## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Georgia Tech over UCF** - These schools haven't met s/2000. GT enters fresh off an FCS win following their emotional loss vs Tennessee and has their ACC opener on deck, while UCF is fresh off a non scheduled bye due to Hurricane Irma. While UCF is 44-20 SU at Bright House, they're just 1-11 vs P5 foes. The Yellow Jackets ran for an incredible 535 (6.2) yds against Tennessee 2 wks ago and UCF all'd 280 (4.4) rush LY against a Tulane team that was running the option for the 1st time with a new HC. The Knights are just 6-15-1 as a HD, while GT is 10-7-2 as an AF. **FORECAST: GEORGIA TECH by 10**

**3★ UCLA over MEMPHIS** - The last/only mtg was in '14, a 42-35 (-23) UCLA win at the Rose Bowl. UM has hosted & beaten a P5 schl each of the L2Y incl #13 Ole Miss in '15. The Tigers are off an unscheduled bye due to Hurricane Irma and have an FCS foe on deck. UCLA comes in off a 56-23 (-24) home win over Hawaii. The Bruins were outg'd by 10 yds, although UH got more than half of their yds after being down 49-7 3Q. We know UCLA has a trip to Stanford on deck, but the Bruins have a GUB edge, while UM is on just a 3-8 overall ATS run. Memphis all'd ULM to throw for 279 (57%) in heavy winds 2 wks ago and now face one of the nations best QB's in Rosen. **FORECAST: UCLA by 10**

**3★ Clemson over LOUISVILLE** - ESPN Gameday will be on hand again for this game. Clemson has won all 3 ACC mtgs incl LY's 42-36 (+2) barn burner. The Tigers are 3-1 SU in road openers. They head to L'ville following a defensive battle w/Auburn in which we easily delivered our Top Weekly Totals Play with a 3.5★ UNDER 57 (covered by 37 pts!). The Cardinals also gave us a nice 3★ LPS winner LW against NC behind 525 ttl yds & 6 TD from reigning Heisman winner QB Jackson. Clemson has our #1 rated DL and had 11 sks LW vs a veteran Aub OL. UL just 3-7 ATS as an ACC dog, while Clemson is 21-14-1 ATS as an ACC fav and on a 5-1 overall ATS run. Clemson will continue to prove they are the team to beat in the ACC. We've used Clemson as a September 5★ before, cashing a winner in 2009! Could we use the Tigers again this year? **FORECAST: CLEMSON by 7**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Stanford over SAN DIEGO ST** - SDSSt has struggled in reg ssn non conf play, going just 2-10 ATS and are facing their 2nd straight P12 foe after beating AZSt 30-20 (+3) which ended a 28 gm road losing streak vs P12 foes. RB Rashaad Penny had 353 all-purp yds incl a 99 yd KR. SU was dominated in the trenches LW by USC, outg'd 307-170 on the ground. Last weeks results give us tremendous value here this week. Stanford is 6-0 as a fav away from home and SDSSt HC Long typically doesn't fare well against non-conf foes, instead focusing on the more important conference games and is 0-5 ATS the week before the MW opener. The Cardinal need to get their confidence back before heading back into P12 play next week and will do so here. **FORECAST: STANFORD by 17**

**2★ MARSHALL over Kent St** - Marshall has won the L/11 SU between these former MAC rivals. KSt rebounded from their thrashing of defending Nat'l champ Clemson, but had all they could handle with FCS Howard LW. The Golden Knights trailed in the 4Q, were outg'd 457-399 & QB Holley hit just 8-16-105-2-0. MU led by 10 late 1H at NCSSt before all'g 27 unanswered. They were only outg'd 485-451 and WR Brady had the most rec yds in Carter-Finley Stadium history with 11-248-1. The Golden Flashes are just 13-25-1 vs non-conf foes and on just a 5-9 overall ATS run vs FBS foes, while MU is 11-7-1 as a HF. The Herd already owns a home win over a solid MAC foe in Miami this season. This is their lone home game in a 4 wk stretch and with a bye on deck should have no problem against a much less talented foe here. We've never used Marshall as our Sept 5★. Could this be the year we do? **FORECAST: MARSHALL by 20**

## WK 3 THURSDAY SEPT 14

**New Mexico at BOISE ST** - BSt has owned this series, going 7-1 SU but NM is 5-1 ATS. The Broncos got revenge LY for their only series loss in a 49-21 (-18) road win. BSt is off an emotional 3OT loss at Wazzu LW after leading 31-10 4Q. QB Rypien was inj (CS) & in street clothes on the sideline in the 2H as Cozart has ply'd in each game. NM was down 30-5 4Q in the Rio Grande Rivalry before scoring 23 str to only lose by 2. This will be a significant change in pace for the Broncos facing the option on a short wk after Wazzu's up-tempo pass attack. They've had trouble against the option (1-9 ATS) but will have the edge on D and are home. BSt is 12-28 as a HF, but is 30-18 vs non-conf foes. NM is 12-6 as an AD.

## FRIDAY SEPT 15

**Massachusetts at TEMPLE** - TU scored twice in the L/1:20 of the only prior mtg ('15) to win 25-23 (-13). After getting thumped by Notre Dame in their opener the Owls needed a 49 yd fg w/1:00 left to get by an FCS foe LW as they were outg'd 402-353. UMass all'd 8 sks and lost at home to Old Dominion LW. TU has their AAC opener on deck, while the Minutemen have a GUB edge with a trip to Tenn on deck. The Owls are 6-1 as a HF and UMass is 12-18 as an AD.

**Illinois at USF** - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. While USF won their 1st two games, they've underachieved so far in the ssn under new HC Strong and their non-scheduled bye last week due to Hurricane Irma probably came at the right time. They do have their AAC opener next Thurs on deck. IL has lost 14 of their L/15 road openers. The Illini are just 6-15 as an AD and while HC Smith has a history at Raymond James Stadium as the HC of the TB Bucs in '14-'15 he went just 3-13 at home. IL has a bye on deck. USF is just 1-4 SU hosting P5 foes, but are 8-1-1 as a HF.

**Arizona at UTEP** - AZ is 22-1-1 in this series s/58 including 12 straight wins (only loss in El Paso '70). The L/mtg was in '03's ssn opener, UA won 42-7 (-21'). The 'Cats enter off a home loss to Houston as QB Dawkins (CS) was replaced by Tate early 4Q. Dawkins had struggled, but was also "nicked up" per HC Rodriguez. After getting handled at Oklahoma in their opener UTEP was dominated by Rice LW getting outg'd 437-229 & outFD'd 22-12. This is the road opener for AZ and they're just 4-12 as an AF of 7+ pts. The Miners are 0-6 SU/4-2 ATS when hosting P5 foes.

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## SATURDAY SEPT 16

**SOUTH CAROLINA by 6 over Kentucky** - This is the SEC opener for Kentucky. The 'Cats have won the L/3 in this series SU with SC winning the 3 prior. The Cocks are 12-8-1 ATS in the series. The 'Cats had all they could handle LW with an in-state FCS foe as they trailed in the 4Q. RB Snell ply'd thru bruised ribs to rush for 103 (5.4). SC is 2-0 SU/ATS despite being outg'd in both. KR Samuel had his 2nd str gm with a KOR td in the Cocks win at Mizzou LW. KY is on an 8-14 ATS run, is 2-6 ATS in SEC openers & 13-24-2 vs SEC foes.

**Notre Dame by 12 over BOSTON COLLEGE** - BC has dropped 5 straight in this series including the last meeting at Fenway Park in 2015, but is on a 9-4 ATS run. The Eagles enter off a misleading final. The yds were nearly identical, BC had the FD edge, but was -4 TO's. RFR Brown was benched after throwing 3 int's, but 2 of those were off his receivers hands. ND enters off a physical & emotional 1 pt loss as they all'd the game deciding fg w/3:34 left. They were outg'd 326-266 & RB Adams only avg 2.8 ypc. The Irish has a trip to Mich St on deck, while the Eagles are at defending Nat'l champs Clemson. Since Lou Holtz left the Irish sidelines in '96, ND is just 5-15 SU in their first 'true' away gm and the Irish are 5-12 as an AF.

**VIRGINIA by 9 over Connecticut** - The home team has won all 3 prior mtgs (1-2 ATS). UVA will be in revenge mode after all'g the GW fg w/1:33 left LY. CT is travelling for the 1st time, off an unscheduled bye due to Hurricane Irma & have a bye on deck. UVA is in a Indy/Boise sandwich so this game is circled as a more winnable one. The yds were nearly even in their home loss LW, but they continue to struggle with their ground game as they've failed to avg 3.0 ypc in each gm incl vs an FCS foe wk 1. The Huskies are 9-17-1 as a dog, while the 'Hoos are 9-3 ATS vs FBS non conf foes.

**MICHIGAN by 24 over Air Force** - These schools last played in 2012. This is HC Harbaugh's first ever game against the option as an FBS HC. UM only led Cincy by 3 late 3Q before pulling away & finished w/a 414-200 yd edge. RB Isaac had a car high 133 (6.7) rush & the Wolves all'd just 2.3 ypc after all'g Florida 0.4 the wk prior. It will be interesting to see how they do against the option. AF enters fresh off a bye and both schools have their conf openers on deck. UM is 1-4 as a HF, while the Falcons are 4-1 as an AD.

**UAB by 1 over Coastal Carolina** - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. UAB enters off a misleading final. After trailing by less than at td at the half LW at Ball St, they were outscored 30-7 until a gbg td late. The Blazers finished w/a 499-377 yd edge as fumbles and being SOD twice led to the lopsided score. CC enters fresh off a bye, but is travelling for the first time as an FBS member with an FCS foe on deck. UAB RB Brown has 193 rush (8.0) this year & the Blazers are avg 298 (5.6) rush ypg. CC all'd 237+ rush yds 3 times LY against FCS foes. UAB has their CUSA opener on deck and would like to get the bad taste of LW's loss out of their mouths. The Blazers are 12-4 as a HD.

**MIAMI, OH by 3 over Cincinnati** - It's homecoming weekend in Oxford and the Victory Bell is at stake. This is the longest running non-conf series as these schools have played every year s/1909 except '43-'44 (WWII). UC has won 11 in a row SU, but now finds themselves in the underdog role. The Bearcats are off a physical loss at Michigan, but trailed by just 3 late 3Q and had several missed opportunities down the stretch. Interestingly both have ply'd FCS Austin Peay with MU finishing w/a 295-270 yd edge, while UC was outg'd 313-248 in new HC Fickell's debut. Both schools have their conf openers on deck. The Bearcats are 13-8 ATS away, while the Redhawks are 7-12 as a HF.

**PENN ST by 42 over Georgia St** - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. PSU had their 11 game ATS win streak end LW against in-state rival Pitt as despite winning by 19, they were outg'd 342-312 & outFD'd 24-14. Pitt utilized time consuming drives to limit PSU's possessions. GSt is fresh off a bye following their loss to an FCS foe in their opener when they all'd 238 (5.7) rush & PSU has 1 of if not the best RB in the nation in Saquon Barkley. PSU HC Franklin is 19-12 ATS vs non-conf foes, while the Panthers have their conf opener on deck and won't take any unnecessary chances heading into their more important and winnable SBC games under new HC Elliott. PSU begins a new ATS streak this week with an easy win.

**Iowa St by 10 over AKRON** - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. IOSt HC Campbell went 0-2 ATS vs Akron as the HC at Toledo. The Zips followed up their lopsided loss at Penn St with an easy win over an FCS foe, while the 'Clones couldn't hold onto a DD 4Q lead in an emotional loss against their in-state rival Iowa. They're travelling for the 1st time, but have a bye on deck. The Zips all'd 322 (68%) pass vs PSU & IOSt QB Park hit 25-46-347-4-1 LW. Akron has never beaten an FBS non-conf foe at InfoCision Stadium, is 7-20 as a HD and 3-7 vs non-conf foes.

**North Carolina by 10 over OLD DOMINION** - UNC will be just the second P5 school to visit ODU (NCSt in '15). In the only prior mtg, UNC won 80-20 (-17) in '13. The Tar Heels should be excited about travelling for the 1st time after hosting B2B P5 foes and all'g 469 & 705 yds! QB Surratt started LW and hit 12-14-168-2-0 but was inj (CS) & wk 1 st'r LSU grad transf Harris showed improvement hitting 17-23-216-1-0. Sure UNC could be w/o 2 st'g OL here & ODU followed up their 7 sk perf vs an FCS foe in wk 1 with another 8 LW at UMass, but the Tar Heels are 6-2 as an AF while ODU is 6-11-1 ATS at home. UNC has enough talent to win by DD's.

**Oklahoma St by 8 over PITTSBURGH** - OKSt won the initial meeting in Stillwater LY, scoring the GW td w/1:28 left (45-38, -3'). The Pokes are on the 2nd of B2B AG's with their B12 opener vs TCU on deck. QB Rudolph hit 25-38-335-3-0 LW & set the schl rec for car pass yds (9,352 surpassing B. Weedens 9,260). Pitt is off an emotional loss to in-state rival PSU in which they ply'd better than the score indicated & have their ACC opener on deck. The Panthers used a ball control OFF last week & rushed for 155 (3.4) and OKSt all'd 244 (4.1) rush vs Tulsa wk 1. The Pokes are 1-3 ATS in non-conf AG's and 2-4-1 as a DD fav. We feel Pitt keeps its a tad closer than expected.

**MINNESOTA by 10 over Middle Tennessee** - MN won the last meeting 35-24 (-16) here in '14, all'g a gbg td w/4:5 left. MN led by just 3 late 2Q, but then reeled off 31 unanswered on the road to route Ore St LW and has a bye on deck. QB Rhoda threw just 8 passes (88%) as the Gophers ran for 253 (4.4). MT is on the 2nd of B2B AG's after their outright upset at Syracuse in an emotional return for DC Schaffer with Bowling Green on deck. They're all'g just 99 (2.3) rush ypg so far. Minn HC Fleck is on a 24-10 reg ssn ATS run, while the Blue Raiders are 6-9-1 as an AD dog and ply'g their 3rd str P5 foe.

**INDIANA by 23 over FIU** - These schools have met each of the L2Y with Indy winning & covering both. FIU was embarrassed at UCF in the ssn opener and while they finished w/465-269 yd & 26-12 FD edges vs an FCS foe last wk, they needed an 80/7pl drive to score the game winning td w/1:12 left. The game was also played at a neutral site due to Hurricane Irma. IU is off B2B Power 5 teams. QB Lagow hit just 3-10 with an int and was benched. Bkp Peyton Ramsey came in and hit 16-20-173-2-0. IU pulled out a deceiving 34-17 (-3) win though the yds were nearly even. FIU is just 1-21 SU vs current P5 tms away, but is 9-5-1 as an AD & 9-3 ATS in gm 1 of B2B road trips, while Indiana is 1-4 as a HF.

**NEBRASKA by 14 over Northern Illinois** - The last meeting took place in 1990, before any of the current players were born. NIU enters fresh off an easy win over an in-state FCS foe with a bye on deck. We won a 3★ LPS with Nebraska in their physical loss at Oregon LW and they have their B10 opener on deck. RB Bryant had 107 yds but left in the 3Q (inj, CS). This is the NIU's road opener. The Huskers are just 5-10-1 as a HF. NIU is 25-8 SU away & 17-5 as an AD.

**DUKE by 10 over Baylor** - These schls have met just once, way back in 1958. BU is travelling for the 1st time and hasn't lost a non-conf AG s/10. They are however off to an 0-2 start following shocking SU losses to both FCS Liberty (-30) & UTSA (-16, outgained 375-274 & we brought home a big dog winner at +615, purchase through the office for just \$9!). The Bears do have OU on deck while Duke has a trip to rival NC up next. Duke thrashed the other smart kids LW by a 41-17 margin (36-16 FD & 538-191 yd edges vs NW), which gives us value here. BU is 11-7 ATS in reg ssn non-conf games & HC Ruhl is 13-2 as a 7+ dog. We'll take the points with an underachieving Bears squad here.

**OHIO by 1 over Kansas** - KU is travelling for the 1st time and have lost 44 str away from Lawrence. They were victimized LW to a CM squad that was forced into 3OT the week prior vs FCS Rhode Island (CM 45 pts & 590 yds). The Bobcats also had some issues on D a wk ago vs Purdue in the 44-21 defeat (PU 558 tll yds) and OFF is not KU's issue. The Jayhawks will be in revenge mode after losing 37-21 (-1) in this matchup at home LY. The Dog in OU games is 10-5 and the Bobcats are just 1-6 as a HF vs FBS foes.

**WAKE FOREST by 7 over Utah St** - It's HC in Winston-Salem. WF dropped the only prior mtg 36-24 (+14) in Logan ('14). Behind an opportunistic D that forced 4 TO's, the Deacons enter off a misleading final at BC. The Aggies enter with a couple extra days of prep/rest after their expected win over an FCS foe last Thurs, but haven't played in the Eastern time zone since '14. Wake is 1-4 ATS in non-conf home games. The Aggies have their MW opener on deck, but still keep this game closer than expected.

**SYRACUSE by 14 over Central Michigan** - The Orange are 3-0 SU vs the Chips' incl a 30-27 (-8) home win in the L/mtg ('15). The Chips followed up their shaky performance vs an FCS foe in week 1 with an easier than expected 18 pt win over an improved KU squad (QB Morris 467 yds, 5 TD). They now face-off against a Syracuse squad that suffered a surprising home defeat to former HC Scott Shafer (now the DC at Midd Tenn). CM all'd 470 yds & 29 FD's LW & Syracuse avg'd 515 ypg vs non-conf foes LY. We don't think CM is as good nor the Orange as bad as each appeared last week. Syracuse has won their past 5 matchups against the MAC (4-1 ATS) and CM is on a 3-8 overall ATS run.

**Virginia Tech by 23 over EAST CAROLINA** - After allowing 422 rush yds in their opener vs FCS James Madison, the Pirates proved that they can't stop the pass either as WV threw for 403 yds LW in their 36 pt win. They now take on a VT squad that is 11-3 SU in this series and snapped B2B losses LY. The Hokies are playing their first true road game, but are fresh off an FCS foe (shutout Delaware 27-0) with just Old Dominion on deck. While the Pirates have a bye on deck, their defense (all'g 616 ypg TD) is clearly a liability. VT is on a 5-0 ATS run vs FBS foes, while EC is on a 4-14-1 run.

**Wisconsin by 14 over BYU** - The Cougars offense belongs on a milk carton so far TY as they've avg just 11 ppg the F/3 wks against Port St, LSU and Utah (Utah 430-233 yd edge). This is the Badgers 1st trip to Provo (won last mtg 27-19 as 9 pt fav in '13 at Madison) and 1st true non-conf road game s/'13, when they lost to AZSt 32-30 (+4). UW was able to get past FAU LW at home by 17 as 3 TO's potentially cost them a shot at the cover (29-10 FD & 564-248 yd edges). BYU is 17-7-1 ATS as a dog, but can't get anything going on offense, while UW (bye on deck) is on a 4-0 ATS run as an AF.

**IOWA by 21 over North Texas** - Iowa won the lone mtg, 62-16 (-25) here in '15. NT enters off a loss to in-state rival SMU 54-32 (+13). NT actually trailed 54-17 but added 2 long td drives in gbg time. QB Stanley stepped up in a big way (27-41-333-5-0) for Iowa LW, leading the Hawkeyes to a come from behind 44-41 (-3) win for the Cy-Hawk Trophy. The Hawkeyes are in a tough ISU/PSU sandwich and are just 11-20 as a HF. This is the 2nd of B2B AG's for NT, who has dropped 31 str on the road vs current P5 foes & are just 5-14 ATS on the road incl 5-13 as an AD.

**TEXAS A&M by 31 over Louisiana** - Not surprisingly A&M is 5-1 SU in this series with the lone loss coming in 1996. The last meeting between these schools took place in 2006. A&M followed up their emotional heartbreaking loss at UCLA with a closer than expected win over an FCS foe, and HC Sumlin's seat grows hotter by the day. True Frosh QB Mond got the start but was replaced by bkp QB Hubenak in the 3Q (str Starkel OFY). LA has their SBC opener which also happens to be the Battle on the Bayou rivalry on deck. LA was crushed LW at Tulsa 66-42 (+14), all'g 424 (5.9) rush yds & the Aggies had 382 (6.1) rush vs UCLA 2 wks ago. LA is 2-4 ATS vs P5 schools and 8-12 ATS vs SEC foes. A&M needs confidence and gets it here.

**NORTHWESTERN by 18 over Bowling Green** - These schools haven't played each other since the 2003 Motor City Bowl. After getting blown out in their opener vs MSU, BG lost LW 35-27 vs FCS South Dakota (-3) and was outgained 520-376. NW was dominated LW at Duke 41-17 (-2). QB Thorson didn't throw for a td for the first time since 2016's opener and finished just 11-29-120-0-2. NW is 21-4 SU hosting non-conf foes, but did lose twice LY. NW is just 7-13 as a HF & 1-7 ATS vs the MAC. The Wildcats do have a bye on deck. BG is 39-20-1 ATS in road gms and have backdoor potential here.

**OKLAHOMA by 28 over Tulane** - 1st mtg. OU hasn't faced the option s/10, a 27-24 (-16) win over AF here. The Sooners are 40-24 as a HF & enter off their emotional win over Ohio St. QB Mayfield threw for 386 yds and 3 td's then after the gm, planted the OU flag at midfield. Tulane enters off a 23-21 (+10) loss at Navy. QB Banks was inj'd in the 2Q and is a ? (CS) though bkp Brantley looked solid hitting 5-8 passes & leading the Green Wave with 7 (8.1) rush. OU is in an Ohio St/Baylor sandwich. The Green Wave are 6-3 as a DD dog. OU is in a letdown spot here and we feel TU keeps it closer than expected.

**FLORIDA by 7 over Tennessee** - LY the Vols ended their 11 gm series losing streak in this series, so Florida will be playing w/legit revenge. The Vols haven't won here since '03. UF is off an un-scheduled bye due to Hurricane Irma while the Vols enter off an easy win over an FCS foe. UF had 10 plyr's susp for the opener vs Mich and those susp's have not been lifted as of presstime (CS). The tm who runs the ball better has dominated this series, winning 14 of the L/15. HC Jones is 0-4 ATS in 'true' road openers.

**TCU by 20 over smu** - 97th mtg in the Battle for the Iron Skillet. TCU has won 15 of 17 incl 4 str by 19+, but is 5-9 ATS. LW we brought home a 3★ LPS winner (also 3★ on these pages) as TCU outFD'd Ark 24-13 in their 28-7 (-3) road win. SMU comes in off a deceiving 54-32 (-13) home win over in-state rival NT. The Mustangs led 54-17 before NT got 2 gbg time td's. QB Hicks threw 4 td's, all to WR Sutton who finished 8-163. TCU is in an Ark/OKSt sandwich. Hicks has a 6-1 ratio in 2 gms but TCU's secondary was #26 in our pass eff D rankings LY and has the entire 2 deep back. SMU is travelling for the 1st time.

**WKU by 10 over Louisiana Tech** - This is a rematch of LY's CUSA Title gm (also LTH) which featured 7 lead changes/5 ties. WKU (-10) led 48-44 w/14:08 left before pulling away w/2 td drives. LT won the reg ssn tilt at home 55-52 (+2'). These 2 comb'd for 1,076 ypg in the 2 mtgs LY. WKU's OFF hasn't clicked under new HC Sanford like it did under Brohm and they are off a 20-7 (-7) loss at IL. LT couldn't do much right LW in their 57-21(+9) home loss to Miss St that was highlighted by a ridiculous 87 yd loss off a bad snap! LT is 2-11 SU/5-8 ATS in road openers while WKU is 11-5 as a HF vs FBS foes.

**OHIO ST by 24 over Army** - 1st mtg. This is the 4th time HC Meyer has faced the option (2-1 ATS). The last was in '14 vs Navy & the Bucks all'd 370 (5.9) rush. OSU is coming in angry after being embarrassed on their home field by OK LW. While Army is just 4-25 SU in road openers, they won LY (+15) and OSU is off a physical gm vs OK. The Black Knights are just 2-9 SU s/10 away vs P5 schls, but beat WF LY & the L/3 losses have been by 7 pts or less. OSU is just 5-12 as a HF.

**WASHINGTON ST by 13 over Oregon St** - OSt is on a 12-5 ATS run in this series incl 6-1 in Pullman. This is the P12 opener for both tms. The Beavers lost at home to B10 Minn 48-14 (-3) and have a bye on deck. LW QB Falk became WSU's all-time leading passer but left w/an inj (CS). QB Hilinski hit 25-33-240-3-1, rallying the Cougars from a 21 pt deficit to win in 3OT. WSt is home for a 3rd str wk with NV on deck. WSU QB Falk is one of the nation's best, and Hilinski looked more than capable while OSU's secondary is down a few notches from LY, and they've yet to record a sk in 3 gms. WSt is on an 0-5 ATS run, while the Beavers are 9-5 ATS vs FBS foes.

**Appalachian State by 21 over TEXAS STATE** - This is the SBC opener for both schools. TXSt HC Withers is an App St alumni. The 'Cats were blown out last week at Colorado, but did allow just 91 (2.2) rush, while the Mountaineers enter fresh off an easy FCS win. We feel TXSt's rush D is improved enough to keep this game closer than expected. AST is 4-9 ATS vs SBC foes.

**ALABAMA by 38 over Colorado St** - The only prior meeting between these schools took place in 2013 with Bama winning at home 31-6 (-39). HC Bobo was OC at Georgia from '07-'14 and went 2-1 ATS vs Bama. CSU is fresh off an easy win over an FCS with a bye on deck. Bama could be w/o as many as 4 LB's (Miller & Lewis OFY, Jennings & Evans ?) but this team is just plug and play as NFL talent runs 4 deep at every position besides QB. The Rams are 2-5 ATS in road openers, while Bama is 52-36-1 as DD fav and on a 15-6-1 ATS run.

**TOLEDO by 7 over Tulsa** - These schls haven't met s/64. Tulsa's OFF is firing on all cylinders after putting up 66 puts on Louisiana LW, going over the total on their own. After being held to just 33 yds in the opener, RB Brewer had 38-262 (6.9). UT is off a rare west coast win at NV, 37-24 (-11). QB Woodside was the top QB in the MAC LY w/a 45-9 ratio but Tulsa was #28 in our pass eff D rankings and has 3 str's back in their secondary. The Golden Hurricane are 12-4 ATS away & are on an 19-11 overall ATS run. UT is off a trip to NV with a trip to Miami, FI on deck. The Rockets are on a 19-10-2 overall ATS run.

**WESTERN MICHIGAN by 10 over Idaho** - This is WM's home opener, while ID is travelling for the 1st time. The Bronco's are off a brutal 2 gm road stretch at USC & MSU, but have just an FCS foe on deck. We went against WM LW on these pages for another 3★ winner as MSU won 28-14 (-7) but dominated much more than the score indicates. WM was outg'd 457-195 and their 2 td's came on a KR & fumble return. ID enters off a 44-16 (-6) home loss to UNLV. The Vandals are 13-3 as an AD, while WM is on a 27-12 ATS run.

**Southern Miss by 10 over ULM** - SM is 3-1 SU vs ULM, but this marks their 1st trip to Monroe and the last time these schools played each other was '93. The Golden Eagles rebounded from their ssn opening loss to Kentucky with an easy win over an FCS foe and have a bye on deck. ULM enters fresh off an unscheduled bye due to Hurricane Irma and has their SBC opener which also happens to be the Battle of the Bayou vs Louisiana on deck. ULM is 8-1 SU in home openers but just 1-3 when involving an FBS program. The Warhawks are 10-21 ATS at home. SM is 17-10 as an AF.

**Oregon by 17 over WYOMING** - WY should be fired up as they haven't hosted a power 5 school since 2011. They're fresh off an easy FCS win and have Hawai'i on deck, while Oregon enters off an emotional & physical win vs Nebraska. Oregon is 14-4-1 ATS in their road openers but they have lost their L/2 straight up. QB Allen is projected as a #1DC, but struggled at Iowa 2 wks ago and this is the last P5 foe on the schedule to make a statement against. The Pokes are 6-0 as a HD and on a 14-8 overall ATS run vs FBS foes. The Ducks are 14-5 as an AF.

**Lsu by 10 over MISSISSIPPI ST** - This is the SEC opener for both schools. LY MSU trailed 23-3 at HT. With 2:15 left & down 3, MSU was SOD at their 17, losing 23-20 (-13'). The LTH was deja vu as LSU led 23-6 4Q but only won 23-19 (-4). The Tigers enter fresh off an easy win over an FCS foe and are playing their first true road game. Miss St dominated LT 57-21 (-9) on the road LW. DT Jeffrey Simmons had a fat man's dream day with 2 td's (blk PR & fmb). OLB Arden Key (LSU sk leader LY) may return after missing the first 2 games. LSU is 7-2 ATS overall since HC Orgeron took over, while MSU is 3-6 ATS at home.

# SEPTEMBER 5★ GOES THIS SATURDAY!

**Kansas St by 7 over VANDERBILT** - Vandy won the last and only prior meeting 26-14 in '84. The 'Dores looked good in their season opener at Middle Tenn and is fresh off an FCS foe, but do have their SEC opener against Bama on deck. KSt is off a relaxing 55-7 (-34) home win vs Charlotte and has a bye on deck. RT Risner (1st Tm B12) was inj'd and is a ? (CS). QB Shurmur has a 7-0 ratio while KSt has all'd just 128 pass ypg in their F/2. Vandy is 15-2 SU hosting non-conf foes and 9-2 ATS vs FBS foes in the reg ssn. KSt is 5-2 SU/ATS in road openers.

**HOUSTON by 17 over Rice** - The Bayou Bucket is at stake for these in-city rivals. They were conf foes from '05-'12, with the last mtg in '13. It will be an emotional home opener for UH as this is their 1st home gm after Hurricane Harvey and it's also HC Applewhite's home debut. The Cougars beat AZ 19-16 (-1) at a neutral site despite AZ having a GUB edge. Rice enters after winning their CUSA opener at UTEP 31-14 (+1). The Cougars are just 3-10-1 as a HF against non-conf foes. Rice is on the 2nd of B2B AG's but are 16-9 ATS off a DD win, while UH is in an AZ/TT sandwich.

**Troy by 7 over NEW MEXICO ST** - This is the SBC opener for both & NMSt's home opener. The Aggies have been impressive so far, only losing to AZSt by 6 on the road then upsetting rival NM for the 2nd straight year 30-28 (+7) though they actually led 30-5 in the 4Q. Troy, meanwhile is fresh off an easy FCS win. QB Silvers is the best in the SBC & hit 72% w/a 2-0 ratio in LY's mtg with all 4 DB starters back for NMSt. The Trojans are 10-3 ATS away and covered 2 wks ago at Boise, while the Aggies are on a 21-35 (or 6-2) overall ATS run & are 3-1 as a HD.

**TEXAS TECH by 7 over Arizona St** - TT is in revenge mode after all'g the most pts ever to a non-conf foe in LY's 68-55 (+1) loss in Tempe. AZSt RB Ballage tied an NCAA rec w/8 rush td's. Unfortunately Ballage was inj'd in LW's 30-20 (-3) home loss to SDSt and RB Richard also sat w/an inj (CS). TT is fresh off a bye & is 7-0 as a HF. AZSt is travelling for the 1st time, has Oregon on deck, and is making their 1st ever appearance in Lubbock. The Sun Devils are 5-11-1 as an AD. HC Kingsbury has covered his L/4 off a bye.

**USC by 20 over Texas** - The last mtg took place in the '05 BCS Nat'l Title with TX winning 41-38 (+7). These schls haven't met in the reg ssn s/67. This is Tom Herman's 1st road gm as HC at TX. True Frosh QB Ehlinger st'd in place of inj'd Buechele and was impressive in a 56-0 (-25') blowout win over SJSt. USC was even more impressive than the final score LW in their 42-24 (-6) win over Stanford, holding a 623-342 yd edge. The Trojans are 25-12 as a HF. Herman is a perfect 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS vs ranked teams. The 'Horns are 2-8 ATS in true road games. USC has won their L/9 at home and outscored foes by 21 ppg last year.

**UTAH by 21 over San Jose St** - These two former WAC rivals meet again. LY Utah traveled to SJSt and won 34-17 (-13). This is a sandwich gm for Utah, coming off the Holy War vs BYU with their P12 opener vs AZ on deck. SJSt was victimized by an embarrassed and upset Texas squad last week and won't see the same passion opposite them here. Utah is 3-7 as a HF vs FBS foes and the Spartans need to get some confidence even if it comes against bkps late.

**WASHINGTON by 35 over Fresno St** - New HC Tedford will be glad when this stretch is over, coming off a trip to SEC Champ Bama and now facing P12 champ UW. Tedford was an offensive consultant for UW LY and knows the personnel. The Huskies are fresh off an FCS foe, but do have their P12 opener on deck. UW is 18-12 as a HF. The Bulldogs are just 3-10 as an AD. HC Peterson may take it easy on his friend and the Huskies won't be showing much with Colorado on deck.

**Mississippi by 10 over CALIFORNIA** - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. Ole Miss has had just one trip to the pacific time zone in their history, beating Fresno St 38-28 (+3') in 2011. Both tms enter off wins vs FCS foes. Ole Miss QB Patterson threw for a schl rec 489 yds. Cal actually trailed heading into the 4Q and was outg'd by 140 yds. Cal has their P12 opener against USC next. The Rebels are 6-3 ATS in road openers since '08 & 26-15-1 ATS vs non conf. Cal is 6-16 as HD and the fav is 41-21 in Berkeley.

**4★ KANSAS CITY over Philadelphia** - Following a come-from-behind win LW in Foxboro where they scored 21 unanswered 4Q pts against the defending Champs (537-371 yd edge), HC Reid takes on his former team (won only other meeting vs old tm 26-16, +3 in his 1st yr w/Chiefs) with a few days of extra rest. The Eagles meanwhile took advantage of a sloppy performance by the Redskins (PHI forced 4 TO's) LW in DC and now journey on the road for a 2nd consec wk. Although PHI is a solid 11-2 ATS in their matchups against the AFC, we find it difficult not to back the Chiefs here as not only have they covered 6 of their past 7 regular ssn matchups, but Arrowhead Stadium has also been a "House of Horrors" for young QB's like Wentz over the past decade. **FORECAST: KANSAS CITY BY 13**

**3★ LA CHARGERS over Miami** - First HG for the newly relocated Chargers (temporary StubHub Center holds just 27,000-half the size of all but 1 current NFL Stadium) following their MNF battle against the Broncos in "Mile High". The Dolphins meanwhile saw their only HG of Sept postponed LW due to Hurricane Irma (at LAC, at NYJ, w/NO in London next 3 wks). While LAC is on a current 0-5 ATS run as of presstime, we'll give them the edge here as not only do they have a GUB advantage over LW's idle Dolphins, but new MIA QB Cutler has seen his team struggle in his matchups against the Chargers during his 11-yr career (outscored by 14 ppg in 7 overall meetings). **FORECAST: LA CHARGERS BY 10**

## OTHER SELECTION

**2★ Chicago (+) over TAMPA BAY** - Following an unexpected week off to start the ssn due to the hurricane, the Bucs are in action for the 1st time in '17 carrying a solid 6-2 ATS run dating back to LY. The Bears meanwhile head South after falling just short LW at home against the defending NFC Champs (sacked from ATLS 5 yd line on final play trailing by 6). With the Bears having a GUB advantage and the Bucs going just 1-8 ATS run as a HF, we expect CHI to stay within the line in this one. **FORECAST: TAMPA BAY BY 1**

## OTHER GAMES

**Houston at CINCINNATI - Thursday** - This will mark the 8th meeting (incl playoffs) between these 2 squads with HOU having the commanding edge with wins in 6 of the L/7 (11 pt avg MOV). Both teams come in following embarrassing home performances as the Texans were forced into 4 TO's in a 22 pt loss to JAX while the Bengals were shutout at home for the 1st time since 2001 (QB Dalton 4 int). Something will have to give in this one however as CIN is on just a 5-13 ATS run overall while HOU has delivered just a 1-8 ATS mark as a NDIV AD and could be giving rookie QB Watson his 1st career start. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**Tennessee by 3 over JACKSONVILLE** - Just the 4th time in the past 4 yrs (0-2-1 ATS) that the Titans come in as a road favorite. Ironically their last trip to JAX was one of those previously mentioned times with the Jaguars getting the 21 pt win (415-263 yd edge) as TEN QB Mariota was lost for the ssn w/inj. JAX took advantage of a handful of Texan miscues LW in their win in HOU while the Titans were unable to slow down the Raiders in Nashville (10 pt loss). Although TEN (7-26 ATS vs DIV foes) and JAX (9-21-1 ATS as a HD) have had their issues covering the spread recently, we'll give a small lean with the visitor here (Jags have London on deck) as they try and get their 1st win in JAX in 4 ssn.

**BALTIMORE by 10 over Cleveland** - The DeShone Kizer era saw some mixed results LW at home against the Steelers (222 pass yds, 2 tlt TD, 1 int) in their narrow home defeat (3.5★ Top Play LP Winner on UNDER 47). The rookie QB now heads to BAL for his 1st career road start against a Ravens squad that has come out victorious in 5 of the L/6 vs CLE with a 7 pt avg MOV. BAL's defense delivered a dominating performance LW in the shutout at CIN (all'd just 220 yds, forced 5 TO's) giving us a 3★ Newsletter Winner. The deciding factor for our lean on the Ravens comes via recent spread history as BAL is an outstanding 9-1 ATS vs DIV foes while CLE has been the polar opposite failing to cover 10 of their past 12 against the AFC North!

**CAROLINA by 10 over Buffalo** - Following a 9 pt victory a week ago against the Jets where BUF had 23-11 FD & 408-214 yd edges, new HC McDermott returns to his former stomping grounds of Charlotte where he spent the past 6 yrs as the Panthers DC. CAR was able to deliver a stout defensive performance LW in SF by holding the 49ers to just 3 pts & 217 tlt yds. While the Bills have covered 5 straight against the NFC coming in, we'll lean with the hometown Panthers in this one as they're on a 10-4 ATS run as a NDIV HF and appear to be heading back to the top of the NFC standings in '17.

**New England by 10 over NEW ORLEANS** - Rough opening night for the Patriots as they appeared to be on their way to another home rout against KC up 17-7 before inj's and struggles on both sides of the ball saw them outscored 21-0 in the 4Q. They do however receive extra rest having played on Thur with Belichick an outstanding 24-9 ATS off a SU loss dating back to 2006. While the rested Pats come in with 9 days between gms, the same cannot be said for the Saints after their road trip to MIN on MNF. Despite being 5-0 ATS as a HD and having gone on a 15-6 ATS run overall as of presstime, a solid lean with NE this week (5-0 ATS as a NDIV AF) is the right way to go, especially with NO's struggles on D the past 3 ssn (#25, #25, #27).

**Arizona by 5 over INDIANAPOLIS** - After a rough trip out West against the Rams where bkp QB Tolzien (9-18 for 128 yds & 2 int's ret'd for TD's, benched late for Brissett) struggled to get anything going for the inj'd Luck, the Colts return home in a HD role that they've had vast success in (10-2 ATS). The Cardinals are on the road for the 2nd consec wk to start the ssn following their matchup LW in DET, a game in which the Lions scored 24 of the game's final 30 pts (QB Palmer 3 int, lost RB Johnson during gm-expected to miss here). While it will likely be either Tolzien or Brissett under center again in place of their franchise QB, it's tough to lay too many points w/ARZ at the moment with their current 3-9 ATS run.

**PITTSBURGH by 3 over Minnesota** - The Steelers held on to a narrow 3 pt win LW in CLE behind an 11 catch, 182 yd outing from WR Brown (Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner on UNDER 47). The Vikings head to Heinz Field on short rest following their MNF battle w/NO although it's worth mentioning that they've been extremely strong in their matchups against the AFC with a 10-2 ATS mark. With MIN also posting a 21-9 ATS run overall as of presstime and a 13-6 ATS record as an AD, we'll call for them to stay within the line here against a Steelers offense that was held to just 35 rush yds (2.1) a week ago vs the Browns.

**OAKLAND by 14 over NY Jets** - The Raiders return home following yet another regular ssn road victory (7 out of L/10) with an equally solid 7-3 ATS mark as a fav. The Jets meanwhile

displayed the struggles that we expected LW in the opener against BUF as they were held to just 214 tlt yds of offense in the 9 pt loss. While this is the only HG in the 1st 4 wks for the Raiders and the Jets are just 1-5-1 ATS as an AD, this line may end up being too elevated for a lean with the HF.

**Washington by 3 over LA RAMS** - The Rams were able to start off the ssn with an easy win against the Colts (2 int ret TD's, 374-232 yd edge) albeit with QB Luck out w/inj. Former WAS asst and current Rams rookie HC McVay now plays host to his former squad that shot themselves in the foot on numerous occasions in a 13 pt home loss LW vs PHI. With WAS still on a 14-6 ATS run coming in and the Rams having gone just 2-9-2 ATS dating back to LY, we'll go ahead and give the FG lean with the visitor in this one as they look to get into the win column for the 1st time TY.

**DENVER by 1 over Dallas** - Following a dominating performance from their Def LW against the Giants in which they all'd just 3 pts, 13 FD & 233 tlt yds, the Cowboys head to DEN to take on a Broncos team that's squeaked out the past 4 matchups in this series by 3, 7, 3 and 2 pts dating back to 2001. While DAL has some pretty impressive spread marks including 17-7-1 ATS vs the AFC and 6-1 ATS as a NDIV AF, we'll go ahead and back a DEN squad here (3-1 ATS as HD over L4Y) in their 2nd consec HG (MNF vs LAC) to start the year.

**SEATTLE by 14 over San Francisco** - The 49ers haven't won a regular ssn gm in Seattle since 2011. In fact, the Seahawks have swept the ssn series in each of the past 3 yrs with a 5-1 ATS mark while outscoring SF by 14 ppg in that span. SEA's offense was held out of the EZ LW in GB in a game that they mustered just 12 FD's & 225 tlt yds in. The 49ers saw their current ATS skid move to 4-12 as they were also unable to get anything going on the offensive side of the ball (3 pts, 217 tlt yds) against CAR in the debut of HC Shanahan. With the 49ers posting just a 5-10 ATS mark as an AD and the Seahawks at 17-7 ATS as a DIV HF, we'll give them the 2 TD edge in this one.

**Green Bay at ATLANTA - SNF** - This marks the 3rd matchup between these 2 squads in ATL in less than a year with the Falcons getting the best of the 1st 2 meetings including a 23 pt win in LY's NFC Championship. The Falcons have to feel fortunate to enter this matchup at 1-0 after hanging on to a 6 pt win LW in CHI. The Packers delivered the 17-9 win LW in Lambeau against a Seahawks team that had just 225 tlt yds for the game. While the Falcons should be hyped for their 1st regular ssn gm in their new home, their 4-13 ATS mark as a HF and GB (3-9 ATS as an AD) seeking revenge could see this one go down to the final possession. **Call your VIP Debit Card for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

**Detroit at NY GIANTS - MNF** - Following a come-from-behind win LW against the Cardinals (forced 4 ARZ TO's), the Lions head East to take on a Giants team that's won 4 of the past 5 regular ssn matchups dating back to '07 (17-6 win as 4' pt fav LY). Not much went right LW in DAL for the Giants as DAL dominated in nearly every area in their 19-3 victory (392-233 yd edge). While the Giants are on an 8-4 ATS run overall, this DET squad has proven to be resilient the past 2 yrs including a playoff berth a ssn ago.
