## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ LOUISIANA over Georgia Southern** - It's Sr day in Lafayette. GS enters off their emotional SR day 52-0 upset (+5) victory over SA which was their first win of the season. These schools met for the first time last year and the Eagles' option OFF was held to a ssn low 52 (1.9) rush yd. GS is just 1-3-1 as an AD TY. LA pulled their own upset last week and is 1 win away from bowl eligibility with a road trip to SBC co-leader App St on deck, so look for an all out effort here. Against 3 common foes LA is 2-1 SU and ATS, while GS is 1-2 SU & ATS. The Cajuns have used a powerful ground attack over their L/3 games and the Eagles have allowed 5 foes to rush for over 240 yards this season. GS's blowout win has given LA some good line value as they have opened as less than a td favorite, so get them early and often.

**FORECAST: LOUISIANA by 13**

**3★ Northern Illinois over C MICHIGAN** - It's Sr day in Mt. Pleasant. CM is on a 7-3 SU/ATS run in this series, the home team is 12-8 SU/13-7 ATS and the outright winner is 13-0 ATS. NIU still has a shot at reaching the MAC title game. The Huskies are +33 ypg away and +68 ypg in MACtion, while CM is -23 ypg at home and +3 ypg in conf play. Against 5 common foes NIU is +41 ypg and CM is +20 ypg. While the OFF's are even, the Huskies have clear edges on D and ST's. CM is just 4-11 as a HD and on an 8-12 overall ATS run, while NIU is 17-6 as an AF and on an 11-5-1 overall ATS run. NIU should have no trouble controlling this game with a consistent ground attack and we'll call for the Huskies to win by nearly double-digits.

**FORECAST: NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 9**

**3★ Indiana (+) over PURDUE** - This rivalry dates back to 1891 and they've played their season finale against each other every year s/'20 except '42 & 2001. The Old Oaken Bucket has been at stake s/'25. Purdue has never lost 5 straight in this rivalry in 119 meetings and is on a 6-3 ATS series run. The stakes are extremely high as the winner becomes bowl eligible! These schools are extremely even as both are about the same on OFF and D, and while Indy does have a slight ST's advantage, it's Sr day in West Lafayette. The Hoosiers put up a season high yards last week, but this figures to be a low scoring affair. The Boilermakers are allowing 74 (2.1) rush ypg over their L/4 games. The Hoosiers played the tough portion of their B10 sked early and have come alive in their L/2 games and we'll gladly take the points, but wouldn't be surprised at an outright upset.

**FORECAST: INDIANA by 7**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Usf (+) over UCF** - It's Sr day in Orlando. USF is 6-2 ATS in this series. Huge stakes are on the line as not only will the winner play for an AAC title next week, but will also be alive for a NY6 bowl bid. The undefeated Knights were in a look ahead spot last week at Temple and were held to a ssn low 384 yards, but benefited from +5 TO's, while USF had all they could handle with Tulsa. USF QB Flowers also leads the team in rushing and UCF has allowed 210 (4.9) rush ypg vs their L/5 FBS foes. The Bulls haven't been an AD s/'15, while the Knights are 5-2 as a HF UCF hasn't been as dominant as they were early in the season and we don't see them winning this game by more than a td. We'll gladly take double digits with QB Flowers always capable of putting up points for the Bulls.

**FORECAST: UCF by 6**

**2★ MIDDLE TENNESSEE over Old Dominion** - It's Sr day in Murfreesboro and MT has won their L/5 (3-1-1 ATS) home finales by 18 ppg. Both teams need a win to become bowl eligible. Since returning from inj, QB Stockstill has a 7-1 ratio. After winning their F/2 games, ODU dropped 6 straight but has now won 3 straight after getting the GW td vs Rice w/37 left last week. Against 5 common foes (FAU, FIU, Marsh, Char & WKU) MT is -3 ppg and +7 ypg while ODU is -11 ppg and -72 ypg. The Blue Raiders have the edge on OFF as well as a huge edge on D, holding foes to 14 ypg below their season avg (#55 in FBS) while ODU allows 36 ypg more than their foes avg (#102 in FBS). MT has the more experienced QB and is 3-0 as a HF TY while ODU is 3-8 as an AD.

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY NOVEMBER 23RD:

**Mississippi at MISS ST** - It's the Egg Bowl and Sr day in Starkville. With Ole Miss on a bowl ban, this will be their season finale. The visitor is 4-13 SU/5-11-1 ATS in this series, but has won the L/2. The Rebels allow 241 (5.4) rush ypg which could spell disaster since QB Fitzgerald had a career high 258 rush yds in this rivalry last year. MSU is off a solid defensive performance, holding Ark to a ssn low 221 yds. Ole Miss' OFF hasn't lost a step with QB Ta'amu filling in for inj'd Patterson. They've averaged 518 ypg and 37 ppg since Ta'amu took over. Against 5 common foes (LSU, Auburn, A&M, Bama & Ark) MSU is +2 ppg and +26 ypg while Ole Miss is -22 ppg and -125 ypg. The Rebels are just 1-9 SU/2-10 ATS against SEC West foes while the Bulldogs are 24-15 ATS vs SEC foes.

### FRIDAY NOVEMBER 24TH:

**TCU by 17 over Baylor** - TCU is 5-0 ATS in this series since joining the B12 in '12. The Horned Frogs had little trouble dispatching TT without QB Hill or RB Anderson as they finished with 204 (4.9) rush yards. Baylor allowed Iowa ST to rush for 214 (5.4) despite the 'Clones being down to their third string QB. Hill should be back this week and a win here will put TCU in the B12 title game. While Bears true frosh QB Brewer has shown that he belongs, he hasn't seen a D anything close to what TCU's #4 unit that holds foes to 127 ypg below their average brings and hasn't allowed a single point in the 2nd half of their last 5 games! Not only is Baylor not eligible for a bowl, but they're also away from home for the third time in 4 weeks. All that being said, Baylor has played better down the stretch and we believe they'll stay within 3 td's.

**TOLEDO by 12 over W Michigan** - It's Sr day in Toledo and a win for the Rockets propels them into the MAC title game. WM has won the L/2 meetings after losing the previous 5. The home tm is 4-6 SU/3-7 ATS and there's been 6 upsets in the L/11 matchups. Toledo is +198 ypg at home and +138 ypg in MACtion, while WM is -98 ypg away and +54 ypg in conf play. Against 5 common foes Toledo is +21 ppg and +186 ypg, while WM is +9 ppg and +62 ypg. The D's are even and both feature excellent ST's, however the Rockets have a large edge on OFF. WM is 14-5 as an AD, while Toledo is 2-4 as a HF and 0-5-1 ATS in season finales. Surprisingly, Toledo hasn't made it to the MAC title game s/'04 and we'll call for that streak to end and side with the Rockets by nearly 2 td's.

**Ohio by 7 over BUFFALO** - It's Sr day in Buffalo and the home team is 9-2 SU including 7 straight wins (6-1 ATS). The L/4 meetings have been determined by an average of 25 ppg! OU must win to have a chance at the MAC title game, while UB must win to gain bowl eligibility. Though the Bobcats are +77 ypg in MACtion, they're -49 ypg away, while UB is +18 ypg in conf play and +95 ypg at home. Against 4 common foes OU is +19 ppg and +69 ypg, while UB is +3 ppg and +33 ypg. The Bobcats are on the second of B2B road games but they've had 10 days in between and are 9-2 ATS in true road games. The Bulls counter with an 8-4 run as a HD. We'll go against recent series history and call for a close game with OU winning by a td.

**Missouri by 1 over ARKANSAS** - It's Sr day in Fayetteville. MO is 3-1 SU/ATS in this series. We have cashed 3★ plays on these pages with Mizzou in each of the last 2 weeks (avg cover by 21 ppg!). After losing 5 straight, the Tigers have now won 5 straight over non-bowl eligible teams to become bowl eligible themselves and QB Lock threw 3 more td passes (33-4 ratio his L/7). HC Bielema dropped his SEC record to 11-28 after LSU's loss to MSU. The Razorbacks are -139 ypg in SEC play. Their D is #83 in the FBS, allowing 20 ypg more than their foes avg and they have our #96 ranked pass eff D. Despite all the reasons to go against Arkansas this week, this is more than likely HC Bielema's last game and we expect maximum effort from the revenge minded Hog who are 15-9-1 as dogs.

**SAN DIEGO ST by 23 over New Mexico** - SDSU HC Rocky Long was the HC at NM from '98-'08 and his current Aztec squad has won the L/5 in the series by 11 ppg. While the Aztecs earned a 19 pt win against Nevada a week ago behind a school-record 429 all-purp yds from RB Penny, they missed out on a berth to the MW title game with Fresno St knocking off Wyoming. The Lobos meanwhile blew a 5 pt lead in the final minute last Friday against UNLV (GW TD w/25 left). With the Aztecs on an 11-3 run (9-5 ATS) in Qualcomm Stadium regular ssn finales and Long's vast success defending the option, we'll go ahead and give them the edge here against a Lobos squad that comes in with 4 consecutive ATS losses.

**HOUSTON by 1 over Navy** - UH will be playing with revenge after losing to Navy last year as the #6 ranked team in the country. The Cougars have the added advantage of defending the option for a second straight week, and while they held Tulane to just 166 (3.5) rush, they were upset. Navy turned to QB Lewis as the starter vs Notre Dame, but that was short lived as an ankle inj forced Abey back under center. The Middies found a spark 2 weeks ago by using Perry at QB, but an ankle inj forced him to miss last week. UH is 6-11-1 as a HF, while Navy is 28-11 as an AD. With Navy travelling for the third time in 4 weeks including the second of B2B away games and questions at QB, we'll set this game at the opening line.

**Miami, FI by 17 over PITTSBURGH** - It's Sr day in Pittsburgh but with dwindling attendance expect there to be more Miami fans in the stands. The Panthers have been dominated in this series (2-18 SU/4-9 ATS). While one could assume that Miami would get caught looking ahead to their first ever ACC title game, their struggles against UVA as 19' pt chalk last week make that less likely. UM trailed by 2 td's 3Q before rallying to win by a misleading 44-28 final. The Panthers nearly pulled an upset LW, but were stopped 4 times from the VT1 to lose by 6. HC Narduzzi turned to frosh QB Pickett, whom he said was a better passer than DiNucci. If Pickett makes his first career start this week, he will see our #9 pass eff D on the opposite side. UM's D is #28, holding foes to 50 ypg less than their avg. Pitt is just 5-14 ATS at home while Miami is 10-5 ATS on the road and the cold weather hasn't affected the 'Canes in the past (4-0 ATS at Pitt in Nov).

**Iowa by 6 over NEBRASKA** - The Heroes Trophy has been on the line since NU joined the B10 in '11. Iowa is on a 4-1 ATS series run. It's not only Sr day in Lincoln, but also their last game of the season as they're staying home for the holidays for the first time s/'07. The Blackshirts are allowing 289 (6.7) rush ypg over their L/6 games so look for Iowa to find success on the ground with RB's Wadley & Butler. The Hawkeys are 12-2-1 as an AF and the NU staff will be cch'g their final game, but let's be honest, neither team can really be trusted with the way each is playing entering this contest.

**TROY by 21 over Texas St** - It's Sr day in Troy and the Trojans enter fresh off a bye and are tied for the lead for the SBC Crown. TXSt is on the second of B2B away games and are finishing out a disappointing season. Troy is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series as SBC foes, winning/covering by an avg of 24/6 ppg. The Trojans are 11-25 as a HF including 0-5 TY. The 'Cats are 4-9 ATS as a DD AD. TXSt has covered 3 of their last 4, including a 27-7 upset of CC as a 9 pt AD. Troy's last game was a 42-17 win at CC as a 17 pt AF. Against their other 2 common foes, Troy went 2-0 outscoring them by 14 ppg and TXSt went 0-2 being outscored by 6 ppg. Troy has the OFF (#98-#122) and D edges (#58-#117). While they should take care of business, they may take their foot off the gas in the 2H with a showdown with co-leader Arkansas St on deck.

**Wku by 6 over FIU** - It's Sr day in Miami. WKU has won 4 straight in this series, and would have 5 straight covers if it weren't for FIU's backdoor cover LY. The 'Toppers became bowl eligible after beating MT in a misleading 41-38 (+1) 3OT win last week. The game was a defensive battle into the 4Q with WKU only leading 10-3. Against 5 common foes (Char, ODU, FAU, Marsh & MT) WKU is +3 ppg and +87 ypg while FIU is -8 ppg and -95 ypg. Both teams have strong pass attacks under veteran QB's, but WKU has a huge edge, coming in at #48 in our pass eff D while FIU is #114. WKU gets an extra days rest but is playing their 3rd road game in 4 weeks, but we don't mind going against a Panthers' squad who saw their CUSA title hopes dashed last week by their rival.

**TEXAS by 9 over Texas Tech** - It's Sr Day in Austin and while UT is on a 1-6 ATS run in home finales, they're on a 6-1 ATS run in this series. TT enters having lost 5 of 6 and must win to become bowl eligible. The 'Horns benefitted from WV QB Grier breaking his finger diving for the pylon in the 1Q and won in Morgantown to become bowl eligible for the first time s/'14. UT also got the return of AA LT Williams, which sparked a 233 (5.5) rush effort, their most since week 2. The 'Horns are 2-5 ATS at home, while the Red Raiders are 8-4 as an AD. A loss here could mean the end of the Kliff Kingsbury era in Lubbock and we'll call for TT to keep this game a tad closer than expected.

**UCLA by 14 over California** - The home team has dominated this series with a 15-2 SU (14-2-1 ATS) run including a year ago in Berkeley where the Bruins were dominated 36-10 without the services of QB Rosen. While Rosen was under center a week ago against rival USC, they moved their road record to 0-6 on the year as a late comeback attempt came up short (UCLA 501-417 yd edge). Cal also had a comeback attempt against their rival fall short in Palo Alto in the eventual 3 pt defeat. While both teams need a win here to become bowl eligible, we'll go ahead and lean with the revenge seeking Bruins in their first game since firing HC Mora (OC Jedd Fisch is Interim HC) against a Bears squad that has dropped their 4 P12 away games (1-3 ATS) by 18 ppg.

### SATURDAY NOVEMBER 25TH:

**CINCINNATI by 5 over Connecticut** - It's Sr day in Cincinnati. This game features two of the bottom feeders in the AAC as neither is eligible for a bowl. UC was on a 5-0 SU/ATS run in this series prior to last years loss when they were held to their lowest rush total s/'06 and will have revenge on their mind. UConn enters on a 4 game losing streak and is on the road for the third straight week. The 'Cats enter off their worst performance of the season, while the Huskies, despite their 23 point loss to BC, did finish with a 412-385 yard edge, though they did trail 39-3 in the 4th quarter thanks to TO's then added 2 late td's. UConn is 10-19-1 as an AD, but UC is 3-6 as a HF and 2-6-1 ATS in their home finale. We'll side with the 'Cats by over a fg.

**Boston College by 10 SYRACUSE** - It's Sr day in Syracuse. The Orange have won 3 of the 4 ACC meetings including the L/2 when hosting on Sr day. BC enters having covered 8 straight and have won 4 of their L/5. RB Dillon went for 200 yards last week and BC led 39-3 until UConn added 2 garbage time td's. After holding foes to 25 ppg and 365 ypg in their F/9 games, Cuse has allowed 64 and 56 points and 734 and 727 yards their L/2. The Orange D allowed 391 (8.4) rush in those and now faces the ACC's #2 rusher in Dillon (1,239, 5.1) who went for 200 yards last week. Cuse's OFF has also gone stagnant, with 1 td in the L/6 quarters and QB Dungey remains a ? due to inj (CS). Cuse is 4-8 ATS at home and no longer has a shot at a bowl.

**Michigan St by 13 over RUTGERS** - It's Sr day in New Brunswick. MSU is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS as B10 rivals. RU enters having lost 3 of 4 and is playing for pride, while Sparty is playing for bowl seeding. MSU rebounded from their blowout loss at OSU with a defensive minded win in bad weather. The Knights were dominated at Indy as they were held to a season low 190 yards and QB Rescigno was benched for true frosh Lewis. MSU RB Scott had his first 100 yard game in 5 weeks and should find plenty of room to go over the century mark again as RU allowed 267 (5.6) rush last week. Sparty is 13-7 as DD chalk, but the Knights are 3-1 as a HD. RU's last 3 losses were by an average of 30 ppg, but we can't trust MSU to win by more than 2 td's.

**Ohio St by 14 over MICHIGAN** - The Game. It's Sr day in Ann Arbor, but OSU has won 12 of 13 SU and is on a 12-7 ATS series run. UM's loss to UW last week was costly as QB Peters was carted off the field which leaves O'Korn as the starter once again, a role he struggled with which led to his benching to begin with. The Bucks still have an outside shot at the playoff and have taken out their anger from their shocking loss at Iowa with B2B dominant performances. While both feature outstanding HD's, the difference in OFF couldn't be more lopsided as the Bucks feature a QB in JT Barrett who holds 35 B10 and school records making his final regular season appearance. The Wolve's have been gashed on the ground the L/2 weeks, while OSU is averaging 254 (6.0) rush ypg and last years leading rusher Weber enters off his only two 100 yard outings in B2B games. UM hasn't been a HD s/'13 and are 8-17-1 as a dog overall, while OSU is 3-1 as an AF this year.

QB Jackson has struggled against ACC foes, hitting just 53% with a 7-6 ratio. He faces our #28 pass eff D, led by 3x All ACC S Blanding. HC Mendenhall has the 'Hoos believing and they're definitely capable enough to end their losing streak in this series. VT is just 5-14 as an AF and UVA gets the call as our Underdog POW!

**UTAH by 12 over Colorado** - Shocking ending for the Utes a week ago in Seattle as the Huskies scored 10 points in the final minute to get the come-from-behind victory. The Buffs meanwhile head to SLC following a late bye week and looking to make it B2B wins against Utah after getting the 5 point win last year in Boulder (-9) to earn their first P12 title game appearance. While both teams come into this matchup needing a win for bowl eligibility, we'll back the vengeful Utes in this one as they are 6-2 overall in the series while Colorado is just 1-3 SU/ATS in conference road contests this season.

**Arkansas St by 9 over ULM** - It's Sr day in Monroe and ULM enters off a trip to Auburn and will finish their season at FSU. ASt is on a 7-0 SU/ATS run in this series, winning/covering by an avg of 23/14 ppg. QB Hansen had a career high 4 td passes and a then FBS car high 303 pass yards last year. The Red Wolves are 14-8 as an AF, while the Warhawks are 3-6-1 as a HD but did upset App St 52-45 (+8.5) in their last home game. ULM has the OFF edge (#38-#83), while ASt has the D edge (#65-#127). Against 4 common foes both were 3-1 SU but while ULM was +6 ppg and +26 ypg, ASt was +23 ppg and +160 ypg. ASt was upset 24-19 by SA (-10.5) in their last road trip two weeks ago and with the SBC title still within reach will not look past ULM here.

**Wisconsin by 22 over MINNESOTA** - It's Sr day in Minneapolis. UW has won Paul Bunyan's Axe the last 13 meetings. The Badgers remain undefeated and in line for a playoff spot as they knocked out UM QB Peters in holding the Wolves to a season low 139 yards including just 58 (1.6) on the ground. MN is 1 dimensional and doesn't match up well with physical squads. UW true frosh RB Taylor leads the B10 in rushing and the Gophers are allowing 200 (5.0) rush ypg in B10 play. MN is 8-0 as a double-digit HD and is 5-2 ATS in home finales, but UW is 7-1 as an AF. We'll call for the Badgers to win by over 3 tds.

**Notre Dame by 5 over STANFORD** - The Cardinal survived a close matchup in the "Big Game" against the Bears behind another 100 yard effort from Heisman hopeful Bryce Love (378-337 yard edge). The Irish meanwhile rebounded from an ugly loss to Miami with a 7 point win against a pesky Navy squad in poor weather in South Bend (RB Adams 7th game of 100+ rush yds TY). LY was the tale of 2 halves as Notre Dame led 10-0 at halftime. The Cardinal went up 17-10 with 10:38 4Q (ND just 100 2H yds) in the eventual 7 point victory. While a loss for both teams would be a great disservice (ND playoff berth), we'll back the Irish as Stanford hasn't shown the ability to consistently stop the run.

**Clemson by 11 over SOUTH CAROLINA** - It's the Palmetto Bowl and Sr day in Columbia. Clemson has won the L/3 and is 5-0 ATS in this series. Clemson is playing this game with the ACC title game on deck for the third straight year and while they did whoop SC 56-0 (-25) LY, two years ago they only won by 5 as 20' pt chalk. Both enter fresh off wins over FCS foes. Under HC Muschamp, SC has a knack for keeping games close, having lost just one game by more than 14 pts (the loss to Clem LY) and are 4-2 as a DD dog. On the other hand, Clemson has gone just 1-3-1 as a DD fav vs FBS foes and their one cover was misleading as were -16 vs FSU, but only led by a fg mid 4Q and got a td with :35 left to win by 17. The Cocks' have covered covered 6 straight vs FBS foes and with the ACC Title game on deck, we expect Clemson to be looking ahead.

**LSU by 10 over Texas A&M** - It's Sr day in Baton Rouge and the Tigers are on dreadful 4-17 ATS run in that role! LSU is on a 6-0 SU/ATS run in this series. LY RB Guice ran for a school record 285 yds and LSU never trailed. LSU took advantage of a beat up Tenn squad last week, giving us another Early Bird winner (Button #9 comp on Mondays!) A&M snapped a 2 game losing streak last week, beating Ole Miss although the yards were even and they were outFD'd 19-18. Against 6 common foes (Miss St, UF, Aub, Bama, Miss & Ark) A&M is -5 ppg and -58 ypg while LSU has scored even with those foes and is +34 ypg. The Aggies only allow 157 (4.1) rush ypg but in their L/6 they've allowed 209 (4.6) ypg. LSU averages 207 (4.9) rush ypg. The Tigers D is #15, holding foes to 89 ypg below their average. LSU has covered their L/6 and HC Sumlin typically struggles in November, going just 6-11 SU/5-13 ATS.

**Boise St by 7 over FRESNO ST** - This is the first of 2 consecutive meetings as the Broncos and Bulldogs both punched their tickets to the MW title game a week ago (facing off for 2nd time in L4Y). In their home matchup against Air Force, the Broncos used a 300 yard, 3 TD performance from QB Rypien in the 25 point win (428-296 yd edge). Fresno meanwhile took advantage of a Wyoming squad missing their star QB in the 13-7 victory (al'd just 13 FD & 308 yds). While Boise has gone 13-2 in this series s/'01, the 2 victories for the Bulldogs came on their home turf including a 41-40 win in '13. With the winner getting the all-important game next week in their home venue, we'll lean in the direction of the Broncos in this one as they've won and covered their L/4 AG's this season by a 17 point avg MOV.

**SMU by 13 over Tulane** - It's Sr day in Dallas, but the visitor in this series is on a 9-2 ATS run. Tulane kept its bowl hopes alive with an upset win over Houston last week while SMU enters having lost 3 straight against the upper tier AAC schools. While the Ponies are allowing 264 (5.7) rush ypg in conference play, they did just defend the option 2 weeks ago. The Green Wave have trouble defending the run as well and SMU has run for 206+ in 3 of their L/4 games. The Ponies are 4-1 as a HF this year and we'll call for SMU to win by just under 2 tds.

**OKLAHOMA ST by 40 over Kansas** - This is the third home game in 4 weeks for OSU and it's Sr day in Stillwater. The home team in this series is on a 5-0 ATS run. OSU nearly erased a 29 point late 3Q deficit but fell as nearly 3 td chalk at home vs KSU, while KU has lost 11 straight games with their lone win coming vs an FCS foe. The Pokes will need help to get to the B12 title game, but will have no trouble restoring their confidence vs a KU team that is #123 on OFF, being held to 77 ypg less than their foes allow. RB Hill was held to under 100 yards for just the second time in 8 games, but should bounce back here. OSU is 31-19 as a HF, while the Jayhawks are 19-35-1 as an AD and we'll side with the Pokes to win by over 4 tds.

**ARIZONA ST by 3 over Arizona** - The home team has now won 4 straight Territorial Cups and done so by 20 ppg. LY Arizona St came in needing a win for bowl eligibility and gave up big play after big play in front of an enthused Arizona home crowd (surprising since they were 2-9 coming in). Things didn't go well last week in Eugene for the Wildcats as they were outgained by a 591-326 clip in the 20 point Ducks victory. The Sun Devils trip up North to Corvallis was a positive one however as they jumped out to a 30-0 lead in the 2Q in the eventual 16 point victory (3★ LP & 2★ Newsletter Winner!). With 2nd place in the P12 South riding on the outcome of this matchup and 5 of the past 8 in this series being decided by 7 points or less, we'll go ahead and give the home squad the 3 point edge in this duel in the Desert.

**OKLAHOMA by 21 over West Virginia** - It's Sr day in Norman. OU is 5-0 SU as B12 rivals and has covered the L/3 meetings by an average of 14 ppg. The Sooners have clinched a spot in the B12 title game and are in line to make the playoff. WV lost starting QB Grier to a broken finger in the 1Q last

week, basically costing them any chance in their home loss vs Texas. Soph Chris Chugunov will be under center and making his first ever start (on the road), and will have a tough time matching score for score with arguably the nations #1 OFF that OU enters with (avg 205 ypg more than their foes allow!). QB Mayfield is the Heisman frontrunner and WV has topped a 20-11 ratio thru the air. OU is 43-25 as a HF, but we aren't comfortable laying more than 3 tds.

**OREGON by 28 over Oregon St** - The Ducks have won 8 of the past 9 in this series although it's worth mentioning that lone defeat did come last year in Corvallis as the Beavers scored the final 20 points in the 34-24 victory (+3). The Ducks earned bowl eligibility a week ago in Eugene against Arizona with QB Herbert returning to the starting lineup (RB's Freeman & Brooks-James both rushed for 100+ yds). The Beavers seem to be going through the motions meanwhile as they trailed the Sun Devils 30-0 in the 2Q in Corvallis in the eventual 16 point defeat. With OSU playing their third road game in a 4-wk span (0-5 SU/0-4-1 ATS away TY, 23 pt avg loss), we'll call for Oregon to make it 9 of 10 in this one with the offense getting close to full strength.

**NEW MEXICO ST by 10 over Idaho** - The home team is on a 4-0 SU/ATS run, winning/covering by an avg of 11/13 ppg. ID enters off an emotional Sr day, their last as an FBS program (FCS Big Sky in '18). ID is an amazing 13-0 ATS as a conference AD. Both teams were not only upset last week, but also suffered QB injuries and there's no line at presstime. The Aggies still have a shot to end their longest bowl drought in the FBS (1960) but must win out. While Idaho has the D edge (#95-#124) they only have our #101 pass eff D and NMSST has a bigger OFF edge (#57-#127). Both teams are 0-3 vs common foes with NMSST (1-2 ATS) -10 ppg and +29 ypg and Idaho (2-1 ATS) -4 ppg and +1 ypg. We expect NMSST to win, but with Idaho's ATS streak expect them to cover.

**Temple by 8 over TULSA** - It's Sr day in Tulsa. This is just the fourth all-time meeting including the first s/'14. Tulsa is 3-6 ATS in home finales. Temple enters off a misleading final as they lost by nearly 4 tds, but had the yard and FD edges as they were -5 in TO's vs UCF. Tulsa has been an up and down team and in their 'up week' last week only lost by a td at USF. Now is their 'down week' and the Owls are in must win mode to become bowl eligible. QB Nuttle had been reliable while filling in for injured Logan Marchi until his 4 int's last week. Nuttle remains questionable. The Golden Hurricane is 3-9 as a HD, while Temple is 22-9 ATS away and we'll call for the Owls to become bowl eligible and win by just over a td.

**LOUISIANA TECH by 2 over Utsa** - It's Sr day in Ruston and LT hosts UTSA in the finale for the second straight season. UTSA is 0-5 SU in this series, but also 4-1 ATS. They have lost all 3 trips to Ruston by 20 ppg. UTSA became bowl eligible last week despite not scoring a td vs Marshall. QB Sturm has thrown for 2,094 yds w/a 15-3 ratio. LT still needs one more win to avoid staying home for the holidays for the first time since 2013. The Bulldogs are -5 ypg at home and +2 ypg in CUSA play. UTSA is +103 ypg on the road and +52 ypg in CUSA play. QB Smith has a 13-4 ratio but faces our #25 pass eff D. UTSA is #17, holding foes to 78 ypg below their season average. While we do feel LT keeps their bowl streak alive, we will call for UTSA to stay within a fg.

**MEMPHIS by 28 over E Carolina** - It's Sr day in Memphis and these former CUSA rivals are meeting for the first time as AAC members as they haven't played s/'12. Memphis is well rested, having had just 1 away game in the L/5 weeks and have already clinched a spot in the AAC title game. EC is off their best performance of the season as they sent their Sr's away with a 28 point win over Cincy. The Tigers have a balanced OFF with QB Ferguson and RB's Henderson and Taylor that is averaging 536 ypg in AAC play, while the Pirates are #127 on D, allowing 115 ypg more than their foes average! The Tigers are 6-1 ATS in their home finale, while EC is 1-6 ATS in their road finale and Memphis can name their score.

**UAB by 15 over Utep** - It's Sr day in Birmingham. Prior to the Blazers' hiatus, they had lost 3 straight home finales and were 2-8 SU/4-6 ATS in their L/10. UAB takes a step back in competition after last week's loss at Florida, getting outgained in 409-180 and they were held to just 3 rush yards. UTEP put up a season high 424 yards in last week's loss to LT. True frosh RB Fields went for 137 (6.0). UAB has the edge on OFF, but UTEP has the edge on D and ST's and has faced a much tougher schedule. We don't feel comfortable laying double-digits with the Blazers, who prefer the dog role and did lose earlier this year to Charlotte.

**Alabama by 3 over AUBURN** - It's the 82nd Iron Bowl and Sr day in Auburn! The Crimson Tide are 5-1 SU/ATS against their rival with the one loss being the famed "Kick 6" game. Bama's average MOV in their 5 wins is 24 ppg, but this should be much more competitive. The winner heads to the SEC title game. Auburn will look to take advantage of a depleted Bama LB corps (4 LB's from pressn 2 deep OFY) with a running game that averages 244 (5.2) ypg. Bama only allows 87 (2.7), but in their L/2 SEC games allowed 151 vs LSU and 172 vs MSU. Kerryon Johnson has 1,172 (5.3). Bama is +268 ypg in SEC play, while Aub is +162 ypg. The Tide average 270 (6.0) rush ypg. Auburn only allows 118 (3.1) and in their toughest test to date, they held UGA's Chubb and Michel to a combine 48 rush yards. Aub is playing their 3rd straight home game and is 12-6 as a HD.

**Florida St by 9 over FLORIDA** - Last year we used a rare 5★ play in this rivalry on FSU (-7) and they rolled 31-13 with UF getting a late td. It's Sr day in Gainesville and the Gators have lost their L/3 when hosting the 'Noles. UF got a much needed breather last week, facing an overmatched UAB squad. The Gators finished with a 409-180 yard edge, holding the Blazers to 3 rush yards in their 29 point win. Both enter with 4-6 records, but only FSU has a shot at a bowl since they rescheduled their cancelled game vs ULM. The 'Noles have the longest active bowl streak at 35 and both coaches and players have made it clear they will do whatever it takes to keep it going. Both teams have struggled offensively but the 'Noles have the edge on D. FSU's D is #12, holding foes to 95 ypg less than their foes average. With both teams struggling so much, it's hard to side with either, but we'll give the 'Noles a slight edge.

**Byu by 4 over HAWAII** - BYU has gone 9-1 in this series but they last met back in 2012. Their home finale didn't go as planned last week with UMass getting the 6 point road upset as a 4 point dog (Cougars 9 losses for 3rd time in school history, matching 1949 & 1955). Hawaii was a no-show in Logan against the Aggies in the 38-0 loss (outgained 475-325). While the Warriors have won 5 straight regular season home finales, we'll go ahead and give BYU the 4 point edge as they attempt to avoid a 10 loss season.

**KEY SELECTIONS**  
**4★ OAKLAND over Denver** - Following a pair of home matchups that featured a blowout loss to the Patriots and a deflating home defeat to the Bengals (19-10 FD & 341-190 yd edge), the Broncos begin a 5 gm stretch that features 4 AG's in a 5 wk span. The Raiders meanwhile returned from their bye a week ago in Mexico City against the Patriots where they were held to just a 4Q TD in the 25 pt defeat. In their previous matchup back in October the Raiders lost QB Carr early in the 3Q in the 6 pt defeat. While DEN has won and covered 5 of their past 6 in the "Black Hole", their current 0-6 SU/ATS run and recent 3-8-1 ATS mark vs AFC West foes has us leaning with the home team in this one.

**FORECAST: OAKLAND by 14**  
**3★ WASHINGTON over NY Giants - Thursday** - Only HG in a 4 wk span for the Redskins who blew a 31-16 lead w/6 min remaining LW in the Superdome against the Saints. The Giants meanwhile earned their 2nd victory of 2017 LW at home against the Chiefs (held a KC offense averaging 28 ppg on the year to just 3 FG's). In their most recent matchup in LY's ssn finale, the Redskins blew a golden opportunity to join the Giants in the postssn by suffering a 19-10 upset defeat as 7 pt chalk. With revenge on the mind of the home squad in this one you would have to think that the Redskins will put the throttle down against a DIV rival that's 0-8 SU/2-6 ATS vs NFC foes with a 13 pt avg defeat. **FORECAST: WASHINGTON by 13**

**OTHER SELECTION**  
**2★ INDIANAPOLIS (+) over Tennessee** - After being a DIV AF on just 1 occasion the previous 3 ssn, the Titans are now listed as AFC South road chalk for the 3rd time in '17 with the prior 2 matchups resulting in a 37-16 win (-1) in JAX and an embarrassing 57-14 defeat (-2) in Houston. Their trip to PIT didn't go as planned last Thur as QB Mariota threw 4 int's in the 23 pt defeat. IND meanwhile returns from their wk off (10-2 ATS after bye) having covered 3 straight including a close defeat at home against previously mentioned PIT as a 10 pt dog (PIT GW FG as time expired). In their previous meeting with IND in Oct on MNF, the Titans needed a late 72 yd TD run (:47 left) to get ahead of the spread. With TEN posting just a 9-27 ATS mark inside their DIV and the Colts having covered 13 of their past 16 as a HD (3-1 ATS TY), a 1 pt lean is all that we can give the visitor this weekend. **FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 1**

**OTHER GAMES**  
**DETROIT by 3 over Minnesota - Thursday** - Following a dominating defensive performance LW against the Rams where they held the league's top scoring offense (33 ppg) to just 7 pts and 254 yds, the Vikings head to Motown for the 1st of 3 consec AG's. The Lions meanwhile are at home for the only time in a 4 wk span having won & covered their past 4 Thanksgiving home matchups (20 pt avg MOV) including against this very same Vikings squad a year ago (swept ssn series LY). They did survive by a FG LW in CHI despite FD (25-19) & yardage (397-352) deficits. With the previous mentioned holiday history for the Lions, we'll back them in this one as they look to pull within a game of MIN in the NFC North standings. **DALLAS by 1 over LA Chargers - Thursday** - The Cowboys have had mixed results in their Thanksgiving home matchups over the past 5 years having gone just 2-3 SU and 0-5 ATS! The Chargers meanwhile are playing on Turkey Day for the 1st time since the NFL merger. LA was able to hand the Bills their 3rd consec loss a week ago behind a defense that forced 6 TO's including 2 ret'd for TD's. The Cowboys on the other hand had plenty of issues LW at home against the front-running Eagles who scored the game's final 30 pts in the 28 pt victory (largest home defeat for DAL since 2004). While we expect DAL to be a small favorite by gameday, their 6-14 ATS run as a NDIV HF and the Chargers routinely keeping their road matchups within reach has us calling for a close one here.

**CINCINNATI by 14 over Cleveland** - Following a 3-gm road trip that featured a pair of losses and a surprising win in DEN a week ago despite just 10 FD's & 190 yds of offense (2-0 TO edge), the Bengals welcome a familiar foe in the Browns who they've had vast success against recently with a 6-0 SU/ATS mark and a 23 pt avg MOV (31-7 win earlier TY, 350-215 yd edge). The Browns remained the only winless team in the league LW at home against the Jaguars (just 1-25 L2Y) as they were held to just 7 pts and 184 yds while being forced into 5 TO's. With CLE on just a 6-13 ATS run as an AD and covering just 3 of their L/15 inside the AFC North, we'll call for the Bengals to get back on track this weekend.

**PHILADELPHIA by 14 over Chicago** - With 3 consec road trips on the horizon for the Eagles including B2B trips to the West Coast to take on the Seahawks and Rams, this will be an important contest to pad their lead as the NFC's potential #1 seed in the playoffs. PHI was also able to gain even further ground inside the NFC East a week ago with their SNF victory in Dallas where they scored the game's final 30 pts en route to the 37-9 victory (383-225 yd edge, forced 4 TO's). The Bears meanwhile pushed the spread as a 3 point home dog a week ago in their matchup with the Lions (397-352 yd edge). Although it's difficult to lean against the Bears with a 4-0-1 ATS run in the underdog role, the Eagles come into this weekend on a perfect 7-0 ATS run along with a solid 10-4 ATS mark as a HF.

**NEW ENGLAND by 20 over Miami** - Only HG in an amazing 6 wk span for the Patriots as they return following wins in both DEN and in Mexico City against the Raiders where they held OAK to just 8 pts in the 25 pt win (420-344 yd edge). The Dolphins meanwhile head North following a 10 pt home loss to the Bucs where QB Cutler was lost with a concussion (CS). In their recent matchups in Foxborough the Patriots have delivered 8 consec victories (6-2 ATS) with an 18 pt avg MOV. With DIV matchups in 5 of the L/6 wks of the ssn, a win here for the Patriots could give them a solid head start towards their 9th consec AFC East Title (MIA on just a 1-6 ATS run as a DIV AD).

**KANSAS CITY by 14 over Buffalo** - Following a 5-2 start to the ssn and playoff aspirations for the 1st time since 1999, the Bills could be falling out of contention after their 3rd consec loss LW against the Chargers where rookie QB Peterman threw 5 int before being benched in the 2H. The Chiefs returned from bye with a shocking road defeat against the 1-win Giants where they were held to just 3 FG's. KC has dominated the recent matchups dating back to '13 with a 3-0 SU/ATS record and a 7 pt avg MOV. With a 10-5 overall ATS run for the Chiefs and the Bills headed in a negative direction (27 pt avg loss L/3 wks), the Arrowhead crowd should have plenty to celebrate this weekend as they look to get back on track.

**ATLANTA by 14 over Tampa Bay** - After a 10 pt win LW in Miami where they were outgained by a 448-321 yd clip (5-0 TD deficit), the Bucs are back on the road once again to take on a Falcons squad returning on short rest following their MNF battle in Seattle. In their magical run a ssn ago that saw them represent the NFC in the "Big Game", the Bucs actually went into Atlanta in the opener as a 2 pt dog and came away with the outright upset. While ATL is on just a 1-5 ATS run as of presstime and having covered just 5 of their L/20 as a HF, the Bucs have covered just 3 of their past 9 and could be without QB Winston again here (CS, missed L/2 gms w/shldr inj). With 2 more home matchups on deck and currently sitting in 3rd place in the NFC South, it's now or never for the Falcons as they attempt to overcome the Super Bowl hangover.

**Carolina by 3 over NY JETS** - Both teams return to action after late ssn byes with the Panthers blowing out the Dolphins the previous Monday and the Jets failing to cover as rare road chalk in Tampa. The ATS defeat to the Bucs was surprisingly the Jets' first since Wk 2 of the ssn as they are on a 6-1-1 run overall. Although the Panthers look like a potential playoff contender in the NFC sitting at 7-3 (just 6-10 LY), we cannot lay much here as not only are they on just a 1-7-1 ATS mark as an AF, but the Jets have also covered each of their 5 as a HD in '17 including a trio of outright upsets (NYJ 10-5 ATS after a bye).

**Seattle by 4 over SAN FRANCISCO** - Following their 1st win of the ssn prior to their week off against the Giants behind a 288 yd, 3 TD performance from rookie QB Beathard (just 2nd win in L/25 gms), the 49ers host a Seahawks squad that's on just a 3-7-1 ATS run as of presstime (MNF vs ATL). In their previous meeting in the Pacific Northwest back in Wk 2, the Seahawks (-13') needed a TD pass in the

middle of the 4Q to escape with the 12-9 victory. While the 49ers are on a 0-5 ATS slide following their bye week, their 6-3 mark as a DIV HD and the Seahawks inability cover as a DIV AF (3-8-1 run) has us calling for a closer outcome than you might expect.

**LA RAMS by 3 over New Orleans** - If we told you at the start of the ssn that both the Saints and Rams would be sitting atop their respective divisions, you would probably think that we had eaten some bad gumbo during our last visit to the "Big Easy". Following a come-from-behind OT victory LW in the Superdome against the Redskins where they stormed back from a 31-16 deficit in the 4Q, the Saints have now rattled off 8 consec victories (6-2 ATS) after their 0-2 start. While the Rams saw their high-octane offense (#1 in NFL at 33 ppg) held to just a TD (1st drive of the game) to see their 4-gm win streak come to an end, they are sitting atop the NFC West with SEA a half game back as of presstime (MNF vs ATL). With both squads obviously exceeding our expectations so far in '17 as they look to keep pace with the NFC-leading Eagles, we'll give the Rams the regular 3 point home edge and let the oddsmakers decide which way we lean.

**Jacksonville by 1 over ARIZONA** - Following a 10 pt loss in HOU a week ago with 3rd string QB Gabbert (272 pass yds, 3-2 ratio), the Cardinals return home to take on Gabbert's former squad JAX (1st Rnd DC in '11) who took over 1st place in the AFC South standings after another dominant defensive outing where they all'd just 7 pts, 184 yds and forced 5 TO's & sks (JAX's 4th road win in '17 after having just 3 total the previous 3 ssn). While the Jaguars appear to be the stronger (and healthier) team entering this weekend, their dismal 2-18 ATS run against the NFC including a 10 pt loss as 2 pt home chalk earlier in the ssn to the Rams has us concerned about leaning too much in their direction (ARZ 17-10 ATS as a home dog).

**Green Bay at PITTSBURGH - SNF** - Rematch of Super Bowl XLV where the Packers won the "Big Game" for the 4th time behind a 304 yd, 3 TD performance from MVP Rodgers. This marks the 2nd of 3 consec primetime games for the Steelers as they took care of the Titans with a strong 4Q last Thur (WR Brown 144 yds, 3 TD) and have a MNF matchup in CIN on deck. The Packers meanwhile head to Heinz Field after being shutout in Lambeau for the 1st time since '06 thanks to 5 TO's. While the game has clearly lost some of its luster with the absence of Rodgers due to injury, the Steelers will see their solid 11-4 ATS mark as a NDIV HF tested with an elevated DD line. **Call the office on gameday at 11am ET for the Marquee Winner!**

**Houston at BALTIMORE - MNF** - Following a successful trip to Lambeau where they recorded their 3rd shutout of the ssn (outgained 265-219, forced 5 GB TO's), the Ravens return home to take on a Texans squad that got back into the win column for the 1st time since rookie QB Watson's injury. While HOU was able to earn the 25-13 victory (+6) in their most recent meeting back in '14, the Ravens have owned the all-time series with a 7-2 SU (5-4 ATS) mark. This is a tough matchup to forecast with a line of more than a TD in favor of the home squad as BAL is just 5-13-1 ATS vs NDIV foes and the Texans are just 4-9 ATS as a NDIV AD. **Check back on Monday after noon ET to see which way we decide to lean!**
