '92 but their LTH ('12) on a Fri night only lost 21-7 (+22). LY AF led 34-0 at the half & won 58-7 (-6). Our big dogs went 5-4 w/3 outright upsets LW as we went against both sch's. AF was upset 45-40 (-14) vs NM in Dallas at the Cotton Bowl. QB Romine threw for a surprising 280 yds & WR Robinette had 182 (26.0). AF is avg 460 ypg incl 275 (4.8) rush & UH is all'g 488 ypg incl 239 (5.6) rush. UH was upset vs UNLV 41-38 (-8) as they all'd the GW 28 yd fg w/49 left & were outFD'd 29-20 & out'd 535-446. They're #116 on D all'g 84 ypg more than their opp's avg. **UL Lafayette by 10 over TEXAS ST** - HC in San Marcos. ULL is 3-0 SU/ATS. LY ULL had FBS ssn highs in ttl (526) & rush (288) yds, finishing an FBS ssn best +175 yds in the 49-27 (-4) win. LTH ('14) ULL also had a ssn high in yds (528) & all'd reg ssn lows in ttl (270) & pass (176) yds, finishing a ssn best +258 yds in the 34-10 (+2) win. ULL enters w/a few days extra rest following their 24-0 (+10) loss vs AppSt last Wed. They were shutout at home for the 1st time s/'02, all'd 4 str scoring drives to open the gm & were out'd 372-267. ULL is #104 in the FBS avg 21 ypg less than their opp's allow & have our #115 ranked pass eff D. TXSt is off a 40-34 (+7) loss at ULM. They were down 33-14 at the half, but had a chance to win it at the end, but their 4&1 pass from the ULM 32 on the final pl was incomplete. TXSt was outFD'd 31-19 & out'd 480-355. TXSt is on just a 5-11 ATS run. The Cajuns have a bye on deck, while the Bobcats are home after B2B AG's & have a bye on deck.

**APPALACHIAN ST by 21 over Idaho** - HC in Boone. ASSt is 2-0 SU, but the visitor is 2-0 ATS. LY RB Moore ran for a schl rush rec 344 yds & ASSt (-20') pulled away in the 2H w/ID getting a bgb td at the end of the 47-20 final. LTH ('14) ID (+17') only trailed 17-15 in the 2Q but all'd 3 str td drives & never got closer than 17 the rest of the way, but covered 45-28. ASSt enters on a few days extra rest off a 24-0 (-10) win at ULL last Wed. They scored on their 1st 4 drives & had a 372-267 yd edge. Despite the option QB Lamb threw for 201 (58%) & WR Meadors had a car high 6-128. ASSt is avg 206 (4.5) rush ypg & ID is all'g 235 (6.2) rush ypg away, ID is off a 55-23 (-4') win over NMSt. QB Linehan set car highs in pass yds (476) & ttl td's (5) as they had 35-17 FD & 651-433 yd edges. The Mountaineers are 4-9 as a HF, but 10-6 ATS vs the SBC, while ID is just 2-7 SU on the SBC road (1-0 TY), but 11-3 as an AD. ASSt has a trip to GS with a short wk on deck, while the Vandals have a bye on deck.

They're #126 on OFF avg 120 ypg less than their opp's allow, but UMass is #115 on D all'g 81 ypg more than their opp's avg. UMass is off a 56-28 (+15) loss vs LT, getting out'd 689-397. SC is 4-6 as a HF & HC Muschamp is 11-18 ATS as a fav, but UMass is 9-17 as an AD. The Gamecocks have been home for 5 of the L/6 wks & have a home gm vs Tenn on deck, while the Minutemen are traveling for the 2nd time in 3 wks & have HC vs an FCS foe on deck.

ULM is #113 on D all'g 73 ypg more than their opp's avg. NM is 2-6-1 ATS as a fav vs non-conf foes & 4-10 ATS off a SU win, while ULM is 3-1 as an AD. The Lobos are ply'g at home for the 3rd time in 4 wks & have a trip to Haw on deck, while the Warhawks are travelling for the 1st time in 3 wks making a rare trip to the altitude & have a trip to Ark St on deck.

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 17 over Buffalo** - HC is DeKalb. NI is 8-0 SU/6-2 ATS winning by 28 ppg in the series. LY NI led 28-3 at the half, but UB chipped away to 38-30 before NI added a td w/3:14 left & won 41-30 (-6'). LTH ('12) NI rolled to a 45-3 (-14') win. NI is off a 34-28 (+2') 3OT loss vs CM. They're #104 on D all'g 67 ypg more than their opp's avg. UB is off a 31-21 (+10') loss vs Ball St. QB Jackson set car highs in pass yds & td's hitting 28-48-306-3-0. They're #124 on D all'g 113 ypg more than their opp's avg. UB is all'g 285 (5.3) rush ypg, while NI is avg 218 (5.4) rush ypg. NI is on a 2-8 ATS run, but UB is 4-8 as an AD. The Huskies are on the 2nd of B2B HG's & have a bye on deck, while the Bulls are travelling for just the 2nd time in 5 wks, but have Akron with a short wk at home on deck.

**Ucf by 3 over CONNECTICUT** - HC in Storrs. CT is 2-1 SU/ATS pulling off outright upsets the L2Y. LY UCF was 0-5 & took the opening drive 73/13pl for a 3-0 lead, but their next 10 drives gained 57/26pl & they trailed 40-3 before a couple of late scores in the 40-13 (-2') pounding. UCF appeared in complete control LW up 25-7 late 2Q, but up 5 w/3:32 left all'd a 70/4pl drive & the GW 8 yd td pass w/0:01 remaining in a gm they never previously trailed. CT is off a 42-27 (+20) loss at USF, getting out'd 527-378. CT is #106 on OFF avg 59 ypg less than their opp's allow. UCF has 23 sks (10.5%), while CT has all'd 20 sks (8.8%). UCF is 23-14 as an AD, while CT is 0-11 as a HF. TT got the backdoor cover with a td on the L/ply of the game to make it 42-30 (+13). OU rolled to a 62-27 (-14) win with QB Mayfield taking on his ex-teams who made him sit out a year even though he was only a walk-on at TTech. The Sooners are coming off a 38-17 (-13) home win vs Kansas St. For the ssn, OU avg 203 (5.0) rush and 323 (71%) pass yds and their OFF is #3 in the FBS, avg 170 ypg more than their foes allow but their D is #92 in our Pass Eff D rankings. TT enters off a 48-17 (+2') home loss to WV. TT avg 511 pass ypg and their OFF is #2 in the FBS, avg 176 ypg more than their foes allow but their D is #112 in the FBS, all'g 70 ypg more than their foes avg and have all'd 205 (5.2) rush ypg. OU is 11-4 as an AF while TT is 11-6 as a HD.

**MICHIGAN by 35 over Illinois** - HC in Ann Arbor. The last mtg was in '12. UM is fresh off a bye & a 78-0 (-30) blowout over RU, finishing w/ssn highs in ttl (600) & rush (481) yds while off a ssn low 39 (+561 yds). They're avg 470 ypg incl 255 (5.7) rush & are #19 in the FBS on OFF avg 106 ypg more than their opp's allow. They just may have the best overall D in CFB, all'g 213 ypg incl 99 (2.9) rush & are #1 in the FBS all'g 222 ypg less than their opp's avg & are #5 in our pass eff D rankings. Ill is coming off a win over RU as well, 24-7 (-4). They led just 7-0 at HT although they were w/o QB Lunt (inj, CS) and passed for just 92 yds in the gm. While Mich was +561 yds vs RU, Ill was actually out'd by 65 yds and all'd RU to get their FBS highs in ttl (385) and rush (203) yds. UM is 7-4 as a HF. The Wolves have a huge gm at rival MSU on deck (5-0 SU/ATS prior). IL is playing their 3rd road game in 4 wks and they are 3-9 ATS as dogs.

**Houston by 28 over SMU** - SMU has lost 3 str by an avg of 27 ppg. The HT is 5-2 SU/4-3 ATS. LY SMU actually led 21-14 late 2Q, but would lose 49-28 (+25'). LTH ('14) SMU came in 0-10 & lost 35-9 (+29'). SMU is off a bye & a 43-40 (+15') OT loss at Tulsa the wk prior, all'g ssn highs in FD's (34) & rush yds (315). QB Hicks is compl just 52% w/a 6-9 ratio & they're all'g 455 ypg incl 280 (5.4) rush their L/2 gms. UH survived LW, 38-31 (-21') at home vs Tulsa. UH got the go ahead td on a FR then tk'd Tulsa inches from the GL as time expired. UH avg 505 ypg and their D is #16 in the nation, holding foes to 100 ypg less than their avg. SMU is 2-9 as a HD while UH is 9-2 as an AF. The Ponies are ply'g at home for the 1st time in 4 wks & have a trip to Tulane on deck. UH is 8-5 SU on the AAC road with their avg win by 25 ppg and their 5 losses by 5, 7, 7, 3 and 6.

**Wyoming by 3 over NEVADA** - HC in Reno. WY is 2-2 SU/ATS & has covered the L/2 mtgs, while the dog is 4-0 ATS. LTH ('12) WY only lost 35-28 (+19) w/NV getting a td pass in the final minutes. LY WY got 1 of their 2 wins of the ssn as they led 28-7 early 3Q & got the upset 28-21 (+6). WY is off a bye & a 35-26 (+11') win vs AF the wk prior, all'g an FBS ssn low 337 ttl yds. The Pokes avg 198 (4.4) rush ypg and face a poor NV run D that allows 251 (5.2). NV is off a 14-10 (+2') loss at SJSSt. The NV D had their best effort of the ssn, all'g ssn lows in ttl (279) and rush (137, 2.5) yds but it wasn't enough as they all'd the GW td w/50 left. For the ssn, NV struggles on both OFF & D, avg 104 ypg less than their foes allow (#121 in nation) and all'g 47 ypg more than their foes avg (#105 in nation). WY is 4-8 as an AF, while NV is 4-2 ATS at home. This is the 3rd AG in their L/4 gms overall for the Pokes & they have Boise at home on deck.

**TULSA by 6 over Tulane** - This is TLS's HC. TLS has dominated this series going 10-1 SU/ATS, winning by an avg of 26.5 ppg. LY TLS was -7 on the road with 1:12 left in the game and got 2 IR's and a miraculous 45-34 cover (-7). TLS also got a miracle cover LTH as they won 38-31 (-6') 2OT. TLN enters off a 24-14 (+11) home loss to Mem. They trailed 13-7 at HT but didn't score again until just 0:47 left to give Green Wave backers a backdoor cover. TLN actually held a 20-16 FD edge but was out'd 399-313. They have the #22 D in the nation, holding foes to 58 ypg less than their avg but their OFF is dead last in the nation, avg 103 ypg less than their foes allow. TLS is coming off a heartbreaking 38-31 (+21') loss at UH LW. The deciding score came on a 33 yd FR then TLS drove 74/8pl but were stopped just inches from the EZ as time ran out. TLS is +167 ypg at home and +62 ypg overall but has all'd 18 sks (8.1%) on the ssn while TLN has 15 sks (9.0%). TLS also just all'd 268 (4.9) rush LW & now must take on the option. TLS is just 3-9 as a HF vs FBS foes. This is TLN's 3rd road gm in 4 wks.

**WASHINGTON by 35 over Oregon St** - Ost was 7-1 SU/8-0 ATS from '04-11, but UW is now 4-0 SU/ATS, winning the L/3 by 37 ppg. UW is off a bye & a 70-21 (-9') win at Oreg the wk prior, finishing w/ssn highs in ttl (682) & rush (378) yds. QB Browning is a Heisman cand w/a 23-2 ratio. The Huskies are +189 ypg at home and have ply'd just 1 road gm all ssn. OSU is coming off a rain soaked 19-14 (+7) loss at home vs Utah. They held Utah to a ssn low 317 yds but that was mostly due to the weather. The gm was costly as both QB's Garretson and Blount were on crutches (CS) and RB Nall left after just 1 carry (foot, CS). The Beavers trailed 19-7 late 4Q and got a td to give their backers a backdoor cover. OSU is -150 ypg on the road. RB Gaskin could be in for a big day vs an Ore St D that allows 233 (5.2) rush ypg. OSU is banged up and playing a 6th consecutive wk while UW is ply'g their 3rd str home gm.

**BOWLING GREEN by 6 over Miami, Oh** - UM was 10-2 SU/9-2 ATS in the series, but BG is now 3-0 SU/ATS, covering by an avg of 18 pts. Surprisingly despite py'g in the same div, the last mtg was in '13 at UM and BG won big, 45-3 (-23'). BG looks like they are making progress after LW's closer than expected 42-35 (+31') loss at Tol. QB Morgan, making his 3rd start threw for 335 and 5 td's. The gm was tied late until they gave up the GW td w/18 left. BG was only out'd 541-502 but they have been out'd by every FBS foe TY. BG is nearly dead last (#127) in our Pass Eff D rankings. LW we went with the 3★ Total on the Under in the MU gm and picked up a winner as the RedHawks won 18-14 (+1'). Ply'g w/o QB Bahl (inj, CS), they trailed 14-12 late 4Q and got a GW 55 yd td pass w/1:34 left. MU is #119 on OFF, avg 98 ypg less than their foes allow but their D is #32, holding foes to 64 ypg less than their avg. MU is 10-5 ATS on the road and HC Martin is 2-5 as an AD and they are in their 3rd road game in 5 wks.

Mem is off a 24-14 (-11) home win vs Tulane. The Tigers led 24-7 until TU got their final td in gbg time. Interestingly, the 1 common foe between these two is TLN and the scores and #'s were nearly identical w/Mem +86 yds and Navy winning 21-14 (+85 yds). Navy is 8-2 ATS at home. The Middies have been home for 4 of the L/5 wks incl 3 str & have a trip to USF with a short wk on deck. Navy's option usually plays its best ball in the 2H of ssn. In the L4Y they avg 27.4 ppg in the F/6 gms, but 39.6 ppg the L/5 prior to Army. Navy was 4-0 SU in AAC HG's (+87 ypg) LY & is 2-0 SU TY (but -46 ypg). Memphis is on their 3rd road game in 4 wks. They all'd 169 (3.8) against the option LW (Tulane in 1st yr of system & still learning), but Navy is much more efficient running this unique system & as mentioned above, greatly improve as the ssn goes on. QB Johnson has thrown for under 100 yds the L/2 gms compl just 50%. MSt's bowl chances are getting slim after LW's 28-21 (+7) 2OT loss in a rare trip to the altitude at BYU. Despite the losing effort, they held a 386-311 yd & 23-20 FD edge but QB Fitzgerald threw 2 int's and was held to 47% compl. MSt is -78 ypg on the road and this is their 4th one in the L/5 gms. LTH ('14) UTEP all'd ssn lows in ttl (70) & pass (32) yds & won 34-0 (+13). UTEP is fresh off a bye & a disappointing 35-21 (-5) loss vs FIU the wk prior. They're #114 in the FBS on OFF avg 82 ypg less than their opp's allow. UTSA was nearly upset LW at Rice but held on to win 14-13 (-3). They led 14-6 at HT and Rice missed a go ahead fg late 4Q. UTSA has been out'd by all 5 of their FBS foes and are -77 ypg against them. They are #120 in the FBS on OFF, avg 99 ypg less than their opp's allow and they have all'd 22 sks (13.2%) but UTEP has just 5 sks (3.1%). UTEP is 7-14-1 ATS on the road and 8-17 as an AD. UTSA is 2-6 as a HF. The Miners are travelling for just the 2nd time in 6 wks.

**WKU by 10 over Old Dominion** - WKU HC. WKU is 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS & they've avg 101 ppg comb'd! LY WKU won 55-30 (-24'), scoring a td w/5:56 left for the cover. LTH ('14) ODU only trailed by 5 early 4Q & driving but a pass slipped out of QB Heinke's hand, int'd & ret'd 96 yds & WKU won 66-51 (-13'). ODU is off a bye & a 36-16 (-8) win vs UMass the wk prior, finishing w/ssn highs in FD's (29) ttl (522) & rush (274) yds. RB Lawry ret'd & they're avg 201 (5.2) rush ypg. ODU is 1-5 (0-2 TY) as an AD. WKU is off a 44-43 (+1) 2OT win at MT. They were out'd 605-521 and got a blk'd PAT in OT to help clinch the win. The Monarchs are travelling for just the 2nd time in 5 wks & have a trip to UTEP on deck. WKU on an 8th str wk and are off B2B emotional road gms. WKU is 8-4 ATS as a HF vs FBS foes. ODU is 2-8 as a dog.

**KANSAS ST by 4 over Texas** - KSU has dominated this series going 6-2 SU/7-2 ATS and the HT has won 4 in a row SU/ATS. UT has lost their L/4 trips here by 23, 19, 25 and 3. LY's game was in a heavy rain storm but UT led 16-6 at the half and won 23-9 (-6'). KSU is coming off a 38-17 (+13') loss at OK. The 'Cats were competitive, trailing 31-17 in the 4Q before all'g a late td. QB Ertz has compl just 50% of his passes on the ssn and their OFF is #116 in the nation, avg 83 ypg less than their foes allow but their D is #25, holding foes to 77 ypg less than their avg. UT got back on track LW w/a 27-6 (-14) home win vs ISU. TX trailed at HT 6-3 but QB Buechele threw 2 2H td's and for the gm had 296 pass yds. The Longhorns held 505-280 yd and 28-19 FD edges. UT's D is improving despite their #112 Pass Eff D ranking as they had 8 sks LW w/HC Strong taking control. TX is away from home for the 4th time in their L/5 gms and are 2-7 ATS away from Texas Memorial Stadium, while KSU is 43-19 ATS vs the B12.

**STANFORD by 10 over Colorado** - This is Stan's HC gm and CU's 4th road trip in 6 wks. The Buffs are 0-3 SU vs Stanford with losses by 48, 41 and 32. LY they were at home vs Stan and gave them their closest game in the series, still losing 42-10 (+16'). CU needs just 1 more win to be bowl eligible for the 1st time s/07 after LW's 40-16 (-11) home win vs AZSt. RB Lindsay ran for a car high 219 (8.4). Stan is coming off a 17-10 (+3) win in Notre Dame. Their D has kept them in gms and is #21 in the FBS, holding foes to 82 ypg less than their avg. CU (18 sks on the ssn) will look to take advantage of a weak Stan OL that has all'd 19 sks (13.3%) TY. Stan also has a big ST's edge (#18 vs #107). Stan is 10-6 as a HF & 10-4 off a SU win. CU is 7-0 ATS this ssn & 6-1 as an AD.

**Michigan St by 3 over MARYLAND** - MSU is 2-0 SU/ATS vs the Terps in B10 play. They won here in '14 37-15 (-11'). LY MSU won at home 24-7 (-14') QB Cook missing the 2H. Since MSU's upset win at ND, they've lost 4 str (1st time s/06) after LW's 54-40 (-6') home loss to NW. The Spartans led 14-0 in the 1Q and were only out'd 490-475. They got within 2 pts in the 3Q but all'd a 91 yd KR. QB Lewerke struggled in his 1st start and they went back to QB O'Connor in the 3Q and he threw for 281 and 3 td's. The 54 pts was their most all'd s/03 and they have just 6 sks (3.2%) on the ssn. MD enters off a 31-10 (-6') home loss to Minn. The Terps were forced to start true freshman QB Pilgrimage due to QB Hills inj (CS). Although they were barely out'd and even in FD's, MD couldn't overcome 4 TO's. They have all'd 19 sks (13.3%) on the ssn. MSU is 16-7-1 as an AF but that incl 4 str non-covers and they are on a 6-14 ATS run. MD is 4-8 as a HD. MSU does have a big game vs rival Mich on deck. MSU put up 386 yds on Mich LY when HC Durkin was the DC.

**MISSOURI by 8 over Middle Tennessee** - These 2 schools have only met once, back in '03 and MO needed OT to escape with a 41-40 (-21') win. MO is off a 40-14 (+13') beatdown at Florida. The Tigers were out'd 532-363 & outFD'd 22-16. QB Lock went 4-18-39 and threw 2 pick 6's. MT enters off an emotional 44-43 (-1) 2OT loss vs WKU. There were 8 lead changes and MT had their PAT blk'd in the 2OT, costing them the gm. QB Stockstill went 42-54-434-31 and MT held a 605-521 yd edge. Both tms have strong OFF's w/MO ranked #13, avg 115 ypg more than foes allow while MT is #29, avg 87 ypg more than their foes allow but both D's have struggled w/MO ranked #111, all'g 69 ypg more than their foes allow while MT is #95, all'g 44 ypg more than their foes allow. MO is 18-6 ATS off a SU loss. MT is 10-20 ATS vs non conf foes. MO is in a Fla/Kentucky sandwich but in need of wins. MT was psyched up at home LY for their game vs VU but still lost by 4 and also lost to Alabama by 27 and VU again TY by 23.

**Georgia Southern by 17 over NEW MEXICO ST** - GSU is 2-0 SU but 0-2 ATS in the series. LY GSU put up a ssn high 592 yds incl 507 (8.6) rush and got an easy home win, 56-26 (-30'). GSU lost their 3rd str gm (all on road) LW, 35-24 (+10') at GT. GSU trailed 21-7 1Q and 35-17 late 4Q before adding a late td. They were held to a ssn low 335 yds and despite being familiar w/the option, all'd GT to put up 265 (6.0) rush yds. GSU has been out'd by 100 ypg in their 3 str losses. NMSt is coming off a 55-23 (+4) loss at ID. The Aggies led 13-7 but was outscored 41-3 in the 2Q and 3Q. They were out'd 651-428 & outFD'd 34-17. For the ssn, NMSt's D is next to last in the FBS, all'g 151 ypg more than their foes avg and they have all'd 245 (5.3) rush ypg but earlier this ssn they did hold NM's option to a ssn low in yds, 150 yds less than their avg. NMSt is also dead last in the nation on our ST's rankings while GSU is #32. GSU is 4-1 as an AF but they are 1-5 ATS this ssn. NMSt is 15-29-3 as a dog and 11-25-3 off a SU loss.

**UCLA by 7 over Utah** - This is UCLA's HC. In their first 3 mtgs the HT was 3-0 SU/ATS but in the L/4 the HT is 1-3 SU/0-4 ATS. LY UCLA was on the road and won 17-9 (E). LTH #8 UCLA (-13) trailed 24-14 into the 4Q and missed the GW 50 yd fg on the final play to lose 30-28. LW UCLA lost at WSU 27-21 (+7'). The Bruins held WSU to a ssn low 356 yds (175 yds below their avg) and no pass td's (1st time in 41 gms) but once again UCLA had no running gm (43 rush yds, 1.7) which they desperately needed on a rainy night and ply'g w/o QB Rosen (inj, CS). The Bruins avg just 91 (2.8) rush ypg which offsets a solid D that is ranked #15 in the FBS, holding foes to 96 ypg below their avg. Utah pulled out a 19-14 (-7) win at Ore St in a gm that was marred by heavy rain and wind. Utah had a 19-7 lead late 4Q but Ore St got a gbg td w/1:40 left. The Utes compl'd just 4 passes due to weather but RB Williams who un-retired LW, stepped in for a beat up unit and went 34-179-1. Utah is 6-2 ATS as an AD while UCLA is just 4-9 as a HF. Both tms are ply'g an 8th str wk but UCLA does have a bye on deck while Utah has a home gm vs Wash.

**LSU by 8 over Mississippi** - Five of the L/7 have been decided by 7 pts or less. LY Ole Miss was #25 and a 7 pt fav over #17 LSU and whipped them 38-17. The HT is 6-1 SU winning 4 str but only 3-4 ATS. Ole Miss is on their 2nd str AG and LSU has a bye on deck. LSU is 2-0 SU/ATS under Interim HC Orgeron after LW's 45-10 (-24') home win vs SM. The gm was actually tied at HT but LSU got 4 3Q td's and never looked back. RB Guice, filling in for inj'd RB Fournette (CS), rushed for 162 (10.1) and 2 td's. Since the cch'g chance, LSU's OFF has been much more explosive, as all 5 2H td's LW were 20+ yds and their top 2 OFF perfs have come under Orgeron. Ole Miss is coming off a 34-30 (-7) loss at Ark. They were out FD'd 27-20 for the gm but led 30-27 late before all'g the GW td. Ole Miss D has all'd 22 ypg more than their foes avg (#89 in FBS) but their OFF avg 154 ypg more than their foes allow on the ssn (#5 in FBS). LSU is 10-4-1 as a HF vs FBS foes but Ole Miss is 12-6 as a dog and 6-2 as an AD.

**Ohio St by 21 over PENN ST** - OSU is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS in the series. LY OSU only led 21-10 after 3Q, but scored 17 pts to pull away 38-10 (-19). LTH ('14) PSt was off a bye, trailed 17-0 at the half but came back before falling in 2OT 31-24 (+14). PSt is off a bye & a 38-14 (E) win vs MD the wk prior, finishing w/ssn highs in FD's (28), ttl (524) & rush (372) yds while all'g a ssn low 270. They're all'g 209 (4.8) rush ypg. OSU is coming off an emotional 30-23 (-10') OT win at Wisky. They trailed 16-6 at HT and 23-20 in the 4Q and they all'd a ssn high 236 (5.1) rush yds as they were out'd for the 1st time this ssn but their OFF put up the most yds that UW has all'd all ssn (411). OSU's D is #3 in the nation, holding foes to 160 ypg less than their avg and they are #2 in our Pass Eff D rankings, holding foes to 48% compl. PSt is 11-5 ATS home vs the B10 while OSU is 4-10 as a DD road fav vs B10 foes. The Nittany Lions are home for the 5th time in 6 wks incl 4 str w/a trip to PU on deck while OSU is a young tm ply'g their 2nd of B2B road gms but have already won in Norman and Camp Randall.

**ALABAMA by 17 over Texas A&M** - The HT is just 1-4 SU. In the F/2 mtgs between Sumlin's OFF & Saban's D, A&M avg 523 ypg incl an upset win here in '12. The next time the Tide got the Aggies at home they beat them 59-0 & in the L/2 mtgs have all'd 244 ypg winning by 43 ppg. A&M enters off a bye & a 45-38 (-7) 2OT win vs Tenn, finishing w/an FBS ssn high 592 yds, while also all'g ssn highs in ttl (684) rush (282) & pass (402) yds. They're all OFF & no D with the #10 OFF in the FBS avg 144 ypg more than their opp's avg & the #118 D all'g 90 ypg more than their opp's avg. Bama enters off a 49-10 (-13') win at a beat up Tennessee team. The Tide held the Vols to a ssn low 163 yds and added IR & PR td's. Bama is +230 ypg on the ssn and their D is #4, holding foes to 161 ypg less than their avg. A&M is 3-9 ATS away vs the SEC and 0-7-1 ATS off a bye. Bama is 2-6 ATS at home. This is the Aggies 4th gm on the road in their L/5, but they have lowly NMSt at home on deck. Bama has a bye on deck.

**Colorado St by 3 over UNLV** - CSU has owned this series, going 9-2 SU/7-4 ATS, but the HT is 6-0 SU/ATS. LY CSU was -7' at home and got a td with 1:45 left to make it 49-28 then UNLV got a garbage td with 1:00 left. LTH was back in '11 and UNLV won 38-35 (+2'). CSU is coming off a near upset of Boise St, losing 28-23 (+28). Ply'g w/o st'g QB Hill (OFY), the Rams trailed 28-3 in the 4Q but rec'd 2 onside kicks in the L/6 mins and 200 of their yds came on their L/4 drives. For the gm, CSU was out'd 444-373. LW we scored an outright Big Dog winner on UNLV (Big Dogs went 5-4 w/3 outright upsets!) as they upset Haw, 41-38 (+8'). There were 6 lead changes in the gm and UNLV got the GW fg w/49 left. The Rebels held 535-446 & 29-20 FD edges and QB Snead went 19-27-279-2. They avg 248 (5.6) rush ypg on the ssn and have held foes to just 51% compl. CSU is on a 30-19 ATS run, while UNLV is on a 13-19 ATS run.

**UTAH ST by 14 over Fresno St** - FSt was 6-0 SU/3-0 ATS, but LY UTSt dominated w/a 482-194 yd edge & won 56-14 (-11). FSt is 5-0 SU when seeking revenge vs UTSt with their avg win by 24 ppg, but haven't travelled here s/10. UTSt is off a bye & a 31-24 (-6) loss at CSU the wk prior, finishing w/FBS ssn highs in ttl (461) & rush (251) yds, but all'g ssn highs in ttl (464) & rush (224) yds. FSt enters off a 17-3 (+17) home loss to SDSt. They were out'd 364-217 and outFD'd 25-10 as SDSt had a 37-19-22-41 TOP edge. FSt is -142 ypg on the road and has all'd 276 (5.2) rush ypg on the ssn. FSt is 2-8 as an AD and have lost those by an avg of 42-19. UTSt is 14-7 as a HF. This is the Aggies 1st HG in 4 wks & they host SDSt w/a short wk on deck while this is FSt's 3rd road gm in 4 wks.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Minnesota over PHILADELPHIA** - The Vikings and Eagles have been 2 of the more surprising teams in the NFL so far this ssn with a combined 9-2 SU/ATS mark. Unfortunately those losses have come in the past 2 weeks for the Eagles as they were unable to get their offensive unit going last week in D.C. where they were held to just 12 FD's and 239 total yds. While MIN needed a bye week in order to get some of their key contributors healthy, the hope for the Viking faithful is that they didn't lose any momentum following their undefeated start that's seen them outscore their opponents by a 24-13 margin while allowing just 288 ypg on the defensive side of the ball. Although the Eagles defense has been just as impressive at home (only HG in a 5-wk span) allowing just 7 ppg & 270 ypg, their 2-9 ATS mark as a HD is quite alarming against a MIN squad (QB Bradford returning to PHI, 248 ypg, 70%, 6-0 ratio) that's put up some amazing spread records (10-1 ATS as a fav, 19-4 ATS vs NDIV foes).

**FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 10**

**3★ Buffalo over MIAMI** - After not having much go in their favor to start the '16 ssn, the Dolphins were able to deliver one of the more surprising victories a wk ago vs the Steelers as a 7 pt dog where they all'd just 15 pts and 297 tl yds to the high-octane PIT offense. MIA now plays host to a red-hot Bills squad that's rattled off 4 consec wins after their 29 pt win over the 49ers last wk in BUF behind a 140 yd, 3 TD outing from RB McCoy. Recent series history has fallen in favor of the Bills as they've gone 5-1 SU/ATS over the past 3 yrs including a 41-14 thumping of the Dolphins in MIA LY (+2). While this will be a rare situation for BUF as they enter play as a DIV AF for the 1st time in 8 ssn, their 14-6 ATS record inside of the AFC East gives us enough confidence to lean in their direction against a MIA tm that's dropped 9 of their L/10 ATS in DIV play.

## OTHER SELECTION

**2★ ATLANTA over San Diego** - After finding interesting and unusual ways to drop games heading into last Thur's matchup vs DEN (4 blown leads in 4Q), the Chargers were finally able to hold on against the Broncos (ended their 10-game AFC West losing skid) despite some more late gm drama (DEN recover outside down by 8 w/:27 left). They now head to ATL to take on a Falcons teams that's off a narrow 2 pt defeat in SEA (trailed 17-3 at HT, ATL 362-331 yd edge). While both teams come in with very impressive spread runs (combined 15-4) and have big contests on deck (SD rematch in DEN, ATL hosts GB), an East Coast trip following LW's emotional win may be too much for the Chargers to overcome.

## OTHER PLAYS

**Chicago at GREEN BAY - Thursday** - Despite a 389-317 yd edge and another 300 yd day from QB Hoyer (4th straight), the Bears continue to find ways to lose late as the Jaguars connected on the GW 51 yd TD pass with 2:49 remaining (CHI 2-9 ATS run). They now head on the road to take on rival GB who allowed 191 rush yds in the 14 pt home loss to DAL (GB had all'd just 171 rush yds thru 4 gms coming in). While the Packers have won and covered 8 of their past 10 matchups against the Bears and are 10-5 ATS as a DIV HF, it is worth mentioning that this very same CHI team went into Lambeau on Thanksgiving Night a ssn ago (GB retired Favre's jersey at HT) and came away with the outright upset as an 8 pt dog. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk.**

**† NY Giants by 3 over Los Angeles - London - 9:30am EST** - Following their 4 pt win against the Ravens a week ago where QB Manning (403 pass yds) and WR Beckham (222 rec yds, 2 TD) finally found their groove, the Giants now head back across the pond for the first time in nearly a decade as their 13-10 win over the Dolphins in '07 was the very first of the International Series. While the Rams have been in London more recently with a 2012 trip, their matchup didn't appear to be very pleasant as they suffered a massive beatdown at the hands of the Patriots (45-7, +7). The Rams are off of their 2nd consec defeat following their 3 pt loss in DET although it is worth mentioning that their 387 yds of tll offense (QB Keenum 321 yds, 3-1 ratio) was their highest mark on the year. With the Giants off of their 1st ATS victory of the ssn and needing a win to stay within reach of the rest of the NFC East prior to their bye, we'll give them the 3 pt edge in this one.

**KANSAS CITY by 7 over New Orleans** - Following their 16 pt win in OAK where they finished with a 406-287 yd edge, the Chiefs return home to take on a Saints squad that earned a last second shootout win LW in the Superdome against a now 1-5 Panthers squad (3★ LP Winner on the Over). While the Chiefs are on just a 14-27-1 ATS run as a HF and the Saints moved their mark as a dog to 10-3-1 ATS, trips to Arrowhead have always been tough, especially for a New Orleans offense that is much weaker when away from the Big Easy (36 ppg & 501 ypg at home, just 24 ppg & 282 ypg on the road).

**Washington by 3 over DETROIT** - After an 0-2 start to the ssn against a pair of solid squads (PIT & DAL), the Redskins have now rattled off 4 consec victories following their home victory over the Eagles LW (WAS 493 tl yds against a PHI def all'g just 267 ypg coming in). They now head to Ford Field to take on a Lions team that's in the final leg of a 3-gm homestand that's seen them deliver consec wins against the Eagles and LW against the Rams (GW 34 yd FG w/1:29 left). While both teams have tough road trips on deck (WAS in London vs CIN & DET at HOU), we'll sit behind the visiting dog in this one as they have the clear talent edge over the banged up Lions.

**CINCINNATI by 13 over Cleveland** - With a 3-12 ATS run heading into Nashville a week ago, the Browns found a way to get the backdoor cover against the Titans thanks to a pair of late TD's in the final minutes of the gm (137 yds & 2 TD's on final 2 drives). They now head back on the road for the 2nd straight wk to take on Hue Jackson's former Bengals squad (OC there L2Y) that's been forced to go through quite the gauntlet so far this ssn with losses against the likes of PIT, DEN, DAL and LW in Foxboro against the Patriots (outgained 437-357 in 18 pt loss). Following a midssn home loss to the Browns in '14, the Bengals have now demolished CLE by a 98-13 combined score (21 pt avg cover). With the Browns' continued inj's and their overall struggles inside of the AFC North (1-6 ATS run), there's no question which way we'll be leaning in this one as CIN has posted a solid 14-7 ATS mark as a HF.

**Oakland by 2 over JACKSONVILLE** - The visitor in Raider games moved to a perfect 6-0 ATS LW as the potent OAK offense was held to just 10 pts and 287 yds in the 16 pt defeat (28 ppg, 392 ypg coming in). They now head back on the road to take on a JAX team that escaped with a 1 pt victory LW in CHI despite a 389-317 yd deficit and being forced into 2 TO's. With the Raiders having success on the road so far this ssn (3-0 SU/ATS in 10am PST kickoffs), we feel pretty confident in leaning towards their side against a Jags squad that just can't find their footing on a consistent basis (8-18 ATS as a NDIV HD).

**TENNESSEE by 7 over Indianapolis** - Following their 2nd consec win a week ago against the Browns where they forced 6 sks and finished with a 407-341 yd edge, the Titans now welcome a Colts team that they've clearly struggled against with an 0-8 SU mark (2-5-1 ATS) over the past 4 ssn (outscored by 9 ppg). After narrowly getting back into the win column the week prior at home against the Bears, IND blew a late 14 pt lead LW in HOU before eventually dropping the matchup in OT (RB Gore 1st Colt w/100 yds rushing in a gm s/12). While recent history clearly gives TEN the disadvantage, the blatant holes on the Colts roster (substantial inj's on both sides) and some fortunate early ssn wins (comebacks vs SD & CHI) has us calling for the Titans to deliver the victory.

**NY JETS by 3 over Baltimore** - The Ravens are back at MetLife Stadium for a 2nd consec time following LW's matchup against the Giants where they were dominated in the air for 403 yds & 3 TD's by Eli Manning. They now face off with a Jets squad returning home on a short wk after their MNF tilt with the Cardinals in the desert. With this being the only HG in a 5-wk span for the Jets and them having winnable road trips to CLE & MIA on deck, a victory here against a BAL team that just can't cover (3-13-1 ATS vs NDIV foes) will be key for them to get back into the mix in the AFC playoff picture.

**Tampa Bay by 4 over SAN FRANCISCO** - The Bucs head to the Bay Area with quite a bit of confidence following their bye wk as they went into CAR the previous Mon and delivered the outright upset. The 49ers meanwhile haven't tasted victory since the opening week of the ssn as LW's 29 pt defeat in BUF (QB Kaepernick 253 tl yds, 1 TD in 1st start of ssn) has now seen them outscored by a 37-20 avg margin the past 5 contests (incl 7 & 11 pt home losses). With SF clearly headed in the wrong direction once again in '16 (2-8 ATS run) and TB already coming out victorious in 2 of their 3 road matchups, we'll give them the edge in this one as they look to chase the front-running Falcons atop the NFC South.

**New England by 7 over PITTSBURGH** - Significant showdown between a pair of the AFC's elite who are looking to get the early tiebreaker advantage inside of the conference. The Patriots are firing on all cylinders following their 18 pt home win over CIN behind a 2nd straight 375+ passing outing from QB Brady (best 2-gm QBR to start a ssn, NE 437-357 yd edge). The Steelers meanwhile struggled on the road for the 2nd consec time (outscored by a 64-18 margin vs PHI & MIA) in a game that QB Roethlisberger was in and out of the lineup w/a knee inj (189 yds, 1-2 ratio) after throwing for a combined 9 TD's the 2 wks prior (minor knee surgery on Mon, expected to miss 2-3 wks). With the Patriots coming into Heinz Field having covered 5 of their L/6 and Landry Jones (1-1 career record as str) expected to line up under center for Big Ben, we'll give NE the TD edge in this matchup and wait to see where the final line ends up.

**Seattle at ARIZONA - SNF** - In a game that saw the Falcons storm back from a 17-3 HT deficit to take the lead heading into the 4Q in SEA, the Seahawks went on to get the 2 pt victory following a 44 yd FG w/1:57 remaining (SEA 362-331 yd deficit). They now head to the desert to take on a Cardinals team off of short rest following their MNF matchup against the Jets. While a victory here by ARZ could get them right back into the NFC playoff picture, it's worth mentioning that the Seahawks have had some recent success in trips to Glendale with 3 straight convincing victories including the past 2 when they combined to allow just 1 total TD (outscored ARZ 105-34 L3Y). **Call your VIP Debit Card for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

**Houston at DENVER - MNF** - The Texans head to DEN in what will be billed as the homecoming for QB Osweiler (234 ypg, 59%, 8-8 ratio in 6 gms w/HOU) after he spent the first 4 yrs of his career with the Broncos (5-2 record as a str LY). HOU has to feel extremely fortunate to have escaped with a win LW as they became the 1st tm to overcome a 14 pt deficit in the final 3 min since the Broncos ironically did it back in '11. DEN meanwhile is off a surprising road defeat in SD (snapped NFL record 15-game DIV road streak) where they trailed by a 21-3 margin in the 4Q and were without the services of HC Kubiak (CS here, fired as Texans coach in '13 after 8 ssn w/team). While DEN will attempt to get back on track with a 12-6 ATS mark as a NDIV HF on their resumé, keep in mind that HOU continues to chug along with their own solid spread streak (10-4-1 ATS).
