4★ Ucf over NAVY - This is the first ever meeting. We cashed our Underdog POW on these pages as well as a 4★ LPS on Navy as they overcame rare self-inflicted wounds at Memphis. UCF is 5-0 (4-0 ATS) for the first time as an FBS member as they continue to dominate foes by an average score of 51-17! QB Milton is 1 of the most improved in the nation, has a 15-2 ratio, and Navy has just our #116 pass eff D. UCF athletes are too fast for Navy and they don't take their foot off the gas once they have a lead. HC Frost ran the option as QB for Nebraska. Navy has exhaled a ton of emotion and energy the L2W and UCF has a legit chance to make a NY6 bowl bid if they continue to dominate. UCF is 3-1 as an AF, while Navy is 0-3 ATS at home this year.

FORECAST: UCF by 14

3★ Troy over GEORGIA ST - This will be the first SBC game in GSU's new stadium. The Panthers opened the season at home and lost outright to an FCS foe despite being more than a 2 td favorite! We cashed another easy college Marquee winner (10-2 L2W!) going against the Trojans last week after their monumental upset at LSU the week prior. GSU was able to rush for 224 (5.5) last week, but Troy is allowing just 99 (2.9) rush ypg. The Panthers enter on a 3 game winning streak off their best performance of the season, finishing +239 yds at ULM. Troy enters with 3 extra days of rest/prep and are 11-4 ATS away, while GSU is 7-10-1 as a HD. We feel Troy will enter this game much more focused and very angry after last weeks effort and will rebound in a major way.

FORECAST: TROY by 14

3★ TEXAS TECH over Iowa St - TT is in revenge mode after allowing 66 points and having their 4 game series winning streak snapped last year. This is the lone home game for the Red Raiders in a 4 game stretch as they're off B2B away games with a trip to Oklahoma on deck. We cashed a 3★ LPS total on the OVER in TT's shootout loss at West Virginia last week. 2★ Pittsburgh (+) over DUKE - Pitt has won the L/2 meetings by a combined 60 points, covering by a combined 53' points. Ben DiNucci took over last week for injured QB Max Browne (OFY) while true frosh Kenny Pickett also saw action in their loss to NCST. The score was a bit misleading as they allowed a late td when NCST was simply trying to run out the clock. Duke was fortunate to be in their game last week vs Florida St considering they were outgained by 110 yards. Daniel Jones has completed just 48% of his passes the L/3 games. Pitt is 8-4 as an AD while Duke is 1-6 as a HF vs P5 foes with 5 of those losses being outright upsets! This is nearly a must win for Pitt if they want to become bowl eligible.

FORECAST: DUKE by 2

2★ MISSISSIPPI ST over Kentucky - MSU is in revenge mode after having their 7 game series win streak broken on a 51 yard GW fg as time expired. The 'Cats last won 2 straight in this series in '78-'79. Two years ago is the same role MSU won 42-16 (-12). KY comes in fresh off a bye and need just 1 win to be bowl elig. Miss St is off a 35-10 win over BYU (-23') and we picked up another Early Bird Winner with the Bulldogs (Button #9 comp on Mondays, 184-104-1 L/20 years!). Memphis at HOUSTON - Houston is in revenge mode as they had their 3 game series win streak snapped after allowing the game winning td w/19 left last year. Memphis is travelling for the third time in 4 weeks and had all they could handle with the Navy option last week. The Cougars enter off a misleading final as they allowed 1 and 6 yard td drives along with a fumble ret td. Memphis has the edge on ST's and OFF including a large edge at QB, while Houston has a large edge on D. The Cougars are just 5-10-1 as a HF, but on a 36-23-2 overall ATS run, while the Tigers are 7-3-1 as an AD, but on just a 5-10 overall ATS run.

Louisiana at ARKANSAS ST - ASU is in revenge mode after having their 15 game SBC win streak snapped last year when they had the GW td w/02 left overturned. UL enters with normal prep, off an easy win last Thurs over Tx St with a bye on deck. The Red Wolves enter off a blowout home win over Coastal Carolina. Neither team fares well on the D side of the ball, while ASU has the edge on OFF and ST's. The Cajuns are 24-12 as an AD, but the Red Wolves are 23-12 as a HF.

Wku by 12 over OLD DOMINION - These 2 have comb'd for 285 pts (95 ppg) in their 3 mtgs. The Toppers are 3-0 SU/ATS with an avg MOV of 25 ppg. Last week HC Mike Sanford said he wanted to see the 'Toppers throw the ball downfield more often. QB Mike White tied a car high with 5 td passes and threw for a ssn high 398 and WKU finished w/a ssn high 627 tt yds in their win over Charlotte. ODU has lost 4 straight all by 30+ pts. True Frosh QB Williams has hit just 39% of his passes. The Monarchs are a beat up team but did get some good news with All-CUSA RB Lawry returning from inj LW. ODU is on a 1-6 ATS run and 1-5 as a HD. WKU is 14-7 as a DD fav.

Marshall by 6 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - These two have split their 4 mtgs as FBS foes with the home tm winning all 4 mtgs (3-0-1 ATS). LY QB Urzua made his first career start (QB Stockstill was inj'd) in this game and MT led 17-14 at HT before allowing 28 unanswered in the 2H. Urzua has started the L/5 with Stockstill again inj'd and MT is 2-3 ATS but both covers were at home. The Herd's D is #59, holding foes to 22 ypg below their avg and they've held 3 of their L/4 foes to 3 pts or less. The Blue Raiders D is #44, holding foes to 35 ypg below their avg. MT is 14-21 ATS at home. This is the Herd's 3rd road gm in 4 wks.

Air Force by 10 over NEVADA - The Falcons are 2-1 SU/ATS in the series with the L/mtg in '14. They did however have some early hiccups LW against UNLV (trailed 27-7 at HT) before rattling off 27 of the final 30 pts behind QB Worthman's 5 ttl TD's. Nevada was also involved in a tight contest LW in Fort Collins (led in 4Q as 24' pt dog) before eventually falling by 2. The Falcons are 18-8-1 ATS off a SU win but are in their 3rd road gm in a 4 week span (Nevada bye on deck). With this being Nevada HC Norvell's 1st time trying to defend the AF triple option, we'll go ahead and give the Falcons a 10 pt edge in this one.

Colorado St by 10 over NEW MEXICO - CSU has won 7 str over NM by 17 ppg (5 consec covers). The Rams escaped with a 2 pt home victory LW against Nevada in a game that featured 1,172 yds of offense. The Lobos surprisingly showed no offense vs a Fresno tm who has a 1st year DC from Canada that had never defended the option in a 38-0 shutout loss. While this happens to be CSU's 3rd road gm in a 4 week span and the home team is on a 7-2 ATS run overall, we'll go ahead and give the Rams the 10 pt edge in this one as they have covered 6 consec MW road matchups including 30 & 13 pt victories over Hawaii and Utah St respectively this ssn.

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 21

Iowa by 2 over NORTHWESTERN - Iowa enters fresh off a bye and in revenge mode after having their 3 game series win streak snapped on homecoming last year. NW enters off a dominant win at MD as RB Jackson had 171 yds to set the school record for career rush yards. The Hawkeyes have allowed 200+ rush yards in two of their L/3 games, but held Michigan St to just 88 (2.2) two games ago on the road. The 'Cats have the edge on D, while Iowa has a decent sized edge on ST's and the OFF's are about even. NW is 8-13 as a HF, while the Hawkeyes are 8-0 ATS when playing with revenge from a SU home loss and are 18-8-1 ATS away from Iowa City.

Tulsa by 13 over CONNECTICUT - It's homecoming weekend in Storrs for the first ever meeting between these schools. This is the first of 3 straight home games for UConn with Mizouu on deck. Both enter off misleading finals as Tulsa won by 4 td's, benefitting from short td drives off TO's, while the Huskies got their first FBS win despite being outgained 473-244. Both defenses rank among the worst in the nation, but the Hurricane has large edges on OFF and ST's. Tulsa has used 2 QB's their L/2 games. The Hurricane is 14-5 ATS away, while UConn is 1-7 ATS at home vs FBS foes.

Smu by 14 over CINCINNATI - It's Homecoming weekend in Cincy. SMU enters fresh off a bye after their misleading loss at Houston. The Bearcats enter off another blowout loss that saw QB Moore inj (elbow, CS) in the 4Q vs USF. The Ponies have gained the most yards given up by 3 teams and are #13 in the FBS averaging 105 ypg more than their foes allow. Cincy's lone 2 wins have come against an FCS foe in a game they were outgained in and vs Miami, Oh when they scored the GW td on a 14 yd IR td w/1:07 left. The Bearcats are 1-7 at home vs FBS foes, while SMU is 5-2-1 ATS away.

FAU by 6 over North Texas - This is suddenly a very interesting CUSA meeting as these teams are a comb'd 5-0 in conf play. NT enters off an emotional win over UTSA as they trailed 26-22 with 1:07 left and drove 98 yds for the GW td. The Mean Green's OFF is #7 in the FBS, putting up 126 ypg more than their foes allow and FAU's D is just #118, allowing 91 ypg more than their foes avg. NT QB Fine has thrown for 1,796 w/a 14-5 ratio. HC Kiffin seems to have finally settled on a QB with Jason Driskel. RB Devin Singletary has gone over 100 yds 4 straight and has 686 (6.5) on the ssn. FAU is fresh off a bye and while they are 3-12-1 ATS at home, they are 2-0 as a HF under HC Kiffin.

MIAMI, OH by 1 over Buffalo - Miami ended a 4 game series losing streak last year. The dog is 2-7 and in 18 meetings there has never been an outright upset! The Redhawks are clearly not the same team without QB Ragland who was inj 2 weeks ago and remains a ? here. Buffalo enters with 4 losses by a combined 17 points despite being without their starting QB the last 3.5 games. The Bulls have shown the ability to run or pass, but their D is #120, allowing 93 ypg more than their foes average. The Redhawks are 15-9-1 ATS vs MAC foes.

TOLEDO by 15 over Akron - The home team is 4-1 SU/ATS. UT was on a 0-3 ATS series run until LY's 48-17 (-10) road win. Akron pulled the outright upset the LTH. UT is 3-9-1 ATS as a HF vs MAC foes. The Zips are on the 2nd of B2B road gms and 4th in 5 wks and had their game vs WM moved to Sunday due to weather which could throw their normal prep off! The Zips have won 3 straight MAC gms & covered 4 straight incl an upset over WM. While Akron has a slight D edge (#65-#68), UT has a huge OFF edge (#33-#116) and should be able to bring the Zips streaks to an end.

OHIO by 18 over Kent St - Ohio has won and covered the L/3 of this series but Kent was 5-0 ATS prior. The home team is just 6-11 SU/5-12 ATS. Ohio is 3-6 as a HF incl an outright loss to CM 2 wks ago. The Bobcats delivering a 3★ LPS winner over BG for us last week. KS is 2-1 ATS in MAC play incl an outright upset of Miami. KS has the D edge (#75-#90) but has struggled on OFF (#128) avg just 8 ppg vs FBS foes but did score 17 LW. Ohio has our #73 off avg 27 ppg vs FBS foes with a low of 21 vs Purdue. While Ohio should win comfortably KS should be able to keep it closer than the opening line.

Northern Illinois by 15 over BOWLING GREEN - Prior to LY, the previous 3 mtgs all took place in the MAC Title gm. NIU is 26-8 ATS on the road and 15-6-1 ATS vs MAC foes, but on the 2nd of B2B AG's. BG is just 1-8 ATS at home incl 0-3 TY. Their 1 win was thanks to a late 93 yd FR td vs a Miami tm that had lost it's starting QB. BG actually has the slightest of OFF edges (#94-#95) but NIU has a dominate D edge (#47-#127). The Huskies should be able to get their rush attack in gear against a BG who is allowing 247 rush ypg (5.5 ypc).

E MICHIGAN by 3 over W Michigan - It's homecoming in Ypsilanti! EM is 12-7 ATS in this rivalry despite being just 5-14 SU. The dog is 13-7 with 6 upsets. EM is 18-35 ATS at home but is on a 16-4 ATS run incl 5-1 TY. WM is 15-5 ATS as an AF. WM enters off a 1 pt loss to Akron as a 14 pt HF. That game was played on Sunday due to weather giving them 1 less day of rest the wk after a 7OT gm. This is also not EM team you are used to, as they upset Rutgers TY and their 3 SU losses are by 7 vs Ohio, 4 at Kentucky & 1 LW vs Army when they went for the 2 pt conv & the win. WM has the OFF edge (#69-#101) but EM has the edge on D (#37-#66). This is a confident EM team facing a tired WM who has their big rival CM on deck.

MICHIGAN ST by 12 over Indiana - MSU is on a 10-3 ATS series run and playing with revenge after having their 7 game series winning streak snapped last year when Indy won the Old Brass Spittoon for the first time s/06. This is the lone home game in a 4 week span for Sparty and it's homecoming in East Lansing. MSU backers deserved better last week as they led 30-13 4Q, but allowed 2 td's in the L/5:20, covering 134 of the 290 yards they allowed and got backdoored with 1:06 left, costing us a 3★ here last week. IU enters off a physical OT loss vs Michigan, sending the game into extra's with 2 scoring drives in the L/3:27. Sparty has held 5 of their 6 foes to season lows in yards (2nd lowest vs ND) and is #6 in the FBS on D, holding foes to 151 ypg less than their average. The Hoosiers have gotten inconsistent play from their QB's and have allowed 242+ rush yards three times! Along with their struggles in this series, IU is also just 8-14 as an AD.

Uab by 9 over CHARLOTTE - HC Bill Clark has done a phenomenal job in reviving UAB's program and could even get COY consideration. The Blazers are off their 3rd outright upset of the season, beating MT 25-23. RB Spencer Brown had 167 (5.4) and has gone over 150 yds 3 times. Now the Blazers step into uncharted territory as a road fav vs an FBS foe. Charlotte is 0-7 on the ssn, has been outgained by 143 ypg and are off their worst performance of the ssn, losing by 31 pts to struggling WKU and were outgained by 318 yds. UC is 0-12 SU/3-8-1 ATS at home vs FBS programs, losing by an avg of 17 ppg.

ARMY by 6 over Temple - Temple is in revenge mode after losing in last year's opener as more than a 2 td favorite, which also snapped their 6 game series winning streak. Both schools have a bye on deck and Army is home for the third time in 4 weeks. The Black Knights run the option so well they have had 3 games w/o any pass yards. They allowed a td w/49 left last week, costing us a 3★ on these pages. The Owls enter off a misleading loss vs UConn as they finished w/473-244 yard and 28-15 FD edges. HC Collins didn't face an FBS option his L7Y as a DC at Florida and Miss St. Temple QB Marchi is adjusting to the new OFF w/B2B 300+ yard games and Army is #102 in our pass eff D rankings. The Black Knights are 1-6 as an FBS HF, while the Owls are 12-6 as an AD.

Byu by 3 over EAST CAROLINA - It's homecoming weekend in Greenville and this is their lone home game in a 4 week stretch. BYU is on the second of B2B away games and travelling for the third time in 4 weeks. EC's D is #127 in the FBS, allowing 149 ypg more than their foes average, however the road weary Cougars and they're #125 OFF has been held to 118 ypg below the average their foes allow. BYU has been held to 13 points or less 5 times, but our computer is projecting a season high 32 here. The Pirates have been alternating QB's. EC is on a 5-18-1 overall ATS run, while the Cougars are on a 0-6 ATS run themselves. We can't justify backing either school at this point and highly recommend you don't either.

Purdue by 10 over RUTGERS - This is the first ever meeting. Rutgers is playing their lone true home game in a 7 week stretch, while Purdue is on the second of B2B away games and enter off a misleading physical loss vs Wisconsin as they were outgained by 273 yds with the scoreboard showing a 1 possession game. The Knights enter off an emotional win at IL following their bye, which snapped their 16 game B10 losing streak. QB Rescigno earned the start but threw for just 89 yards as they turned to the run game. Purdue has 1 of the most improved D's in the nation but their run D has been gashed the L/2 weeks. Rutgers is 3-6 as a HD, but the Boilermakers haven't been an AF s/12.

MIAMI, FL by 18 over Syracuse - These two former Big East foes are meeting for the first time as ACC members. Both of these teams enter off emotional wins. Syracuse won't get to bask in the glory of their monumental upset over Clemson for very long against the undefeated Canes. The Orange did hold +123 yd & +12 FD edges last week but the Tigers didn't have QB Bryant in the 2H. QB Eric Dungey leads Syracuse in both passing (2080 yds, 12-4 ratio) and rushing (386, 3.8). The Canes needed a catch off a tipped pass on 4&10 last week to set up the GW fg to beat GT. Travis Homer stepped in for inj'd Mark Walton (OFY) and all he did was rush for 170 yds (8.4 ypc on the season!). HC Babers has Syr playing well, but it will be hard for the Orange to play up to that level for a 2nd straight week while Miami is off wins over FSU & GT and is 12-5-1 as a HF.

Central Michigan by 8 over BALL ST - It's homecoming in Muncie. CM has won B2B mtgs after losing 5 str by 10 ppg. The visitor is 7-3 SU/8-2 ATS. BSt is just 8-21 ATS at home & 5-11 as a HD. CM is 18-7 ATS on the road and 9-3 as an AF. The Cards are fresh off a bye while CM is ply'g their 3rd road gm in 4 wks. Both teams are struggling this year as CM is 2-5 ATS while BSt is 2-4 incl 4 straight losses and the loser will likely finish in the MAC West basement. Both teams have struggled on OFF (BSt #112, CM #115) but CM has the D edge (#76-#115) which will have us calling for CM to cover on the road despite rival WM on deck.

GEORGIA TECH by 1 over Wake Forest - The Deacons get extra prep time for the option coming off a bye and faced the option twice LY, holding Tulane to 146 (3.1) rush yds and Army to 238 (3.7). They also all'd 122 (3.5) vs App St TY. GT enters off a deceptively close loss vs Miami. The Jackets were outgained by 205 yds and got a KR td off a surprise outside kick to start the 2H. GT's #2 rusher Benson was inj'd LW (CS). WF has held foes to 32 ypg less than they avg on the ssn (#49). These two are nearly even on OFF & D and GT is near the bottom of our ST's rankings. While GT is 5-0 ATS TY, WF has a talented DL & done well against the option so we'll lean with the dog.

APPALACHIAN ST by 20 over Coastal Carolina - There's been 3 prior mtgs, all when both were FCS members with App St 3-0 SU, winning by an avg of 28 ppg. CC is on the 2nd of B2B AG's & 4th in 6 wks. The Chanticleers have shifted to a spread option OFF, similar to App St. Since winning their opener, CC has lost 5 straight, but outgained 3 of their 4 FBS foes and though they lost 51-17 at Ark St LW, they were only -47 yds. They have 2 QB's banged up. App St was -12' LW at ID but trailed 20-0 3Q before finishing with 23 unanswered. This is the lone HG in a 4 wk stretch for the Mountaineers while CC is ply'g their 2nd of B2B road gms. App St is just 2-9 ATS at home.

PENN ST by 10 over Michigan - PSU is in revenge mode after getting embarrassed last year when they were extremely depleted on the D side of the ball. The Nittany Lions enter fresh off a bye, while UM enters off an OT win and is on the second of B2B away games. We appeared to have an easy 3★ LP cover with the UNDER on the Wolve's last week, but they allowed their first 4Q points of the season, all in the L/3:27 of regulation to send the game into extras (Our tot totals play is 5-2 and we're releasing our totals GOM this wknd!). New starting UM QB O'Korn continues to struggle and PSU has the #13 D in the FBS holding foes to 107 ypg below their average. UM counters with the #1 D, holding foes to 183 ypg below their average as they've held all 6 opponents to season lows! The Nittany Lions are 10-4 as a HF, while the Wolve's are 5-9 as an AD.

WISCONSIN by 29 over Maryland - It's homecoming weekend in Madison. In the lone meeting here UW covered by 35 points. This is the second of B2B home games for the Badgers, while MD is travelling for the third time in 4 weeks. UW enters off a misleading final, winning by 1 possession while finishing w/494-221 yard and 24-14 FD edges. True fresh RB Taylor has rushed for 219+ in 3 games, leading an OFF that averages 264 (5.5) rush ypg while the Terp's have allowed 238+ rush ypg in 3 of their L/4 games. The Badgers are #10 on D, holding their foes to 123 ypg below their average while MD is down to their third string QB and #108 on OFF, averaging 52 ypg less than their foes allow. UW is 20-12-1 ATS in B10 home games, while the Terp's are 5-10 as a DD dog.

VIRGINIA TECH by 26 over North Carolina - It's homecoming in Blacksburg. The Hokies are 4-0 ATS in this series after winning LY in a downpour thanks to 4 TO's. Things have gone from bad to worse for the Tar Heels. Last week they had their 7 gm win streak over Virginia snapped and the score was misleading as the Heels were outgained 406-256. QB Harris got the start but hit just 7-18-46 with 3 int's. The pass yds were NC's lowest since 2000. Now NC faces our #15 pass eff D who is fresh off a bye. VT has out'd foes by 145 ypg and their OFF is #32, avg 65 ypg more than their foes allow. NC has been outgained by 104 ypg and their D is #104, allowing 51 ypg more than their foes avg. NC is 2-5 ATS on the ssn and their bowl hopes are almost zilch. VT is a contender for the ACC Coastal and is 5-1 as a HF vs FBS foes. HC Fuente is 7-1 off a bye week.

VIRGINIA by 3 over Boston College - It's homecoming in Charlottesville. UVA has never beaten BC (L/mtg in '10). The 'Hoos need 1 win to be bowl elig. BC is off a thrilling 45-42 (+21') outright upset at L'ville. True Frosh RB AJ Dillon went for 272 (7.0) and 4 td's and BC got the GW fg with no time left. UVA only won 20-14 (-3') vs NC but the score was misleading as the 'Hoos finished w/a 150 yd edge and held NC to just 46 pass yds & int'd 3 passes. BC has our #5 pass eff D. UVA avg 408 ypg but if you remove the UConn gm, that number drops to 365. The Eagles have faced our #2 toughest schedule while UVA has only faced our #90 toughest schedule. BC is 9-2-1 as an AD and have covered 4 straight. UVA is 8-13-3 as a HF.

BOISE ST by 11 over Wyoming - Boise ST had won 10 str by 26.2 ppg until LY when WY got a 30-28 (+14') home win over the #13 Broncos (cost Boise a trip to the MW Title game!). The Cowboys are ply'g B2B road gms but they are on a 9-3 ATS run as dogs including the outright upset of Utah St a week ago (12-0 run to close out gm). The Broncos also delivered outright as a road 'dog LW against a ranked SDSt squad (Boise Def w/4 sks & 12 fl). Despite the Broncos clearly seeking revenge from LY's upset defeat, we can't lean in their favor by too much here as they've now failed to cover their L/9 as a HF!

TCU by 42 over Kansas - It's homecoming weekend in Fort Worth. Since joining the B12, TCU is 5-0 SU in this series, however KU is 5-0 ATS. The Frogs are the lone undefeated B12 team and enter off an easy win over a KSU team ply'g without it's starting QB. Embarrassed isn't a strong enough word to describe the Jayhawks after their 4 FD and 106 total yard performance at ISU last week as they cannot decide on a starting QB and are allowing 55 ppg in conference play! TCU has held 3 of their 5 FBS foes to their season low in yards (2 others to 2nd lowest) and are #12 in the FBS holding foes to 108 ypg below their average. KU is on the second of B2B away games, has the Sunflower Showdown on deck and is 18-34-1 as an AD.

UTSA by 17 over Rice - Rice is 4-1 ATS in this series and won the F/3 mtgs but UTSA has won the L/2. UTSA is off B2B close losses incl last week then they allowed NT to drive 98 yds with no TO's for the GW td with :10 left. Rice has lost 4 straight with each being a non-cover. The Owls have been outgained by 127 ypg while UTSA has outgained foes by 157 although Rice has ply'd a much tougher sked. The Owls are 5-10-1 as an AD. UTSA is 3-9 ATS in CUSA road gms. Rice is fresh off a bye and HC Balliff is 11-2-1 ATS off a bye.

MASSACHUSETTS by 10 over Georgia Southern - It's homecoming wknd in Amherst. This starts a run of 5 road gms in a 7 wk span for GSthrn & they're in an SBC sandwich. UMass due to rescheduled Hurricane gms has had 2 straight bye weeks to prep for the option, something most only dream of. They all'd a respectable 4.4 ypc vs Tulane's option LY. While both teams are winless GSthrn is 0-4-1 ATS & lost to an FCS foe, while UMass is 2-1 ATS their L/3 with an 8 pt loss at Temple, a 4 pt loss at Tenn & an 8 pt loss vs Ohio. GSthrn is off their best performance of the ssn, but were outgained 505-265 & out FD'd 25-13 benefiting from a KR td & a 1 pl 48 yd td "drive". UMass has a slight D edge (#107-#116) but as a #77-#118 edge on OFF.

MISSOURI by 17 over Idaho - It's homecoming in Columbia. Mizzou QB Lock feasts on non-P5 foes, throwing for 426 ypg with a 19-1 ratio in 4 career games. The average score in those games has been 64-29. ID is just 1-10 ATS vs P5 foes and 10-23 ATS vs non conf foes. MO is 16-10 ATS vs non conf foes. The Vandals are off B2B close losses, have put up 359 ypg and have allowed 21 sacks (12.1%). MO has a penchant for blowing nonP5 foes out and they only face UConn next week.

USf by 14 over TULANE - This is the third opponent that USF is meeting for the first time this year and Tulane is the lone option team on the Bulls' sked. USF started slow but then picked up the pace in their nation leading 11 game win streak as they enter having scored 30+ points in 23 straight games! The Green Wave were held to a season low 239 yards last week at FIU and have allowed 218+ rush yards in 2 of their L/3 games. The Bulls are averaging 293 (5.0) rush ypg. USF is on a 21-9-1 overall ATS run. Tulane is 4-9 as a HD.

UNLV by 1 over Utah St - While it's HC in Las Vegas, UNLV is just 3-12 SU in this series with 3 str losses. Both squads are off of narrow and disappointing losses coming in with the Rebels blowing a 27-0 lead in the 2Q at AF and the Aggies being tripped up late at home vs Wyoming. The dog is a solid 5-2 ATS in this series and the Aggies are playing their lone road contest in a 5-wk span.

LA TECH by 7 over Southern Miss - LT is in double revenge mode! LTH was the 'defacto CUSA West Title gm and SM won 58-24 (+5). LY the Bulldogs had the CUSA Title gm on deck and got caught looking ahead in a 39-24 (-14') road loss. LT is fresh off a bye after losing a heartbreaker to UAB. SM is +132 ypg while LT is +14 ypg against similar schedule strength. S Miss RB Ito Smith has rushed for 733 (6.2) and QB Howard has had B2B strong performances, hitting 66% of his passes. LT is 10-5 ATS at home vs FBS foes. SM is 16-26 ATS vs CUSA foes.

UCLA by 8 over Oregon - It's HC wknd at the Rose Bowl with the Bruins needing to get back on track after being victimized on the ground LW in Tucson to the tune of 457 rush yds (17 pt defeat, QB Rosen held w/o TD pass for 1st time s/15). While the Ducks are on a 4-1 ATS run in this series, this is a different UO team following the loss of signal-caller Herbert. In their loss LW in Stanford (3★ Winner on the Cardinal), the Ducks finished with just 33 pass yds (outgained overall by a 504-309 clip). With the Bruins playing their only HG in a 5 wk stretch and UO on the road once again here and on a 5-15-1 ATS run overall, we'll lean with home squad in this one.

Arizona by 3 over CALIFORNIA - After going just 1-52-1 against Top 10 tms dating back to '78, the Bears pulled a shocking 34 pt upset (+16') LW against WSU thanks to a 7-0 TO edge. Cal has now covered 3 consec HG's (all as dogs) with 2 coming in the outright upset variety (27-16 over Ole Miss, +3'). The Wildcats and QB Tate were back at it for a 2nd consec wk as the young signal-caller has totaled 847 yds of tll offense (557 rush) in wins against Colo and UCLA. While going against either squad is a bit risky at the moment, we'll go ahead and back the visitor here as AZ has won 3 straight in the series including a 5 pt victory in their last trip to Berkeley back in '13.

MINNESOTA by 17 over Illinois - It's homecoming weekend in Minneapolis and the Gophers are on a 5-1 ATS series run. The Gophers enter off a misleading final as they gained 134 of their 290 total yards on two late td drives, while ILs home loss snapped Rutgers 16 game B10 losing streak! MN's run game is extremely effective vs average DLs and that fits right in with the Illini's. QB George has given IL a downfield passing threat, but the Gophers have our #26 pass eff D despite a banged up secondary. MN HC Fleck is on a 26-12 ATS run, while IL is on a 2-9 ATS run.

ALABAMA by 38 over Tennessee - It's the Third Saturday in October and Bama has won 10 str by 23 ppg in this series (8-3 ATS). Butch Jones time in Knoxville is almost surely running out. LW the Vols went with QB Guarantano as the starter. They put up just 253 yds vs SC and haven't scored a td in over 10 quarters. That streak could very well continue this week vs a Bama D that has allowed just 1 non-garbage time td vs their 4 SEC foes. This is the Vols 1st road gm in over a month and Bama has a bye on deck. Bama is on an 18-9-2 ATS run and 13-3-2 ATS vs SEC foes. The Vols are 0-6 ATS on the season.

Oklahoma St by 6 over TEXAS - OSU is on a 5-2 SU/4-2-1 ATS series run. This is the lone home game in a 4 week stretch for Texas. They enter off an emotional loss in the RRR, taking the lead after falling behind 20-0, but allowed the game deciding td w/6:53 left. The 'Horns are 18-1 SU/14-4 ATS in the game following. The Pokes enter off a school record 747 yard performance vs Baylor and are #3 in the FBS averaging 193 ypg more than their foes allow. Texas is averaging 223 (5.2) rush ypg at home and OSU has allowed 219+ rush yards 3 times. 'Horns HC Herman is a perfect 7-0 as a dog with 5 outright upsets.

West Virginia by 11 over BAYLOR - It's homecoming weekend in Waco. Baylor is 4-1 ATS in this series as B12 rivals. We not only cashed our 3★ LPS on the OVER (Totals GOM going this Sat!), but also used WV as our Inside info Marquee winner (college marquee's 8-2 L2W!) in their shootout win vs Tx Tech. Baylor has our #110 pass eff D and had no answer for OKSt's OFF in their blowout loss. The OFF had been playing better s/inserting Smith at QB, but he hit just 39% and was benched. The Mountaineers are #6 in the FBS on OFF averaging 140 ypg more than their foes allow and QB Grier has a 21-5 ratio. WV is 5-2 as an AF.

Auburn by 17 over ARKANSAS - Ark's 53 pt loss to Aub LY was the worst in series history (25 mtgs) and their 543 rush yds all'd set an SEC conf gm reg ssn record. The home tm is 6-2 SU/ATS. 6'7" 258 lb QB Cole Kelley was thrust into the lineup LW vs Bama (QB Allen inj'd, CS) and they trailed 41-3 before a late td caused a backdoor push. Aub is off a shocking loss vs LSU. The Tigers led 20-0 2Q but got just 64 2H yards and allowed 20 unanswered. QB Stidham had been the SEC's most efficient passer but hit just 9-26-165-1-3. Aub is +140 ypg while Ark is -9 ypg. The Tigers have the edge on OFF, D & ST's but are on their 2nd of B2B road gms.

FLORIDA ST by 10 over Louisville - It's shocking that both of these teams come in with 3 losses. FSU looks for revenge after getting utterly dominated in QB Francois' 1st 'true' road start LW 63-20 (-1). Not even Lamar Jackson's heroics (180, 8.2 rush, 332 pass) could save Lville LW thanks to a porous run D that allowed 364 (6.2). The 'Cards actually outgained BC 625-555 and are +187 ypg on the ssn but lost 45-42 (-21') on a fg as time expired. FSU outgained Duke 425-315 but were tied at 10 until RB Akers broke a 42 yd td run. FSU is +16 ypg but has faced our #1 toughest sked in the nation this year. FSU has rushed for a ssn high in each of the L/5 gms and could do so again with Lville allowing 238 rush ypg vs their L/4 FBS foes. UL is on a 1-10 ATS run. In FSU's 14 series wins, all but 1 have come by DD's (70) and we will call for that to continue.

SOUTH ALABAMA by 5 over Ulm - SA ply'g w/revenge after losing LY as a 2 td fav in OT. QB Davis threw for a then car high 307 yds. Last week we used South Alabama as our Wednesday Marquee (purchase through our office for \$15 at 1-800-654-3448) and the Jags pulled an outright upset as 16 pt dogs over Troy. ULM had won 3 straight into LW but were upset themselves by Georgia St. The WarHawks are -26 ypg on the ssn while SA is -89 ypg. The Jags have rushed for just 73 ypg their L/2 but ULM has allowed 225 (5.4) on the ssn. This is the lone HG in a 5 wk stretch for the Jags. ULM is ply'g an 8th str wk. SA is 1-6-1 as an SBC HF, while the WarHawks are 4-1 as an SBC AD.

NOTRE DAME by 6 over Usc - The Trojans shook off some early mistakes LW against the Utes (trailed 21-7 at HT) in their 1 pt come-from-behind victory (532-436 yd edge). They now head to South Bend to take on a well rested Irish squad off of their bye week. After being tripped up at home against Georgia back in Wk 2, ND has now rattled off 4 consec SU & ATS wins with a 14 pt avg cover. With USC in a P12 sandwich and the Irish having covered 3 of their past 4 at home in this series, we'll go ahead and give the home team the lean in this one.

Oklahoma by 13 over KANSAS ST - It's homecoming weekend in Manhattan. This is the third straight year that OU enters this game off the RRR and the LTH ('15) they dominated 55-0 (-4). The Sooners rebounded from their shocking loss to ISU w/an emotional win over Texas, scoring the game deciding td w/6:53 left after blowing a DD lead for the third straight game. KSU enters off an inept OFF performance led by bkp QB Delton as Ertz was held out vs TCU & is a ? here. OU has gained the most yards allowed vs 5 of their 6 foes (2nd most in the other) and is #2 in the FBS avg 204 ypg more than their foes allow and KSU has just our #65 pass eff D and allowed 546 yards vs Texas 2 weeks ago. The Sooners are 17-9 ATS in true road games and on an 8-4 overall ATS run, but the 'Cats are 9-3 as a HD and 47-24 ATS in B12 play. KSU does have the Sunflower Showdown on deck.

UTAH by 14 over Arizona St - The Utes have covered 4 straight in this series including a 23 pt win LY in the desert as 6 pt chalk. Utah could easily be returning to SLC after an outright upset of the Trojans LW as they led 21-7 at the half (USC TO's) and were attempting the go ahead 2 pt conv with :42 remaining. The Sun Devils meanwhile picked up a huge upset of #5 ranked UW LW in Tempe behind a suffocating defense that surrendered just 7 pts and 230 tll yds (UW came in avg 43 ppg and 432 ypg). With the Utes having covered all 6 gms so far in '17 and the Sun Devils having gone just 6-11-2 as an AD, we'll give a strong lean to the home squad in this one as the colder temps (mid 40's forecasted as of presstime) could give the warm-weather visitor some issues.

WASHINGTON ST by 13 over Colorado - After mixed road results the past 2 weeks that saw them knock off a Herbert-less Ducks squad and get embarrassed in Berkeley against Cal (37-3 defeat, fewest pts in Leach era, 5 int's thrown by Falk, the Cougars are back home where they've outscored (+21 ppg) and outgained (+221 ypg) their foes by significant margins so far TY (5-0 SU/2-3 ATS). The Buffs needed a late score LW in Corvallis to escape with a 3 pt win over the Beavers while snapping their 3-gm losing streak in the process. While CU has now covered each of their past 5 as a P12 AD including a few wks back against UCLA, there may be some underlying issues for their defense at the moment after giving up 567 & 569 yds the past 2 wks.

SAN DIEGO ST by 14 over Fresno St - SDSt has won the L/2 SU (1-1 ATS) in the series but do come in following their 1st loss of the ssn LW against Boise St as the Broncos bottled up Aztec RB Penny to just 53 rush yds on 21 att (2.5 ypc). The Aztecs trailed 14-0 early despite Boise St having 0 FD's thanks to a fumble & punt return. The Bulldogs meanwhile are off of a convincing win over NM (526-322 yd edge). With SDSt on a solid 30-14-1 ATS run against conf foes incl 12-6 as a MW HF, we'll call for them to get back on track this weekend against a FSU squad that's covered just 4 of their past 12 as an AD.

The Cardinals meanwhile FINALLY got their offense moving a week ago in the desert against the Bucs (38 pts & 432 yds). While we clearly made a mistake earlier in the ssn by going against the Jaguars across the pond (5th consec yr traveling to London) in their matchup against the Ravens, we've learned from that error and will back the Rams (played here twice before including LY) in this one against a Cardinals squad making their inaugural trip (ARZ overall 4-13 ATS run).

FORECAST: LA RAMS by 13

3★ MINNESOTA over Baltimore - Following an OT loss LW at home against the Bears that dropped their spread record against the NFC to 1-7-1 ATS, the Ravens are back in non-conf once again here. The Vikings meanwhile had the benefit of playing against GB with bkp QB Hundley under center following an injury to Aaron Rodgers (351-224 yd edge). With BAL still struggling in meetings against NDIV foes (covered just 3 of L/12) and the Vikings posting a 10-3 ATS run against the AFC under Zimmer, we'll give the edge to MIN in this one as they've also rattled off covers in 15 of their past 20 HG's.

FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 14

2★ Tennessee over CLEVELAND - The Browns continued their slide into NFL obscurity LW in Houston (lost 21 of L/22 gms) as Kevin Hogan proved to be even worse under center throwing for just 140 yds and 3 int's. They now play host (3-11-1 ATS as a HD) to a Titans squad fresh off their MNF matchup against DIV rival IND. While TEN is on short rest and traveling, we'll go ahead and give them the 13 pt edge here (9-2-1 ATS as a NDIV AF) as they have a bye week on the horizon while the Browns (3-13 ATS run) are preparing for their first trip to London to take on the Vikings.

FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 13

OTHER PLAYS

Kansas City at OAKLAND - Thurs - The Chiefs are a perfect 5-0 ATS as a DIV AF the past 3 ssn's incl 26-10 (-1) & 34-20 (-2) victories in the "Black Hole." In fact, KC has won 5 straight against OAK (4-1 ATS) with a 12 pt avg MOV. The Chiefs did however drop their 1st game of the ssn LW against the Steelers in Arrowhead thanks to a rough start that saw them record 1 FD & 6 yds in the 1H. The Raiders also continued their recent losing skid a week ago (Chargers GW 32 yd FG as time expired) as it appeared that QB Carr was a bit rusty (171 pass yds, 1-2 ratio) returning from inj. With both squads hungry for a victory here, this is a matchup that we'll have to examine closer to Thursday's kickoff. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

Jacksonville by 5 over INDIANAPOLIS - Following a home defeat LW against the Rams where their ST's allowed a KR & blk'd punt for TD's, the Jags head to IND as a potential DIV AF for just 2nd time in L9Y. The Colts are on short rest after their MNF battle in Nashville but do have some confidence in this matchup as they've knocked off the Jags in each of their past 4 meetings (12 pt avg MOV). While the Colts are 12-2 ATS as a HD, we'll side with the Jags in this one as they're on a 6-1 ATS run away from JAX and have alternated wins and losses so far this ssn.

PITTSBURGH by 9 over Cincinnati - Following their 3rd victory over the Chiefs in a little more than a calendar year (Big Ben, Bell & Brown 346 combined ttl yds), the Steelers are back in Heinz Field to take on a Bengals squad that comes in well rested after a bye and riding a 2-gm winning streak. While the Bengals are on a 7-3 ATS run in DIV AG's including an easy 31-7 win over the Browns (-3), we'll give the Steelers the lean in this one as they've done extremely well against the Bengals lately with a 6-1 SU/ATS mark (9 pt avg win).

MIAMI by 1 over NY Jets - The Dolphins offense woke up in the 2H against the Falcons a week ago by scoring the final 20 pts in a 3 pt victory (1st MIA int of yr sealed the game and our Oct NFL GOM Winner on UNDER 46!). Ironically those dismal offensive performances began in their previous meeting against the Jets back in Wk 3 with their only score coming on the game's final play (20-6 loss as 6 pt chalk). Although the Jets landed in the loss column for the 1st time in a month LW at home against the Patriots (led 14-0 in 2Q, finished w/a 408-375 yd edge), they do head to South Beach carrying a 16-7 ATS mark when listed as a DIV AD. While we'll go ahead and give the favored Dolphins the 1 pt edge, it wouldn't surprise us to see another outright upset in this series as MIA has covered just 12 of their past 45 as a HF!

BUFFALO by 6 over Tampa Bay - Following an error-filled loss against the Patriots a few weeks back in Tampa, the Bucs struggled early LW at ARZ (trailed 31-0 in the 3Q) while potentially losing QB Winston to a shldr inj in the process (CS here). They're now back on the road for a 2nd consec week to take on a well-rested Bills squad (8-4 ATS off a bye). While TB is on a 6-2 ATS run as an AD, keep in mind that Bills HC McDermott spent the past 6 yrs as the DC of the Panthers (matched up against the Bucs twice a year). With covers in each of their previous 7 meetings against the NFC including a perfect 2-0 mark TY, we'll lean with the Bills in this one.

Carolina by 2 over CHICAGO - The Panthers were tripped up at home last Thur against the Eagles thanks to a trio of Newton int's. The Bears meanwhile delivered a surprising performance on short rest in their OT win in BAL (1st road start for Trubisky, 338-291 yd edge). While the Panthers are clearly the stronger team (#1 in NFL holding foes to 77 ypg under their ssn avg) and have extra rest heading to Soldier Field, it's tough to lay points with them as they've covered just 1 of their past 8 as away chalk. With the hometown Bears sitting at 7-1-1 ATS as a HD including a perfect 3-0 mark in '17 (incl outright win over PIT), we'll call for this matchup to go right down to the wire (CHI #5 in NFL holding foes to 52 ypg under ssn avg).

New Orleans by 7 over GREEN BAY - After holding off another late comeback attempt by the Lions (DET pulled within 7 in 4Q after trailing 45-10 early 3Q), the Saints head to Lambeau having covered 11 of their L/13 away from the Superdome. The Packers not only return home following a loss at MIN, but with major questions under center after Aaron Rodgers was lost to a broken collarbone (GB outgained 239-155). While GB has a bye on deck after this matchup, we find it hard to back them in this one with Brett Hundley (18-33 for 157 yds & 1-3 ratio LW) earning his 1st career start against a Saints defense that forced 5 TO's & scored 3 TD's a week ago.

Dallas by 3 over SAN FRANCISCO - The Cowboys and 49ers have matched up against each other on 35 occasions in their history (7 times in postseason) with the series deadlocked at 17-17-1. The Cowboys did come out victorious in their most recent meeting a ssn ago in Santa Clara (24-17 win, -1) holding 26-14 FD & 428-295 yd edges. Following a 3-gm road trip that included 2 OT defeats vs ARZ & IND and a narrow 2 pt loss to WAS with CJ Beathard (245 pass yds, 1-1 ratio) taking over for an ineffective Hoyer (likely earning 1st career start here), the 49ers get a one game home reprieve before heading back on the road next week in PHI. While the Cowboys are in a better spot after their week off (9-3 ATS off a bye) and posting an 8-4 ATS mark as an AF, we'll go ahead and lean with the 49ers here as they became the 1st team in NFL history to lose 5 consec gms by 3 pts or less.

Seattle by 10 over NY GIANTS - After a nightmarish start to the '17 campaign that saw the Giants drop each of their 1st 5, some fortunate things went in their favor LW in DEN as they handed the Broncos a 23-10 defeat (+12) despite a 412-266 yd disadvantage (DEN 3 TO's & 2 missed FG's).

After going 9-3-3 ATS as HF the past 2Y, the Pats have slipped up so far TY in Foxborough with an 0-3 ATS mark that includes SU defeats to KC (-8) & CAR (-9). NE trailed 14-0 early against the Jets LW before scoring 24 of the game's final 27 pts in the 7 pt victory. While the Falcons jumped out to a 17-0 lead LW against the offensively-challenged Dolphins, it was MIA that would shockingly rattle off the final 20 pts of the game (**4★ GOM Winner on UNDER 46!**) and moving ATL's ATS record vs the AFC to just 5-13 in the process. Although NE is on a 14-7 ATS run overall, check back on Sunday to see which way we lean as ATL is an impressive 8-1 ATS as an AD. **Call the office on gameday at 11am ET for the Marquee Winner!**

Washington at PHILADELPHIA - MNF - The Redskins held off a late charge by the 49ers LW to escape with a 2 pt victory (420-335 yd edge). PHI moved to 5-1 on the yr (only loss to KC in Arrowhead) last Thur in Charlotte behind a 3 TD outing from QB Wentz. While PHI gets the sked advantage with a home gm and extra rest, keep in mind that the Redskins are 20-8 ATS as a DIV AD.
